Kurtis Rice • Senior • Forward

Rice led the Buccaneers to their first 2-0 start in Big South Conference play since 1994-95 after averaging 17.0 points, 9.0 rebounds and .667 percent from the floor (14-of-21) in road wins at UNC Asheville and VMI. In CSU's 64-63 win against the Bulldogs, Rice tallied his League-leading fourth double-double of the year with 16 points and 10 rebounds, while recording two blocked shots and three steals. Rice then added 18 points, eight rebounds and a blocked shot in the Bucs' 78-67 win over the Keydets. Charleston Southern has won three straight games and shares first-place in the Big South standings with High Point.

Also, UNC Asheville, the Biltmore Double Tree Hotel, and the American Red Cross will be collecting donations for the Tsunami relief effort during the Bulldogs' game with Winthrop on Monday night, Jan. 10, at the Justice Center. Everyone in attendance will receive a famous Double Tree Cookie, compliments of the Biltmore Double Tree. Each wrapper will be numbered and one lucky fan will win a free stay at the Charleston, S.C., Double Tree.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN, HIGH POINT OPEN BIG SOUTH SEASON 2-0

Charleston Southern opened the Conference season with road wins at UNC Asheville (64-63) and VMI (78-67) to start the Big South slate 2-0 for the first time since 1994-95. That season, the Bucs started 3-0 on their way to the regular-season title. CSU looks to improve to 3-0 Monday night at Radford. High Point is 2-0 for the third time in the last four seasons, including 3-0 to start last year's Big South season. HPU's next Big South game is Wednesday against UNC Asheville.

FLAMES' THROWER

Liberty sophomore **LARRY BLAIR** continues to shine this season. In LU's two Big South games last week, Blair scored 25 points at High Point and 23 at Winthrop, finishing with a League-leading 24.0 points per game average in Conference games. Blair also leads the Big South with six 20-point affairs, averaging 25.7 points in such contests. In his 46-game career, Blair has scored 668 points for a 14.5 career average.

WINTHROP FLYING HIGH, FIRST TEAM TO REACH 10 WINS

Winthrop's 75-73 overtime win over Liberty last Saturday was its 10th win in 15 games, the best start during head coach **GREGG MARSHALL**'s seven seasons and the best by a WU squad since the 1989-90 team opened 10-3. Winthrop also is the third-fastest Big South member to reach 10 wins in the last 10 years. The 1999-00 Liberty Flames reached 10 wins after 13 games, while the 1996-97 Flames and 2003-04 Birmingham-Southern and High Point squads each won its 10th game after 14 dates.

GATHINGS TRACKER

High Point senior **DANNY GATHINGS** became the first High Point player and just the 33rd member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound club earlier this season. His 524 boards in a High Point uniform are 30th all-time in Big South history, while his 1,133 points in the Big South are 45th. He is looking to surpass **STEPHEN BARBER** (Radford) on both charts, as Gathings is 10 caroms away from bettering Barber's rebounding total, while needing 38 points to move ahead of Barber on the scoring list.

MAY WE ASSIST YOU?

VMI sophomore **MATT COWARD** is averaging 7.0 assists in his last eight games, and leads the Big South with a 5.64 per game average. He has seven games with at least five helpers, including two games with 10+ assists. Winthrop freshman **CHRIS GAYNOR** is second in the League in assists with 4.27, but leads in total assists with 64. He has handed out at least five assists eight times this season. Since returning to Liberty's lineup in late December, **BRIAN WOODSON** is averaging 4.6 assists in seven games, with three games of six-or-more. Meanwhile, Radford junior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** is 23 assists shy of 300 in his career.

OLIVER TWIST

Radford sophomore **CHRIS OLIVER** currently ranks 20th in the nation in field goal shooting, and he has recorded seven games with a percentage better than .600, based on five field goals made in each game. Oliver has shot between .600-.699 twice, .700-.799 twice, .800-.899 twice, and .900-.999 once, for a grand total of .759 (60-of-79) in such games. His .909 percentage (10-of-11) against Longwood Nov. 23 ranks as the sixth-highest single-game performance in the NCAA this season.

GEEZ, MR. WILSON

Since joining the Panthers on Dec. 18 in accordance with NCAA transfer regulations, High Point junior **MARK WILSON** has scored 98 points in 119 minutes of action, which equates to 32.9 points per 40 minutes. He tallied 31 points against preseason favorite Birmingham-Southern this past Saturday on 13-of-17 shooting (=.765). The 31 points equaled Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR**'s performance this season as the highest scoring output of the year. In six games for High Point, Wilson is averaging 16.3 points, .542 from the floor (39-of-72), .368 from long-range (7-of-19) and .722 from the line (13-of-18), as well as 5.2 rebounds per game.

STILL GOING

Birmingham-Southern 6-9 junior forward **THOMAS VIGLIANCO** continues to lead the Big South in rebounding (7.4) and three-point field goal percentage (.525). Through games of Jan. 3, Viglianco was sixth in the nation in three-point shooting. If he continues his shooting prowess, Viglianco is on pace to record the second-highest three-point percentage in League history.

MR. ALL-AROUND

Coastal Carolina junior **PELE PAELAY** is the lone Big South player to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals. Paelay is 3rd in scoring at 16.3 points per game and 6th in rebounding at 6.4 caroms per night. He is also 5th in assists with 3.36 per game and 2nd in steals with 2.50.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN'S PLATT TURNS 100 ... IN WINS

Buccaneers coach **JIM PLATT** recorded his 100th career coaching win when CSU defeated Fordham two weeks ago. Platt's overall record now stands at 103-138 during his nine-year head coaching career, including a 47-79 mark at Charleston Southern. He is the fifth active Big South coach with 100 career wins, joining BSC's **DUANE REBOUL** (375 career wins), UNCA's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** (143), VMI's **BART BELLAIRS** (133) and WU's **GREGG MARSHALL** (125).

SPEAKING OF WINS...

Birmingham-Southern head coach **DUANE REBOUL** won the 375th game of his 16-year career last week when Birmingham-Southern defeated Radford, 61-59. All 375 wins have come as the Panthers' head coach, and his record during BSC's Big South years is 60-35 (=.632). Meanwhile, with his 10 wins already this season, Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** has 125 career wins and is three victories away from tying **BILLY LEE** (128) for fourth on the Big South's all-time win list.

BIG SOUTH 1,000-POINT SCORERS

Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** became the League's 58th member of the 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone Dec. 8 against Hampton. High Point's **DANNY GATHINGS** became the 57th member when he reached the milestone Dec. 2 against Greensboro College. Holcomb-Faye is three points shy of passing **LARRY JACKSON** (Liberty) for 52nd place.
