Wicker recorded 53 points, 19 rebounds, two blocks and three steals, scoring double figures in all three games last week for the Lady Bucs. She started the week off hot, recording 16 points and seven rebounds, as well as a block and a steal against Benedict. That was followed with a 27-point explosion against James Madison, where she also recorded seven more rebounds and another steal. In the final matchup of the week at IUPUI, Wicker scored 10, grabbing five rebounds and recording another block and another steal.

NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

Stacy Shepard Center • UNC Asheville Altavista, Va.

Shepard matched her careerhigh with 18 points and seven rebounds against N.C. A&T last week. She went 7-of-9 (.778) from the floor, including 4-of-5 from the charity stripe. Shepard is second in the Big South in field goal percentage at 62 percent.

RAVEN TRUSLOW, G, HIGH POINT

8 PTS, 2 AST, 1 RB vs. South Florida ... 2 PTS, 2 STL, 1 AST vs. Indiana State

HIGH ON THE MOUNTAIN

After reeling off four straight games of scoring 70 or more points, UNC Asheville now leads the League in scoring at 67.4 points per contest. It helps that **KRISTAL HOOD** is third in the Conference in points (16.2), while newcomer (10.1) **STACY SHEPARD** is chipping in 10.1 markers a game. She is leading the Big South rookies in that category as well. The Bulldogs are also first in free-throw percentage (.695), second in scoring margin (+3.1) and field goal percentage (.429).

ARE WE THERE YET?

So far this season, Big South schools have played in 32 road games, which accounts for a little over half (.516) of all contests so far this year. High Point has only seen a home-court advantage once this season, as five of the Panthers' first six games were on the road. HPU won't return to the Millis Center until Jan. 2, 2005. Winthrop has played six of eight games on the road, while Radford has four away contests. Meanwhile, Birmingham-Southern has played five games at home this season and has just its second road test Dec. 20 at South Carolina.

FEENSTRA WATCH

Liberty senior All-American **KATIE FEENSTRA** is quickly climbing the Big South record books this season, and could become just the third Big South women's player to amass 1,500 points and 800 rebounds in her career, having tallied 1,375 points and 598 rebounds. So far this season, Feenstra is first in FG percentage (.691), second in rebounding (9.1) and second in scoring (17.0). She has also tallied two double-doubles, while scoring in double-digits on six occasions.

3-POINT QUEENS

Winthrop's GENE'T MOORE has connected on a League-leading 21 treys in nine games for the Eagles this season. Not too far behind Moore are Birmingham-Southern's STACY ANTHONY and Liberty's KRISTAL THARP with 17 each. Anthony currently ranks 15th nationally with 2.57 3-point FG per game. The Big South record for three-pointers in a season is 91, set by Elon's LORETTA LAWSON during the 1999-00 season.

KATIE WHO?

Don't think that Liberty's **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the only Katie making an impact on Big South hoops this season. High Point's **KATIE O'DELL** is stating her cause early, averaging 18.1 points and 9.7 rebounds through eight contests. She is 1st in the League in scoring, rebounding and free-throw percentage, while 8th in 3FG percentage and 10th in FG percentage. She has scored double figures in seven of eight games played this season.

TAG TEAM

In what might be the trend for High Point women's hoops this season, KATIE O'DELL and CHARLENA MARTIN have scored in double figures in the same game five times this season, with the feat happening twice in Week Three. Martin had 11 points, while O'Dell added 10 vs. UT-Chattanooga Dec. 6, while they both tallied 17 points against Longwood Dec. 9. The duo also became the first pair of teammates to score 20 or more points in the same game, with O'Dell pouring in 27 points and Martin 24 against Western Carolina, Dec 1. O'Dell and Martin have combined to make up 46 percent (268 points) of the Panthers' offense this season.

DEJA VU?

When the Lady Flames fell to the Hokies of Virginia Tech Dec. 7, it marked the second time in school history that Liberty beat a Top-25 team and then lost to Virginia Tech the next home game, as Liberty defeated No. 17 Kansas State, 77-56, prior to facing to the Hokies. The first time it happened came back on November 26, 2002, as the Lady Flames beat No. 25 Virginia, 77-69, in overtime and then fell to the Hokies, 50-53, in the Vines Center.

100+

Coastal Carolina head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** earned his 100th victory at Coastal Carolina with a 51-47 win over UNC Wilmington, Nov. 30. He is just the fifth Big South coach to reach the century mark, and is the only coach in Division I to win 100 games in both men's and women's basketball. LeForce is the winningest head coach in Coastal women's basketball history with a record of 100-101, surpassing former Chanticleer head coach **GINA MARKLAND** last season.

CAN I HAVE THE UPSET SPECIAL?

Liberty snapped No. 17 Kansas State's 35-game home winning streak Dec. 4 and picked up the biggest win in the history of the program, downing the Wildcats, 77-56, to win the 10th Annual Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament over the weekend. The win marked just the second time in school history that the Lady Flames' have knocked off a ranked opponent, as LU defeated No. 25 Virginia, 77-69, in overtime at the Vines Center during the 2002-03 season.

For the third year in a row, the Big South Conference will be changing up the format for the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship, this time to accommodate television coverage. This year, the four first-round games will be played on the campus of the higher-seeded teams. The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, Mar. 8, with the Semifinals following on Friday, Mar. 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, Mar. 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

After a week of for exams, the Panthers return to action on Monday against South Carolina. The trip up north will mark the first time this season BSC will play outside of Alabama. **STACY ANTHONY** leads the Panthers in scoring (10.7), while pulling down five rebounds per game. **MARTINA KNOTKOVA** is third in the Conference in rebounds at 7.0 boards per contest.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs continued to play well, despite dropping games to James Madison and IUPUI. Sophomore Keena Wicker stepped up and led the Lady Bucs offensively this week, scoring double digits in all three games this week. Wicker led all scoring with a 27-point explosion against James Madison. Senior **LAKESHIA BRYANT** also had another strong week, using a 24-point outing to help lead CSU over Benedict. CSU will take on Eastern Illinois this week before taking a break for Christmas.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal got off to a hot start in its 73-45 win over Savannah State Dec. 16. The Lady Chants lead 11-0 just 2:50 into the game and had a 22-point lead (30-8) at the 7:41 mark. Coastal led by as many as 28 points in the first 20 minutes on its way to its largest winning margin since last year's season opener against Anderson in which the Lady Chants won 76-48. Sophomore VANESSA LAUG had a career high 15 points off the bench in a 73-45 win over Savannah State Dec. 16. She connected on five of her seven field-goal attempts and was 5-of-6 from the free-throw line. Coastal will take 10 days off for the holidays and return to the court Dec. 29 against South Carolina.

HIGH POINT

At the Image Depot Classic High Point was without the services of leading scorer and rebounder Katie O'Dell. HPU was just 3-of-20 (15 percent) from three-point range and shot 31 percent from the floor overall in the Indiana State contest. The Panthers did hold a 44-43 edge on the boards. After seven straight games on the road and some time off for the holidays, the Panthers will return home to play Appalachian State on Sunday, Jan. 2 in the Millis Center at 2:00 pm.

LIBERTY

The Flames hammered Norfolk State in their only action last week. LU will have a 10-day break for the Holidays and will travel to William & Mary Dec. 28, followed by a road trip to American New Year's Eve.

RADFORD

After nine days off, the Highlanders will take on Kent State Tuesday at the Dedmon Center. After a short Holiday break, RU returns to the court Dec. 28 at Memphis and caps off 2004 with a home contest vs. Western Carolina.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have won four in a row and have evened their record at 4-4 on the season. UNCA is currently leading the Conference in field goal percentage and free throw percentage. The Bulldogs are second in scoring averaging a surprising 67.4 points per game. Asheville's run of three-straight 80 point games came to an end as UNCA scored 79 against NC A&T. UNC Asheville's freshmen have made a strong contribution this season, STACY SHEPARD matched her career-highs with 18 points and seven rebounds while ASHTON BARTON scored a career-high 11 points against NC A&T.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles fell to 0-4 on the road this season after losing to Tennessee Tech 74-55. The Lady Eagles haven't won a road game since it's 64-62 last second victory at UNC Asheville in the final regular season game of the 2002-03 season. The streak is now at 18 straight losses on the road. Winthrop looks to end that streak tonight at Tennessee State. Junior guard **ARIN KRESS** has been solid for the Lady Eagles over the last three games. Kress had eight points, seven assists, three rebounds, three steals and just two turnovers against Tennessee Tech. In her last three games she's averaged 10.1 ppg while shooting 57 percent from the field and 40 percent from beyond the arc. She's also been dishing out 4.7 assists and averaging 2.3 steals.
