O'Dell, while helping High Point to its eighth-straight victoand a second-place Conference finish, collected her seventh double-double of the season at Radford, hitting 7-of-13 (.538) from the floor for 16 points and adding game-high 12 rebounds, four assists and three steals. She followed that up with a game-high 17 points against Winthrop, while shooting a fiery .571 percent (3-of-4) from beyond the arc and tallying three assists and four steals. For the week, O'Dell averaged 16.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 3.5 assists, 3.5 steals and shot .545 percent both the floor and beyond the three-point line.

NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

Kelli Darden C • Radford Chesapeake, Va.

Darden averaged 9.5 points, four rebounds, while shooting .545 percent from the floor in two games last week for the Highlanders. She recorded a team-high 13 points on 4-of-5 shooting, to go along with seven rebounds and three blocks vs. High Point. Darden then added six points, a rebound and a steal against Liberty.

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern earned the fourth seed in the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship by virtue of a tie-breaker over Charleston Southern. The Panthers split the season with the Lady Buccaneers, but held an advantage over CSU by beating UNC Asheville on Saturday ... Tuesday will be BSC's second appearance in the Big South Tournament, as the Panthers we first eligible last season due to NCAA Division I reclassification standards ... Birmingham-Southern advanced to the Championship game in 2004 and was defeated by Liberty, 54-41.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Charleston Southern will meet Birmingham-Southern for the third time this season, but only the first time in postseason play ... Charleston Southern is 2-4 in the last three seasons in Tournament play and has never advanced to the Championship Final ... CSU comes into the Touranment ranked second in free-throw percentage (.715) ... KEENA WICKER has recorded three 20+ point games, including scoring a career-high 27 points vs. James Madison Dec. 16. ... LAKESHIA BRYANT leads the Lady Bucs in Conference scoring (12.4) and ranks fourth in League assists (3.36) and fifth in free-throw percentage (.786).

COASTAL CAROLINA

Tuesday will mark the third time in five years that Coastal Carolina and High Point have met in the Big South Tournament quarterfinals, with CCU knocking off High Point most recently last season, 68-62 ... KIM TURN-ER ranks fourth in League scoring at 13.4 points per contest and has reached the 20-point plateau five times this season ... Coach ALAN LEFORCE has led the Lady Chants to the Big South semifinals the last three season and reached the Championship Game in 2002.

HIGH POINT

High Point ended its Conference season with a mark of 11-3, the best record in the Panthers' short stint with the Big South ... HPU closed out the season on an eight-game winning streak -- the longest in its short Division I history -- after starting a dissapointing 2-7 ... The Panthers became the first team to beat Liberty since the 2001 season and snapped the Lady Flames' 33-game home Conference winning streak, the second longest in the nation ... KATIE O'DELL is second in the Conference with six double-doubles and has reached double-figures in 11 of 14 League contests ... The Panthers rank third in the League in scoring defense, giving up 56.3 points per game, and rank first in three-point field goal percentage defense , holding Big South opponents to a dismal .272 percent from beyond the arc.

LIBERTY

Liberty enters the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship looking to tie Radford's record of nine Big South Championhips. Liberty has caputured the Conference crown the past eight years and is a perfect 17-0 under Coach **CAREY GREEN** in tournament games ... **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the only player in the nation to lead her Conference in scoring (17.3), rebounding (10.3), field goal percentage (.692) and blocks (2.58). She also ranks tops in the country in field goal percentage and has not shot below .500 in all but one League games this season ... The Lady Flames have faced Winthrop just twice in the Big South Tournament, capturing a 63-50 semifinal win in 1997 and an 81-47 quarterfinal victory last season.

RADFORD

Radford went on an eight-game winning streak in the middle of the season, including opening Conference season at 3-0, then lost 8 of its last 12 contests to finish the regular season at 12-15 ... Since the change in the format, Radford will be on the road for the third straight season in the first round of the Big South Tournament. The Highlanders are 28-9 in Tournament games and are 4-1 against first round opponent UNC Asheville ... TARYN CAUSEY has recorded six 20+ point games this year and is second in Big South scoring (15.6), first in assists (4.07), first in free-throw percentage (.881) and second in steals (2.93).

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville recorded its second back-to-back winning season, two years after finishing a dismal 1-27 in 2001-02. The Bulldogs will take on Radford in the opening round of the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship for the first time since losing to the Highlanders in the quarterfinals of the 1999 Championship ... KRISTAL HOOD ranks seventh in League scoring at 11.3 points per contest, second in free-throw percentage (.875) and sixth in steals (2.14).

WINTHROP

Winthrop lost its final regular season game against High Point and finished the conference season 0-14. It was the first time Winthrop had ever finished with less than two victories in the Big South. In the process, the team extended its school record losing streak to 17 games. The last Big South school to have a winless Conference season was UNC Asheville, who also finished with a mark of 0-14 in 2002-03 ... The Lady Eagles have advanced only twice to the Big South Tournament semifinals since 1997 ... GENE'T MOORE heads into the Tournament leading the Conference in three-point field goals made per contest, while JOLANDRA CRUMP ranks second in rebounds, pulling down 7.2 an outing.
