White averaged 10.0 points, 4.0 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.0 steals in a pair of games last week. Against UMBC, she recorded a career-high 13 points, six rebounds and four assists. In the Highlanders' overtime game vs. Gardner-Webb, White chipped in seven points, had a team and career-best four steals and dished out four assists.

RP-HIGH

In the latest RPI standings, Liberty is sitting pretty at No. 51, the highest the Lady Flames have appeared in the standings since being ranked 53rd on March 15, 2003. It helps that LU's strength of schedule is currently rated 3rd in the country. Coastal Carolina is the next Big South member on the list with a rank of 125, followed by Charleston Southern (261), UNC Asheville (272), High Point (312), Birmingham-Southern (313), Radford (317) and Winthrop (322). Also, nine Big South opponents appear in the top-100 in this week's RPI.

SISTER-SISTER

Charleston Southern took on Kentucky this past weekend, pitting sisters **SARA** and **RACHEL POTTS** against one another for the first time in their collegiate careers. Sara, the elder of the two, went 7-of-17 from the floor and hit 5-of-11 shots from three-point range, leading the Wildcats to an 89-33 victory. Rachel started the game for the Buccaneers and went 0-of-2 from the floor, but pulled down three rebounds.

DEJA VU?

When the Lady Flames fell to the Hokies of Virginia Tech Dec. 7, it marked the second time in school history that Liberty beat a Top-25 team and then lost to Virginia Tech the next home game, as Liberty defeated No. 17 Kansas State, 77-56, prior to facing to the Hokies. The first time it happened came back on November 26, 2002, as the Lady Flames beat No. 25 Virginia, 77-69, in overtime and then fell to the Hokies, 50-53, in the Vines Center.

ARE WE THERE YET?

So far this season, Big South schools have played in 27 road games, which accounts for a little over half (.519) of all contests so far this year. High Point has only seen a home-court advantage once this season, as five of the Panthers' first six games were on the road. HPU won't return to the Millis Center until Jan. 2, 2005. Winthrop has played six of eight games on the road, while Radford has four away contests. Meanwhile, Birmingham-Southern has played five games at home this season and has just its second road test Dec. 20 at South Carolina.

FEENSTRA WATCH

Liberty senior All-American **KATIE FEENSTRA** is quickly climbing the Big South record books this season, and could become just the third Big South women's player to amass 1,500 points and 800 rebounds in her career, having tallied 1,375 points and 598 rebounds. So far this season, Feenstra is first in FG percentage (.667), second in rebounding (9.2) and third in scoring (16.2). She has also tallied two double-doubles, while scoring in double-digits on five occasions.

3-POINT QUEENS

Winthrop's **GENE'T MOORE** has connected on a League-leading 18 treys in seven games for the Eagles this season. Not too far behind Moore are Birmingham-Southern's **STACEY ANTHONY** with 17 and Liberty's **KRISTAL THARP** with 15. Anthony currently ranks 10th nationally with 2.83 3-point FG per game. The Big South record for three-pointers in a season is 91, set by Elon's **LORETTA LAWSON** during the 1999-00 season.

KATIE WHO?

Don't think that Liberty's **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the only Katie making an impact on Big South hoops this season. High Point's **KATIE O'DELL** is stating her cause early, averaging 18.5 points and 9.7 rebounds through six contests. She is 1st in the League in scoring, rebounding and free-throw percentage, while 8th in 3FG percentage and 9th in FG percentage. She has scored double figures in seven of eight games this season. O'Dell is also among the Nation's leaders in free-throw percentage.

TAG TEAM

In what might be the trend for High Point women's hoops this season, KATIE O'DELL and CHARLENA MARTIN have scored in double figures in the same game five times this season, with the feat happening twice last week. Martin had 11 points, while O'Dell added 10 vs. UT-Chattanooga Dec. 6, while they both tallied 17 points against Longwood Dec. 9. The duo also became the first pair of teammates to score 20 or more points in the same game, with O'Dell pouring in 27 points and Martin 24 against Western Carolina, Dec 1. O'Dell and Martin have combined to make up 47 percent (234 points) of the Panthers' offense this season.

HIGH-POINTS

Through three full weeks of action, High Point is leading the Big South in scoring offense with an average of 70.3 points per contest, 4.6 points over next-in-line UNC Asheville (65.7). The Panthers reached the century mark in their second game of the season, routing Queens, 100-58, and have scored at least 72 points in four of seven contests. HPU also is atop the League in rebounds (45.9), blocks (4.57), field goal percentage defense (.383) and offensive rebounds (20.0).

Coastal Carolina head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** earned his 100th victory at Coastal Carolina with a 51-47 win over UNC Wilmington, Nov. 30. He is just the fifth Big South coach to reach the century mark, and is the only coach in Division I to win 100 games in both men's and women's basketball. LeForce is the winningest head coach in Coastal women's basketball history with a record of 100-101, surpassing former Chanticleer head coach **GINA MARKLAND** last season.

CAN I HAVE THE UPSET SPECIAL?

Liberty snapped No. 17 Kansas State's 35-game home winning streak Dec. 4 and picked up the biggest win in the history of the program, downing the Wildcats, 77-56, to win the 10th Annual Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament over the weekend. The win marked just the second time in school history that the Lady Flames' have knocked off a ranked opponent, as LU defeated No. 25 Virginia, 77-69, in overtime at the Vines Center during the 2002-03 season.

HOW YOU DOIN'?

Preseason All-Conference selection **KRISTAL HOOD** dropped 31 points Saturday vs. Wofford and is averaging 15.7 ppg in seven contests. Here's a closer look at Hood and the rest of the Big South Preseason All-Conference squad through three weeks of action:

THREE-POINT PLAY

For the third year in a row, the Big South Conference will be changing up the format for the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship, this time to accommodate television coverage. This year, the four first-round games will be played on the campus of the higher-seeded teams. The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, Mar. 8, with the Semifinals following on Friday, Mar. 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, Mar. 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers won their second game of the season last Tuesday night, defeating Rhodes College, 67-48. Sophomore **BRITNI BALLARD** scored a career-high 10 points in the game, and senior **MARTINA KNOTKOVA** recorded a career high 12 rebounds. Freshman **REBA ROSS** also got in on the action with a career-high six boards. Until the game against Rhodes, all of BSC's games had been decided by nine points or less. Junior **STACEY ANTHONY** leads the team in scoring with 10.7 points per game while Knotkova leads with 7.0 rebounds a contest.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

CSU came up one point short at Morehead State, as it tried to get their first road victory over the weekend. Senior AMANDA EKBERG led all scorers at Morehead State with 13 points and eight rebounds. Junior ERICA MCCOY continued to be strong down low grabbing eight rebounds as CSU out-rebounded MSU 49-42. Sophomore AMBER JAMES led the Lady Bucs offensively against Kentucky with nine points. The contest against UK was the first time CSU had been out-rebounded by an opponent since they played No. 5 North Carolina on Nov. 23.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina will be part of the Carolinas Women's Challenge Dec. 19, at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center. The challenge, which coincides with the Holiday Invitational High School Girls Basketball Tournament, pits the Lady Chants against the College of Charleston at 1 p.m. The University of North Carolina-Georgia State University tilt follows that game. For more information on the holiday tournament, visit www.beachballclassic.com. Coastal faced North Carolina Dec. 12, which was ranked in fifth in the current AP poll, dropping a 94-52 decision. It was Coastal's first game against a ranked opponent since it last faced the Tar Heels, Feb. 24, 2003. North Carolina was #8 at the time and defeated Coastal, 80-48.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers have lost five in a row, including three to Southern Conference schools. **KATIE O'DELL** is a perfect 17-of-17 (1.000) from the charity stripe, which ranks 1st in the Big South and the country. HPU will head down to the Image Depot Classic in Tampa, Fla. to play South Florida and Indiana State this weekend.

LIBERTY

This season's non-conference schedule ranks amongst the toughest that any Liberty women's basketball team has faced. The Lady Flames' schedule ranks third in the nation in the latest WBCA RPI rankings. **KATIE FEENSTRA** moved into third-place all-time in career scoring this past week against Virginia Tech, as she currently has recorded 1,375 points.

RADFORD

In the first six games, Radford has had the game's high scorer five times, but so far it has resulted in just one victory. Radford's guards have accounted for 67 percent (207) of its 307 points so far this season, including 62 percent from its three starters.

UNC ASHEVILLE

Asheville has won three-straight games following an 82-80 overtime victory over Wofford this week. **AMANDA ELDER** (11), **LINDSEY ROCHE** (10), **ASHTON BARTON** (9), and **LAURA KIRBY** (7) all scored season-highs against Wofford as the Bulldogs played without two starters. The Bulldogs have scored in the 80's each of their last three victories, marking the first time in 20 years a UNCA teams has scored at least 80 points in three-straight games. The last time was during the 1984-85 season when Asheville played a NAIA schedule.

WINTHROP

First year head coach **BUD CHILDERS** recorded his first victory with the Lady Eagles in the win over Campbell Saturday. He now has 386 career victories. **IVA MILEVOJ** has continued to play solid for the Lady Eagles at guard. She's started seven of the eight games, averaging 7.4 points, 2.9 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 2.8 steals. In the win over Campbell, Milevoj had 13 points, four assists and three steals. Winthrop is firing up three-pointers at a record rate this season. With only eight games gone, the Lady Eagles have made 50 field goals and are on pace to break the school record of 113 set by the 2000-01 team. Winthrop has put up 133 and is shooting 38 percent as a team from three-point land. The school record for three-point attempts in a season is 396 set by the 2000-01 squad.
