In two wins last week, Lightbourne averaged 18.0 points, 9.5 rebounds and .714 from the field on 15-of-21 shooting. He helped the Flames move past High Point in the Conference Standings with his first career double-double against the Panthers, scoring 24 points and grabbing 12 rebounds. In Liberty's come-from-behind win at Birmingham-Southern, Lightbourne was 6-of-8 from the floor and finished with 12 points and seven boards in helping the Flames win their first game at Birmingham-Southern's Bill Battle Coliseum, and tie Winthrop with a League-high seven Conference wins.

### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Leasure averaged 13.7 points in helping the Chants win two of three last week and move into a tie for fourth place in the Big South. He scored 20 points and was 8-of-15 from the floor in CCU's 75-70 win over VMI Saturday, while equaling his personal-best of six rebounds at Charleston Southern. For the week, Leasure was 16-of-33 from the field ( =.485), averaged 2.67 three-pointers per game and reached double-figures in all three contests in winning his fifth weekly freshman honor of the season.

# **RADFORD SUSPENDS FOUR PLAYERS FOR REMAINDER OF 2004-05 SEASON**

Radford has suspended four players for the remainder of the 2004-05 season, coach **BYRON SAMUELS** announced Saturday. Juniors **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**, **CHRIS GOODIN** and **TOM HAYES**, and freshman **BRANDEN SMITH** have all been suspended for a violation of team rules and athletic department policy. Holcomb-Faye, a preseason All-Conference selection, was averaging 15.1 points per game. Goodin was scoring 4.5 points a night while Smith averaged 1.5 points per appearance. Hayes, a walk-on, tallied 0.8 ppg in five games.

# **ESPN.COM'S "COLLEGE HOOPS EXTRA" FEATURES BIG SOUTH FOR SECOND TIME IN '04-05**

ESPN.com's weekly "College Hoops Extra" report this week highlights Coastal Carolina's **PELE PAELAY**, under its "A Look at Some of College Basketball's Hidden Gems" feature. The Conference was first featured in the weekly report on January 13 when Birmingham-Southern's **THOMAS VIGLIANCO** was profiled for his rebounding and three-point shooting proficiency.

# **PAELAY LEADING THE WAY**

Coastal Carolina junior guard **PELE PAELAY** continues to pace the Big South in overall scoring (18.1) and in Conference games (20.1). He also ranks first with eight 20-point games, first with 2.55 steals per game, seventh with 6.1 rebounds per night and ninth with 2.91 assists per contest. His accomplishments come after entering the 2004-05 season with career averages of 4.7 points, 2.1 rebounds, 0.73 assists and 0.67 steals in 52 games. Paelay is looking to become the first player in Big South history to lead the League in both scoring and steals in the same season.

# **WINTHROP'S WIN STREAK REACHES SEVEN**

After opening the Big South season with a loss, the Winthrop Eagles have won seven straight to move ahead of the pack with a 7-1 Conference record. The Eagles' seven-game Conference win streak is their longest since winning seven-in-a-row in 1999-00, and marks the third such win streak during **GREGG MARSHALL**'s tenure as head coach. The last Big South team to win seven straight Conference games was Liberty, accomplished last season. Meanwhile, Winthrop is 10-0 at Winthrop Coliseum this year, and is looking to become the first Big South squad since Radford in 2000-01 to go undefeated at home in a single-season.

# **TREY LINERS**

High Point's **ZIONE WHITE** has made a three-point bucket in 16 straight games, the longest streak of the season in the Big South. Coastal Carolina freshman **JACK LEASURE** has hit a three-pointer in 14 straight contests, and in 21 of his 22 appearances this year. Charleston Southern's **TERRELL BROWN** has also tickled the twine from long range the last 12 straight games. # **JAKOB HOPING EIGHT IS NOT ENOUGH**

In his last eight games, Birmingham-Southern's **JAKOB SIGURDARSON** is averaging 18.8 points, 2.7 points above his season average of 16.1. In that same span, he has moved up from fifth in the Conference in scoring to third place, and is averaging .530 from the field (44-of-83) and .552 from long range (16-of-29). Sigurdarson has also recorded three games with at least 26 points, including two 29-point efforts.

# **LIBERTY'S BACKCOURT PRESS**

Liberty's backcourt sophomore duo of **LARRY BLAIR** and **DAVID DEES** have combined for 35.3 points in 10 Conference games this season, and are producing at almost an identical pace in the Big South campaign. Blair is 60-of-131 FG, while Dees is 53-of-128. Blair has made 17 three-pointers; Dees 20. Both are shooting .789 from the free throw line; on the boards, Dees is averaging 5.6, compared to Blair's 4.9. Blair has 21 assists, one behind Dees' 22. The two also foul alike, as Blair has 21 personal fouls, with Dees being whistled 24 times in the Conference season.

**TWO SETS OF PANTHERS, EAGLES LOOKING TO ESTABLISH FIRSTS**

Birmingham-Southern is looking to become the first school ever to lead the Big South in field goal percentage and three-point percentage in two consecutive seasons. Last year, BSC was tops with a .482 field goal percentage and .430 three-point success rate. This season, the Panthers are leading with a .460 average from the field and .386 clip from the arc. Meanwhile, High Point's League-leading 75.5 overall scoring average is the highest in the Big South since Radford averaged 78.4 points in 1998-99. The Panthers have never led the Conference in scoring average. Winthrop, which has led the Big South in scoring defense each of the last six seasons, is on pace to set the League mark in that category, as the Eagles are limiting opponents to 60.3 points. The 1987-88 Eagle squad set the League record at 61.6.

**GATHINGS TRACKER**

High Point senior **DANNY GATHINGS** is the lone active member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound club, and 33rd member overall. His 572 boards in a High Point uniform are 26th in Conference history and is four caroms away from supplanting **DEWAYNE CHEATHAM** (Coastal Carolina) for 25th place. Gathings' 1,221 points in the Big South are 36th and trail **SKIP SAUNDERS** (UMBC) by eight points for the 35th spot. Meanwhile, Gathings is looking to become the 25th player to record 600 rebounds and 11th player to score 1,300 points and grab 600 rebounds in the Big South.

**BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT SCORERS**

UNC Asheville's **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** became the latest member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone January 15 against VMI. The Conference now has three active 1,000-point scorers as League members, and four overall when Birmingham-Southern's **JAKOB SIGURDARSON** is added to the mix. Meanwhile, Radford's **OLUMUYIWA POPOOLA** is 40 points away from joining the club. The chart below indicates the active scoring leaders:

**MARSHALL PLAN**

With the Eagles' 58-45 win over Charleston Southern Jan. 25, Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** became the first Big South coach ever to record seven-straight 15-win seasons. Marshall was tied with former Radford mentor **RON BRADLEY**, who led the Highlanders to at least 15 wins from 1996-02. Marshall, who is third on the League's all-time win chart with 131, is also climbing the Big South's list for Conference wins, trailing UNC Asheville leader **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** by two for third place. However, Marshall does own the highest winning percentage among coaches with 50 Conference games coached.

BSC has been without 6-11 center **SHEMA MBYIRUKIRA** the last five games because of an injury ... The Panthers have suffered seven of their 10 losses by eight points-or-less, including four by four points-or-fewer ... Birmingham-Southern hosts High Point on Thursday in a game to be regionally-televised on FSN South. The Panthers visit Winthrop on Saturday.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Senior **KURTIS RICE** ranks 11th in the League in scoring (13.2), third in rebounding (6.7) and third in field goal percentage (.517). In Conference games, Rice is hitting .556 from the floor (55-of-99) ... The Bucs are second in the League in Conference Games scoring defense at 65.4 ... CSU hosts VMI Monday night, then visits Liberty on Saturday.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

In his last eight games, **PELE PAELAY** is averaging 21.3 points, .808 from the charity stripe (42-of-52), as well as 5.6 rebounds and 2.5 steals ... Freshman **JACK LEASURE** leads the Big South in three-point field goals made (62) and made per game (2.82). ## HIGH POINT

High Point hosts Winthrop Tuesday in a re-scheduled game, travels to Birmingham-Southern Thursday for an FSN South TV game and hosts Coastal Carolina Saturday. The Panthers are three wins away from tying the school record for home wins in a season (11) since moving to Division I ... High Point leads the Conference in overall scoring offense (75.5) and in Conference games (81.3). In addition, the Panthers are first in steals per game at 10.23, good for 12th in the nation.

## LIBERTY

LU's 84-81 win over High Point last Tuesday marked its 100th as member of the Big South. The Flames are now 101-94 during their tenure ... The Flames have erased a halftime deficit in five of their seven League wins ... Liberty is riding a 15-game home winning streak against Conference foes and entertains Winthrop Thursday and Charleston Southern Saturday.

## RADFORD

Sophomore **CHRIS OLIVER** is averaging Big South-bests of 7.1 rebounds and .564 from the floor. The last Radford player to lead the Conference in those categories were **ANDREY SAVTCHENKO** (rebounds - 2000-01) and **CORREY WATKINS** (field goal percentage - 2001-02), respectively. Oliver could become just the fourth player in League history to lead the Conference in both categories in the same season and first since 1999-00 (**CLINT WALKER** - Elon) ... Radford plays at Coastal Carolina Monday in its lone action of the week.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs are 5-2 in their last seven Conference games. In that span, **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** is averaging 15.9 points, while **K.J. GARLAND** is scoring 11.9 points. Garland is also handing out 5.6 assists since Jan. 15, and **CHAD MOHN** is crashing the boards at a 7.9 per game rate. UNCA has out-rebounded its opponents in six of the seven games, averaging 42.3 (vs. 35.0) ... Against High Point last Saturday, the Bulldogs scored 61 second-half points in the 89-77 win ... UNCA plays at Winthrop Monday night before visiting VMI Saturday afternoon.

## VMI

The Keydets are tied for second in the Conference in three-point defense, holding opponents to a .322 average ... In Conference games, VMI is shooting a League-high .719 from the free throw line ... **REGGIE WILLIAMS** continues to rank as the Conference's leading freshman scorer at 15.7 points per game, good for a tie for fourth overall in the Big South ...
