Whit Holcomb-Faye • Junior
Guard • Radford
Winston-Salem, N.C.

Holcomb-Faye averaged 19.5 points in leading Radford to a pair of Conference wins last week. He led the Highs with 20 points at VMI Wednesday, and finished with 19 points against High Point Saturday night -- including a half-court buzzer-beater in overtime to lift RU to an 85-83 win over the Panthers. Holcomb-Faye averaged .500 from three-point range (4-of-8) and was near-perfect from the charity stripe, hitting 13-of-14 free throws (.929), in addition to 3.5 assists and 2.0 steals per game. The pre-season All-Conference selection has made 45 of his last 49 free throw attempts (.918).

BIG SOUTH'S TELEVISION SCHEDULE THIS WEEK FEATURES ONE VS. TIED-FOR-TWO

The Big South's television package continues this week with three games on the tube. On Monday night, VMI travels to Liberty to face the Flames at Vines Center for a BSTN game. LU enters the game with a 13-game home Conference win streak, and has won its last four straight games to move into a tie for second place with Charleston Southern and High Point. On Tuesday, FSN South will televise Charleston Southern's visit to League-leading Winthrop. CSU has suffered two straight setbacks, while the Eagles have won five-in-a-row. The TV slate wraps-up Saturday night when C-SET carries the Eagles' appearance at High Point.

WINTHROP MOVES INTO SOLE POSSESSION OF FIRST PLACE

After opening the Big South season with a loss, the Winthrop Eagles have won five straight to move ahead of the pack with a 5-1 Conference record. The Eagles' five-game Conference win streak is their longest since winning six-in-a-row in 2002-03, and marks the fourth such win streak during **GREGG MARSHALL's** tenure as head coach. During the current streak, Winthrop is averaging 74.4 points and a +10.4 scoring margin, as well as .477 FG (123-of-258), .456 from three-point range (41-of-90), 17 free throws made, 38.4 rebounds, 12.6 offensive boards, 5.0 blocks and 6.2 steals. In their last four games, the Eagles are hitting .514 (37-of-72) from beyond the arc.

MY FAVORITE MARTIN

Winthrop guard **TORRELL MARTIN** has enjoyed a three-game stretch that has seen him hit .606 from the floor (20-of-33), .647 from three-point range (11-of-17) and .846 from the free throw line (11-of-13), while averaging 20.7 points in that span. He scored a career-high 24 at Birmingham-Southern, following a five-hour stay in a Birmingham hospital because of a stomach virus. He followed that performance with his first career double-double vs. Coastal Carolina (16 PTS, 10 REB).

MARSHALL PLAN

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is one win away from becoming the first Big South coach ever to record seven-straight 15-win seasons. Marshall is tied with former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY**, who led the Highlanders to at least 15 wins from 1996-02. Marshall, who moved into a tie with **GARY EDWARDS** (Charleston Southern) for third-place on the League's all-time win chart with 129, is also climbing the Big South's chart for Conference wins, as he just trails UNC Asheville leader **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** for third. However, Marshall does own the highest winning percentage among coaches with 50 Conference games coached.

COASTAL'S DOUBLE-DOUBLE

Coastal Carolina is tied for the top spot in the League in two scoring categories. The Chants and Liberty have produced the most games with a 20-point scorer (10), while Coastal and Winthrop have one player to lead his team in scoring the most times. CCU's **PELE PAELAY** and Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN** each have led their squad in scoring 10 times this season.

TREY LINERS

High Point senior guard **ZIONE WHITE's** consecutive games streak of hitting at least two three-pointers ended at 12 Saturday, as he went 1-of-6 at Radford Saturday night. However, White's streak of 13 straight games with a three-pointer is the longest current run in the Big South, breaking his tie with Winthrop's **TORRELL MARTIN**, who opened the 2004-05 campaign with a trey in the first 12 games. Coastal Carolina's **JACK LEASURE** is chasing White, as he has nailed a three-pointer in his last 10 games, as well as in 17 of his 18 appearances this season. Following Leasure on the current chart is Liberty's **DAVID DEES**, Charleston Southern's **TERRELL BROWN** and UNC Asheville's **STEVEN RUSH** at eight-straight games, and Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** with seven consecutive games with a three-point bucket.

WHO'S LINE IS IT ANYWAY?

Radford junior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** has made 45 of his last 49 free throw attempts for a .918 percentage. The preseason All-Conference selection, who entered the season with a .721 career mark from the line, leads the League in the category at .863, helping the Highs rank 15th nationally in free throw percentage. Holcomb-Faye, whose career average now stands at .745, has recorded seven perfect nights from the line this season, and his worst outings have been just two free throw misses. He is challenging the school season record of .879, set by **DON BURGESS** in 1992-93.

GATHINGS TRACKER

High Point senior **DANNY GATHINGS** is the lone active member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound club, and 33rd member overall. His 555 boards in a High Point uniform are 27th in Conference history and is 12 caroms away from supplanting **GREG WASHINGTON** (Winthrop) for 26th place. Gathings' 1,184 points in the Big South are tied for 42nd and trail **BRENT KECK** (UNC Asheville) by two points for the 41st spot. With two games this week, Gathings could reach 1,211 points and 36th place if he maintains his 13.8 scoring average. Meanwhile, Gathings is looking to become the 25th player to record 600 rebounds and 11th player to score 1,300 points and grab 600 rebounds in the Big South.

BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT SCORERS

UNC Asheville's **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** became the latest member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone January 15 against VMI. The Conference now has three active 1,000-point scorers as League members, and four overall when Birmingham-Southern's **JAKOB SIGURDARSON** is added to the mix.
