Jakob Sigurdarson • Senior Guard • Birmingham-Southern Reykjavik, Ireland

Sigurdarson helped the Panthers capture the Dr Pepper Classic. He scored a game-high 20 points and tallied six assists in directing Birmingham-Southern past UTC in the championship contest. The Senior earned All-Tournament honors with averages of 17.0 points, 3.5 assists and 3.5 rebounds in two games. Sigurdarson also posted 14 points at Texas-Pan American to finish the week with a 16.0 ppg aver-

Kurtis Rice • Senior • Forward Charleston Southern Salt Lake City, Utah

Rice led the Buccaneers with a career-high 26 points and 11 rebounds in a 50-49 win over Fordham, which snapped CSU's fivegame losing streak and earned a berth in the UCF Invitational Championship game. Rice received All-Tournament honors with a 17.5 scoring average, 6.5 rebounds and .538 field goal clip. He also led CSU with 12 points at No. 9 Georgia Tech.

NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

Jack Leasure Guard • Coastal Carolina Rochester, N.Y.

Leasure averaged 8.0 points in three contests and hit on 46.2 percent from the three-point arc (6-of-13) for the Chanticleers. He scored 12 points at the College of Charleston and finished with nine points at Tennessee. Leasure also averaged 1.7 rebounds and 1.7 assists.

CONFERENCE SEASON BEGINS IN EARNEST ON WEDNESDAY

The Conference portion of the 2004-05 season begins in earnest with four games on Wednesday, Jan. 5. Last season, Birmingham-Southern, Coastal Carolina, High Point and UNC Asheville each won its respective Big South opener. However, it was a mixed result as BSC (12-4) and HPU (10-6) were the lone teams of the four to post a better-than-.500 Conference record. Coastal finished at 8-8, while UNCA ended at 6-10.

BIG SOUTH ADDS TO WIN TOTAL

During Dec. 20-Jan. 2, the Big South recorded wins over Atlantic-10 and Colonial Athletic members, and now has wins against 16 Conferences this season. Last year, the Big South posted wins against 12 Leagues. In 2002-03, the Big South had victories over 13 different Conferences.

PULLING RANK

Liberty sophomore **LARRY BLAIR**, who leads the Big South in scoring at 16.6 points per game, averaged 26 points in two games against nationally-ranked opponents earlier this season. Against then-No. 10 North Carolina State, Blair tallied 22 points. He bettered that performance with 30 points at No. 23 Maryland on Dec. 29. Below is a closer look at Blair's two games, as well as other Conference players' efforts against nationally-ranked teams:

Meanwhile, Collington's teammate, **BRYAN McCULLOUGH**, posted averages of 11.5 points, 5.0 rebounds and 4.5 assists against the Terps and Spartans. In addition, in Birmingham-Southern's tilt against then-No. 12 Mississippi State, **JAMES COLLINS** scored 14 points and **THOMAS VIGLIANCO** grabbed 12 boards in the Panthers' seven-point loss to the Bulldogs.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN'S PLATT TURNS 100 ... IN WINS

Buccaneers coach **JIM PLATT** recorded his 100th career coaching win when CSU defeated Fordham last week, 50-49. Platt's overall record now stands at 100-140 during his nine-year head coaching career, including a 44-79 mark at Charleston Southern. He is the fifth active Big South coach with 100 career wins, joining BSC's **DUANE REBOUL** (374 career wins), UNCA's **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** (143), VMI's **BART BELLAIRS** (133) and WU's **GREGG MARSHALL** (124).

SPEAKING OF CAREER WINS...

Birmingham-Southern head coach **DUANE REBOUL** stands one win shy of 375 in his career, which have all come as the Panthers' head coach. His record during BSC's Big South years is 59-34 (=.634). Meanwhile, with his nine wins already this season, Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** has 124 career wins and is four victories away from tying **BILLY LEE** (128) for fourth on the Big South's alltime win list.

GATHINGS GATHERING

High Point senior **DANNY GATHINGS** became the first High Point player and just the 33rd member of the Big South's 1,000-point, 500-rebound club, when he grabbed his 500th career board in a High Point uniform against James Madison. Gathings has hauled in 508 boards in his High Point tenure, while totaling 571 during his collegiate career. On the scoring ledger, he currently owns 1,093 points in the Big South and 1,232 overall.

MR. ALL-AROUND

Coastal Carolina junior **PELE PAELAY** is the lone Big South player to rank in the top 10 in scoring, rebounding, assists and steals. Paelay is 3rd in scoring at 16.4 points per game and 7th in rebounding at 6.6 caroms per night. He is also 4th in assists with 3.42 per game and 2nd in steals with 2.58. UNC Asheville senior **BRYAN McCULLOUGH** is close to joining Paelay, as he is 10th in scoring, tied for 8th in assists and 4th in steals, while holding the 11th spot in rebounding.

HE'S NO COWARD

VMI sophomore MATT COWARD is averaging 6.8 assists in his last six games, as well as 3.2 steals and 15.3 points. He has scored in double-figures in each contest, including a career-high 20 points at New Orleans. Coward recorded his fifth game with at least five assists when he handed out nine helpers at Tulane. He leads the Big South in both assists (5.22) and steals (2.67). The last player to lead the League in both categories was Charleston Southern's ED O'NEIL in 2002-03.

WELCOME BACK

Since returning to the Flames' lineup, senior guard **BRIAN WOODSON** is averaging 4.8 assists, 7.0 points and 3.6 rebounds in five games. More impressive is that Woodson has either led or tied for the team-high in assists in all five contests, which leads the Flames. His 24 assists already are tied for second-most on the squad. Woodson led Liberty in assists last season with 4.7 per game.

GEEZ, MR. WILSON

High Point junior MARK WILSON scored 27 points and added eight rebounds and two blocked shots against James Madison in what was just his third collegiate game. He has scored 50 points in just 62 minutes of action after joining the Panthers on Dec. 18 in accordance with NCAA transfer regulations. Wilson is averaging 16.7 points, 6.0 rebounds, .543 percent from the floor (19-of-35), .571 from long-range (4-of-7) and is a perfect 1.000 from the charity stripe (8-of-8).

BIG SOUTH 1.000-POINT SCORERS

Radford's WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE became the League's 58th member of the 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone Dec. 8 against Hampton. High Point's DANNY GATHINGS became the 57th member when he reached the milestone Dec. 2 against Greensboro College. Gathings is now 46th all-time in scoring and needs 12 points to move ahead of BRAD CHILDRESS (Campbell) for 45th place. Holcomb-Faye is seven points shy of passing LESLIE BALLARD (Radford) for 53rd place. Below is a look at the current active players with 1,000 points overall in their careers, as well as their Big South career point totals. NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers claimed their second in-season tournament last week as they won the Chattanoogahosted Dr Pepper Classic. It marked just the third time in 15 years that Chattanooga failed to win its tournament. **THOMAS VIGLIANCO** earned Tournament MVP honors after averaging 12.5 PPG, 8.0 RPG and 7-of-15 3FG (=.467) ... The championship marked BSC's second "Cola" crown of the season, as Birmingham-Southern captured the Pepsi Marist Classic in November ... The Panthers open the Conference season Wednesday at home against Radford, just their second home game of the year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Freshman **CHRIS MOORE** scored a career-high 14 points with five boards in CSU's loss to Brown in the championship game of the UCF Invitational. Senior center **JOVAN JEGDIC** pulled down a career-high 11 rebounds and blocked five shots against the Bears. He finished with 19 boards in the two games ... Charleston Southern opens the Big South slate Wednesday at UNC Asheville. This is the third consecutive year that CSU will begin the Conference season with three straight road games.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal held Ohio Northern to the lowest point total of the season by an opponent (45) and the lowest field goal percentage (.269) ... Coastal has had a 20-point scorer in seven of its 12 games, the most by a Big South school to date ... The Chanticleers are looking to improve on last year's 8-8 Big South record, which was their best in 10 years, and open the Conference season Wednesday at home against Winthrop.

HIGH POINT

MARK WILSON and DANNY GATHINGS combined for 51 of High Point's 82 points against James Madison ...
