# CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

### Katie Feenstra • Senior C • Liberty Grand Rapids, Mich.

Feenstra led her team to two Big South victories over Winthrop and UNC Asheville, as she averaged 24.5 points and 12.0 rebounds per game, while shooting .633 (19-of-30) from the field. At Winthrop, she tallied 18 points and collected five Against UNCA rebounds. Feenstra poured in 31 points and a season-best 19 rebounds, while knocking in 11-of-19 shots. Also versus the Bulldogs, she picked up her 40th career double-double and became Liberty's all-time shot blocker (224 blocks), surpassing her sister's (Meribeth Anderson) record of 223. She needs one more block to tie the Big South record of 225. Currently, Feenstra is the only player in the nation to rank first in her respective Conference in points, field goal percentage, rebounds and block shots.

# NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

**Raven Truslow** G • High Point Charlottesville, Va.

Truslow scored 10 points for her fifth double-digit game of the season and provided four rebounds, three assists, and two steals in HPU's win over Radford. She then added eight points, three rebounds, two assists, and two steals at home against Charleston Southern. For the week, Truslow averaged 9.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 2.0 steals.

#### ITS LONELY AT THE TOP

With the second round of Big South competition under way, Liberty is still standing strong atop the League at 8-0, and winning those games by an average of 21.9 points. With a current record of 16-5, the Lady Flames have already claimed their 10th-consecutive winning season and 13th winning season in school history. LU is riding a 54-game Conference winning streak, including postseason play, dating back to the 2001-02 season and hasn't lost to a current Big South member since dropping a 58-53 decision to High Point on Feb. 17, 2001. Liberty has already knocked off everyone in the League in the first go-around of Big South action and swept UNC Asheville.

#### **ROAD WOES**

Big South teams are having a tough time finding victories on the road this season. The combined mark of League teams on the road is a dismal 20-55 (.266), with Liberty the only squad with a winning record of 7-3. On the flip side, the Big South is holding a strong record of 53-25 (.679) at home venues this year, with seven teams posting winning home records.

#### **30-SECOND TIMEOUT**

High Point's CHARLENA MARTIN overcame her recent shooting slump by posting back-to-back performances of 24 and 21 points in two HPU victories ... CCU's DEMARIA YOUNG pulled down 10 rebounds vs. Birmingham-Southern, tying her season-best performance ... LU's KATIE FEENSTRA (31) and KRISTAL THARP (20) combined for their second game of the season with both scoring 20 or points against UNC Asheville, however the Bulldogs had 18 assists on 21 made baskets against Charleston Southern ... The Lady Chanticleers pulled down 18 more rebounds than BSC, a season's best rebounding margin for Coastal ... Winthrop became the first Big South team to pull ahead at half-time against Liberty, however, the Lady Flames held the Lady Eagles to just 18 second-half points to get the victory ... RU's KELLI DARDEN has blocked a whopping 46 shots in her rookie season, including 29 in Big South competition ... After averaging a fiery 17.3 points in her first six Big South games, CSU's KEENA WICKER had been held to just 8.0 points in her last two Conference games.

#### STATING HER CAUSE

Radford's TARYN CAUSEY has been lighting up the scoreboard for the Highlanders this season, especially when it comes to taking on Big South opponents. She is the top Big South scorer in Conference play at 18.0 points per game and is the second-leading scorer in all games played this season (15.5 ppg). In the Highlanders' first eight games, she averaged 12.5 points and shot just .326 from the field. However, in her last 12 games, Causey has tallied 18.1 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.9 assists and 2.9 steals per contest, while shooting .454 from the floor and .434 from beyond the arc. Causey has put up 11 or more points in Radford's Conference games, including five games of 18+ points, and recently knocked in 5-of-6 three-pointers at Birmingham-Southern.

#### FEAR THE FEENSTRA

Big South Preseason Conference Player of the Year KATIE FEENSTRA is certainly holding up her end of the bargain, averaging 17.1 points and 10.1 rebounds per game this season, while shooting an impressive .682 from the floor. Feenstra is the only player in the country to lead her Conference in scoring (17.1), rebounding (10.1), FG percentage (.682) and blocks (2.35). After scoring 17 points against Charleston Southern in Week Eight, she became just the third Big South women's player to amass 1,500 points and 800 rebounds in her career. Feenstra accomplished the second half of that feat in Week Six. She can also become the League's all-time career shot blocker, only needing one more stop to tie the record of 225 and two to surpass the milestone.

#### WE'VE GOT O'DELL

Don't think that Liberty's **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the only Katie making an impact on Big South hoops this season. High Point's **KATIE O'DELL** is pouring in 15.5 points and 8.5 rebounds a game through 19 contests. She is currently 3rd in the League in scoring, 2nd in rebounding, 8th in free-throw percentage and 9th in three-point field goals per game. O'Dell has scored double figures in 16 of 19 games played this season and is credited with six double-doubles, with her latest coming against Charleston Southern (11 points, 15 rebounds).

#### PUT UP YOUR DUKES

Despite Winthrop's 2-19 record, the Lady Eagles have somethings to smile about. WU is getting solid performances out of **JESSICA DUKES**, who is averaging 11.0 points and 6.5 rebounds in Big South contests. She currently is eighth in League scoring and tied for fifth in rebounds. Dukes put up spectacular numbers last week, with 17 points against Liberty and 15 at Coastal Carolina. Winthrop also leans on **GENE'T MOORE**, who adds 10.4 points to WU's offense in Big South contests and is first in three-point field goals made (2.25) in League games.

For the third year in a row, the Big South Conference will be changing up the format for the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship, this time to accommodate television coverage. This year, the four first-round games will be played on the campus of the higher-seeded teams. The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, March 8, with the Semifinals following on Friday, March 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, March 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

#### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### **BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN**

In the Panthers' 66-55 victory over Radford, **BRITNI BALLARD** and **MUNECA OLIVER** both recorded careerhigh point totals. Ballard scored 14 points, while Oliver tallied 12 points. **CRYSTAL REED** also grabbed a career-high eight steals, which ties the BSC single-game record. So far in 2004-05, the Panthers have played well at home, going 7-4 at Bill Battle Coliseum. The Panthers are also 3-1 in Big South action at home, with the only loss coming at the hands of UNC Asheville, Jan. 15. After dropping two road games at CSU and CCU, the Panthers are now 1-8 in away games so far this season. BSC's only road win was a three-point victory at McNeese State, Dec. 30, and the Panthers are 0-4 in Big South road games.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Charleston Southern broke its five game-winning streak at UNC-Asheville, and wasn't able to bounce back against High Point. Both teams were able to put out the fire that was **KEENA WICKER**. Instead the team looked to **LAKESHIA BRYANT**, who led the team in both games, scoring 13 points against Asheville, and 12 points against High Point. She had three assists in each game. **DANIELLE BASKIN** also scored 12 points against High Point, shooting 4-7 from three point range. Despite the loss, the Lady Bucs out rebounded both opponents.

#### **COASTAL CAROLINA**

CCU outrebounded Birmingham-Southern, 43-25, in its 55-42 win over Birmingham-Southern Feb. 7. The Lady Chants had three players with eight or more rebounds, including **DEMARIA YOUNG's** 10 boards. **COURTNEY BROWN** had nine rebounds, while **VANESSA LAUG** had a career-high eight. The plus-18 rebounding margin was the highest by the Lady Chants this season. After scoring only 19 points and shooting 21.4 percent in the first half, CCU exploded for 34 points in the second half in a 53-45 win over Winthrop Feb. 12. The Lady Chants went 13-of-27 from the field in the second stanza. Junior **KIM TURNER** had 12 second-half points, while classmate **JASMINE TYLER** added nine.

#### HIGH POINT

The Panthers have won the last two games to give them a 7-1 record at home. HPU continues its home court advantage on Tuesday when Coastal Carolina visits. High Point has already split the season with Charleston Southern, losing by three at CSU, 53-50, and winning at home by four, 60-56. The Panthers downed Coastal Carolina (65-47) in Conway on Jan. 24 and look for another victory on Tuesday. HPU will visit UNC Asheville on Saturday at 2:00 pm.

#### LIBERTY

The Lady Flames have posted their 10th-consecutive winning season and their 13th winning season in school history during the 2004-05 campaign with a 16-5 record. The last non-winning season for the team came in the 1996 campaign when the Lady Flames posted an overall record of 5-22. The Lady Flames are currently rank amongst the best in the NCAA ... Liberty enters this week ranked 3rd in the nation in rebound margin (11.0), 5th in the nation in defensive field goal percentage (34.3), 13th in field goal percentage (46.7), while ranking in the Top 50 in scoring margin (33rd, 12.4), won-lost percentage (39th, 76.2), scoring defense (44th, 56.8) and three point field goal percentage (50th, 34.8).

#### **RADFORD**

Freshman **KELLI DARDEN** is making a name for herself as she continues to be a defensive presence down on in the paint. This season, she has blocked 46 shots, 29 in eight Big South games. She is leading the League (Conference games only) in blocks per game at 3.6 and is just two blocks behind League leader **KATIE FEENSTRA**, who has led the Conference the last two years.

#### UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville added a new weapon to its arsenal, the three-point shot, this week. The Bulldogs hit a season-hit high nine three-pointers on way to a 63-49 victory over Charleston Southern and then hit eight 3's in a 74-62 loss at Liberty. In the last two games, Asheville is 17-of-32 for 53.1 percent behind the arc. With the win over Charleston Southern, the Bulldogs are now 9-2 at home this season. **ASHTON BARTON** and **ANDREA CLAPP** each reached double-figures for the third-straight game against the Lady Bucs. **KATIE BALDWIN** scored a career-high 15 points in the loss at Liberty, while **KRISTAL HOOD** scored 20 points against the Lady Flames.

#### **WINTHROP**

The loss at Coastal extended Winthrop's losing streak to 11 games, which is the longest since the 1994-95 season. That year the Lady Eagles dropped a school record 13 in a row. The loss was also the teams' eighth-straight in the Big South. The team record for consecutive conferences losses is nine. Also set by the 1994-95 team. This season the Lady Eagles have not been gunshy from beyond the arc. Through 21 games they've attempted 340 three-pointers, an average of 16.19 per game. At this pace, Winthrop is going to eclipse the single-season record for three-point attempts of 396 set by the 2000-01 team. Winthrop has made 106 three-pointers (5.04 per game). With seven games left the Lady Eagles will easily break the record for three-point field goals made in a single season of 113, also set by the 2000-01 squad.
