Feenstra collected her 10th and 11th double-doubles of the season last week, averaging 21.5 points and 12.0 rebounds in two contests. At Coastal Carolina, she hit 8-of-9 (.889) field goals for 21 points, collected 12 boards and two blocks and shot .833 percent (5-of-6) from the charity stripe. Against High Point, Feenstra led all scorers with 22 points and had 12 rebounds, four blocks and two assists. Feenstra is currently the only player in the nation to lead her Conference in scoring, field goal percentage, blocks and rebounds.

SHOCKER!

High Point accomplished the unthinkable Saturday, becoming the first Big South foe in 57 Conference meetings to knock of Liberty, bringing two of the longest winning streaks in the nation to an end. The 62-53 Panther victory not only brought the Lady Flames their first League loss since 2001, but it came in the Vines Center, the venue that held a 33-game unblemished mark for the LU women. The 57-game Conference winning streak, which included postseason contests, was the longest streak in the country, while the 33-game home Conference winning streak tied for the second longest. Ironically, Duke University shared that 33-Conference home game mark, and saw it come to an end as well over the weekend. The loss marked only the second time that the Liberty seniors suffered a defeat to a Big South opponent, the first coming to former member Elon on January 21, 2002. High Point is the last current member of the Big South to defeat the Lady Flames, and now have accomplished the feat twice.

DOWN TO THE WIRE

Entering last Saturday's contests, the Lady Flames looked to be a lock for the regular season championship and No. 1 seed in the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament. However, all of that changed when High Point went into Lynchburg and brought home a victory, moving within two games of LU in the Big South standings and having the possibility of sharing the regular season title. LU and HPU have two games left, with both facing Winthrop and Radford in the last week of regular-season action. Meanwhile, UNC Asheville is sitting pretty at 7-5 with games against Charleston Southern and Birmingham-Southern, while Charleston Southern and Radford are still tied with each other at 6-6 with two contests left.

SE-HPU-RATION

Two weeks ago, there was a log jam for second-place in the Big South standings, with UNC Asheville, Charleston Southern and Radford tied at 4-2. However, after six-straight wins by then 3-3 High Point, the Panthers have separated themselves from the rest of that pack, jumping ahead to sole possession of second-place at 9-3, with the Bulldogs trailing at 7-5. The Panthers have split the season series with Liberty, and captured key recent victories over Radford, Coastal Carolina and UNCA.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

RU head coach **JERI PORTER** notched her 100th coaching victory this weekend, defeating Winthrop, 88-50, which was Radford largest margin of victory this season ... After going 11-straight weeks with out recognition in the national polls, Liberty received votes in last week's *ESPN/USA Today/WBCA* poll... LU's **KATIE FEENSTRA** is leading the nation in field goal percentage for the second-straight season and is the only player in the country to lead her Conference in scoring, rebounding, field goal percentage and blocks ... HPU forced Liberty to commit a Conference season-high 25 turnovers Saturday. The Panthers also held the Lady Flames to a mere 17 points in the first half ... CSU's **LAKEISHA BRYANT** and RU's **TARYN CAUSEY** both dished out a Big South-high nine assists last week ... Causey and CSU's **DANIELLE BASKIN** also hit five three-pointers in one game last week ... Radford had five players score in double-figures last against Winthrop, while four High Point teammates tallied double-digits at Liberty ... Within the last two weeks, Winthrop has broken the school's season record for three-pointers made and attempted. The Lady Eagles have two of the Leagues' top-10 three point shooters (**GENE'T MOORE** and **ASHELY CAREY**) ... The Lady Bucs came back from a 26-point deficit in the final nine minutes to beat Radford 72-69, marking the biggest comeback in school history ... Charleston Southern had two players reach the 20-point mark in one game, as **AMANDA EKBERG** tallied 21 points and **LAKEISHA BRYANT** scored 20 against Radford Saturday ... The Big South completed the 2004-05 season with a non-conference mark of 45-57 (.441), the first time in three seasons the League hasn't finished above .500 outside the League.

O-FOR?

With just two regular season contests left, Winthrop is still in search of its first Big South win of 2005. The Lady Eagles have lost 12-straight League contests, longest since the 1994-95 season lost 13 consecutive contests. The last Big South school to have a winless Conference season was UNC Asheville, who finished 2002-03 with a mark of 0-14. However, the Bulldogs bounced back the next season, winning nine League games and earning the Nation's Most Improved Team award. Winthrop still has a chance to earn some wins, facing Liberty and High Point this week.

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO?

Liberty is holding Big South opponents to a mere 49.5 points per game, recently holding Charleston Southern, scoring just 24 points and hitting only nine buckets Feb. 19. The 24 points was a Big South season low, as was the .173 the Lady Bucs shot from the field. CSU holds the single-game record for lowest point total (23) and field goal percentage (.170). Meanwhile, the Lady Flames are ranked 5th nationally in field goal percentage defense and 16th in scoring margin.

Liberty's **KRISTAL THARP** became the latest member of the Big South 1,000 point club, when she reached the milestone against Radford Jan. 29. She joins teammate **KATIE FEENSTRA** (1,679) as the only active Big South players to reach 1,000 points in their careers and the list is three when Radford's **TARYN CAUSEY** (1,403) is added. The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, March 8, with the Semifinals following on Friday, March 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, March 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC won its eighth home game this past Saturday, defeating Charleston Southern, 74-60. The Panthers lost on the road earlier last week to High Point, 66-55. Against CSU, **LAWANDA YOUNG** tied her career high with 16 points, and **STACEY ANTHONY** recorded 13 points in her first game back after suffering an injury. She missed the Panthers' last four games with the injury. Anthony leads BSC with 10.5 points per game and **CRYSTAL REED** leads in rebounding with 6.4 a contest. The Panthers are currently ranked first in the Big South and third in the nation with 13.3 steals per game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The week started with the greatest comeback in women's basketball this season. Led behind **AMANDA EKBERG**'s 21 points, and **LAKESHIA BRYANT**'s 20 points, the Lady Bucs came back from a 26-point deficit in the final nine minutes of the game to beat Radford 72-69. The momentum couldn't spill over as the Lady Bucs hit the road again to face a hot shooting buzz saw in Birmingham-Southern. **DANIELLE BASKIN** was 5-9 from behind the arc, leading CSU with 15 points. Lakeshia Bryant also came on strong with 15 of her own in the loss. CSU will wrap up the regular season with two home games this week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

KIM TURNER scored 18 points and grabbed a career high 13 rebounds in the 59-53 win over Savannah State Feb. 24. Turner also had 17 points and 11 rebounds in a 61-52 loss to High Point Feb. 15. It was the second and third double-doubles of the season for a Coastal player. **DEMARIA YOUNG** went for 14 points and 10 rebounds in a loss to Charleston Southern Jan. 29. **AMBER ROSE** played for the first time in eight games against UNC Asheville Feb. 26. The guard missed the time after suffering an injury Jan. 22 against Winthrop. Rose scored 11 points and was a perfect 3-of-3 from three-point range in the 52-48 loss to UNCA. Coastal will play two road games to end the regular season. The Lady Chants are at Birmingham-Southern Wednesday, March 2 at 8 p.m. EST and face Charleston Southern Saturday, March 5 at 5 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point won its sixth-straight game and ended Liberty's 57-game Big South winning streak with a 62-53 victory over the Lady Flames Saturday in Lynchburg. The Panthers improved to 14-11 (9-3 in the Big South) and stay in second place position in the League. **CHARLENA MARTIN** and **CANDYCE SELLARS** each scored 12 points to lead High Point past the Lady Flames. **KATIE O'DELL** added 10 points and five steals, while **KATIE RALLS** also notched 10 points for the Panthers. Before it was broken, Liberty's 57-game Conference streak was the longest in the nation. The Lady Flames had also won 33-straight Big South home contests since HPU knocked off Liberty on Feb. 17, 2001.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames suffered their first Conference loss since the 2001 season, falling 62-53 to High Point in the Vines Center. **KATIE FEENSTRA** notched her 10th and 11th double-doubles of the season last week. LU will be back in action on Monday night against Winthrop for Senior Night, as it will mark the final home game for five of the Lady Flames' seniors. Tip-off for the game is scheduled for 7 p.m.

RADFORD

Head Coach **JERI PORTER** won her 100th career game when the Highlanders defeated Winthrop on Saturday. Currently in her seventh season, she is 100-88. Also, **TARYN CAUSEY** tied a career-high with nine assists and **KELLI DARDEN** blocked her 50th shot, moving her into third in a RU single season. Radford set a school record for three's in a game against Charleston Southern by going 12-26, breaking the mark of 11 set twice last season. With the road win at Winthrop, RU snapped a six-game road losing streak and avoided becoming the first Highlander team not to win a Conference game on the road.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville guaranteed itself back-to-back winning seasons for the first time since moving to division I in 1986. The Bulldogs went 2-0 last week overcoming a pair of halftime deficits against Winthrop and Coastal Carolina. The win at Coastal was Asheville's first win at Kimbel Arena since the 1995-96 season. **STACY SHEPPARD** scored 17 points just missing her career high against Coastal. She had a career-best 10 rebounds against Winthrop earlier in the week and led the Bulldogs in points and rebounds averaging 11.5 points and 8.0 rebounds in the two games. **ANDREA CLAPP** averaged 10.5 points and 8.0 rebounds for the week scoring in double figures in both games.

WINTHROP

Just a week after breaking the single-season mark for three-pointers made, Winthrop broke the mark for three-pointers attempted. The old record was 396 set by the 2000-01 team and Winthrop has put up 406 on the year while shooting 31 percent. **JOLANDRA CRUMP** has been a solid performer on the boards since Big South play began. In the 12 games she's averaged 7.8 rebounds a game and has pulled down 10 or more rebounds in six Conference games, including three of her last five and five of her last eight games.
