Torrell Martin • Sophomore G • Winthrop Columbia, S.C.

Martin helped Winthrop win three games, including a 60-54 upset victory at Providence. He averaged 14.0 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.7 steals, while hitting 7-of-13 from three-point range (.538%). Against the Friars, he scored the go-ahead basket, was 4-of-5 from the line in the final seconds and grabbed a career-high nine boards. Martin also had 13 points vs. Barton and 18 against Siena.

NEW BALANCE CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Chris Gaynor • PG • Winthrop Winston-Salem, N.C.

Gaynor averaged 9.0 points, 5.3 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 2.7 steals in Winthrop's three wins. He scored in double figures twice, was .500 from both the floor and three-point range, and recorded four steals against Providence. Gaynor also had nine assists against Barton and six helpers vs. Siena.

Reggie Williams • F • VMI Prince George, Va.

Williams helped VMI upset Virginia Tech with 16 points, including three three-pointers. He also had four rebounds and three assists against the Hokies. Williams led VMI in scoring vs. Old Dominion and averaged 12.5 points and 4.0 rebounds for the week.

BIG SOUTH POSTS WINS OVER BIG EAST, ACC IN SAME WEEK

It was a memorable week last week in the Big South Conference, as Winthrop traveled to Providence, R.I. and upset the Friars, 60-54, for its first win against a Big East member. On Saturday, VMI stunned then-undefeated Virginia Tech with a 72-68 win over the Hokies in Lexington, the Keydets' first win over an ACC opponent since 1964. The last time the Big South Conference recorded wins over ACC and Big East members in the same season was 1993-94, when former member Towson defeated St. John's, 66-65, and former member Campbell knocked off North Carolina State in overtime, 72-69.

NON-CONFERENCE WIN-THROP

The Eagles recorded their fourth win over a major Division I power since the 1999-00 season with its upset win at Providence last week. The Friars, which received 16 Top 25 votes in the Nov. 29-Dec. 5 ESPN/USA Today coaches poll, joins schools from the Big 12, ACC and SEC that have fallen to Winthrop. In 1999-00, GREGG MARSHALL's squad defeated Missouri 51-46, then knocked off intrastate rival Clemson in 2001-02 (66-61). The Eagles routed Georgia last season, 80-60.

HOKIE-POKEY

VMI's 72-68 win over Virginia Tech was the Keydets' first against the Hokies since Dec. 31, 1997, a 72-65 win in Blacksburg, and the first over an ACC opponent since a 95-75 win over Virginia on Dec. 9, 1964. It also was VMI's first win over Tech in Lexington since January, 1959.

REBOUL, MARSHALL APPROACHING MILESTONE WINS

Birmingham-Southern head coach **DUANE REBOUL** stands three wins shy of 375 in his career, which have all come as the Panthers' leader. His record during BSC's Big South years is 54-35 (=.607). Meanwhile, with his six wins already this season, Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** has 121 career wins and is seven victories away from tying **BILLY LEE** (128) for fourth on the Big South's alltime win list.

THIS IS A NEW ONE

Birmingham-Southern junior **THOMAS VIGLIANCO**, named the Conference's preseason Newcomer of the Year by *Lindy's* and *Street & Smith's*, leads the Big South in three-point shooting at .553% (21-of-38) *AND* is fifth in rebounding at 7.8 caroms per game. The 6-9 forward, who is the lone Big South player this year to haul in 10 rebounds in consecutive games, is hitting at an impressive .738 three-point clip in his last three contests (14-of-19). In addition, he has grabbed at least seven rebounds in six of eight appearances. Here is a look at Viglianco's three-point prowess thus far:

NOT FAR BEHIND IS...

Winthrop sophomore **CRAIG BRADSHAW**, at 6-10, is tied for sixth in the Conference in three-point shooting at .480 (12-of-25). Radford's **CHRIS OLIVER**, at 6-7, is hitting threes at a .538 rate (7-of-13) as well.

WHAT'S IN A NAME?

Coastal Carolina's **PELE PAELAY** has already recorded a League-high three double-doubles, as well as two 20-point, 10-rebound contests. He has three games of at least 20 points, all of which came in consecutive games. Paelay is second in the Big South in both scoring (18.0) and rebounding (8.7), and ranks first in steals with 3.67 per game.

THREE-PEAT

Charleston Southern's KURTIS RICE, Coastal Carolina's PELE PAELAY and High Point's DANNY GATH-INGS have led or tied for the lead as their team's respective high scorer, rebounder and top assist player in the same game this season. Rice led CSU with 10 points, 11 boards and 2 assists at Notre Dame; Paelay led the Chanticleers with 22 points and tied for the team-high with 11 rebounds and 4 assists at UNC Greensboro; Gathings was tops against North Carolina A&T with 21 points, 14 rebounds and 3 assists. Meanwhile, Rice, Paelay and UNCA's BRYAN McCULLOUGH each lead their clubs in scoring, rebounding and assists for the year.

He is now 54th all-time in scoring and needs eight points to move ahead of **RYAN CHARLES** (Radford) for 53rd place. Radford's **WHIT HOL-COMB-FAYE** is four points away from 1,000 in his career. TOP 25 COUNTDOWN

Six Big South opponents were ranked in the Top 25 in both the most recent *Associated Press* and ESPN/*USA Today* coaches poll (Nov. 29-Dec. 5): Georgia Tech, Michigan State, Maryland, Mississippi State, North Carolina State and Notre Dame. Ten additional opponents received votes: Oklahoma, Michigan, Providence, Creighton, Charlotte, West Virginia, Old Dominion, Utah, Miami (Ohio) and Oregon. This week, the Conference will face Michigan (High Point), Old Dominion (Liberty), N.C. State (Liberty) and Maryland (UNC Asheville).

ON THE BRINK

Birmingham-Southern's three losses have each been by seven points-or-less. The Panthers lost to No. 12 Mississippi State by seven (55-48), Massachusetts by four (64-60) and Indiana State by seven (62-55). Birmingham-Southern ranks first the Conference in scoring margin (+8.0), as well as field goal percentage (.483) and three-point shooting (.411). Last season, the Panthers ranked first in the nation in three-point shooting, 12th in field goal percentage and 28th in scoring margin.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

JAKOB SIGURDARSON and THOMAS VIGLIANCO have carried the Panthers in the past two games, accounting for 65% of the team's offense last week. At Indiana State, Viglianco led BSC with 19 points, followed by Sigurdarson's 17, while both players scored 23 points at Alabama State. The duo has gone 19-of-29 (=.655) from beyond the arc in that same span ... BUCKY McMILLAN is first in the Conference in assist/turnover ratio at 4.00 ... Birmingham-Southern is off for two weeks, with its next game set for Dec. 20 vs. Texas-Pan American.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Buccaneers were off last week for exams, and are idle until Saturday's match-up at Clemson ... **KURTIS RICE** leads the squad in scoring (9.0) and rebounding (10.0).

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers will take the week off for finals and hit the court again on Sunday, Dec. 12 with a home game against Coker ... The Chants will play all six games in the month of December in South Carolina, with five at Kimbel Arena. The lone road tilt is at the College of Charleston on Dec. 22.

HIGH POINT

DANNY GATHINGS became the 24th member of High Point's 1,000-point club last week with his 12 points against Greensboro College. He is now 23rd on HPU's all-time scoring list, and needs 11 points to surpass **RAY COBLE** (1973-77) and 13 points to surpass **CHARLIE FLOYD** (1977-79) ... The Panthers conclude a stretch of seven games in 13 days Tuesday at Michigan. High Point has already logged more than 9,600 miles of travel this season.

LIBERTY

The Flames snapped their season-opening three-game losing streak with an 86-82 overtime win over Shenandoah Saturday. It was LU's 43rd overtime game in history, and the win pushed Liberty's OT record to 17-26. Liberty has won three-straight overtime contests ... The Flames are in a stretch of playing 11 out of 15 games on the road ... LU surpassed 40% in field goal shooting in a game for the first time this season, reaching the mark against Western Carolina (23-of-51, =.451) and Shenandoah (30-of-71, =.423) ... Liberty travels to Old Dominion and North Carolina State this week.

RADFORD

Radford's 78-44 loss at West Virginia marked the first time this season the squad did not have three players reach double-figures in scoring in the same game. The Highlanders led by as many as eight against the Mountaineers, but WVa came back and took control of the game ... CHRIS OLIVER picked up his second career double-double earlier in the week with 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Ferrum ... WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE stands four points away from becoming the 18th player in RU history to score 1,000 career points ... Radford hosts Hampton at the Salem Civic Center Wednesday and Lees-McRae at the Dedmon Center Friday.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs placed five players in double-figures in UNCA's 85-71 win over Western Carolina Saturday. UNC Asheville shot a school-record 9-of-13 (=.692) from three-point range in the first half en route to the victory ... The Bulldogs are off this week for exams, but reconvene for a road game at Maryland on Sunday, which will be regionally televised by Jefferson Pilot Sports.

VM

PRESTON BEVERLY's 10 rebounds against Virginia Tech matched his career-high, set against Davidson in 2002-03 ... VMI is 3-1 for the first time since the 1999-00 season and heads to Longwood on Wednesday before hosting Towson on Saturday.

WINTHROP
