CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Charlena Martin • Senior G • High Point Greenville, S.C.

Martin recorded one of her most consistent weeks this season, averaging 15.0 points, 5.0 assists, 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals in two key Big South victories that vaulted the Panthers into sole-possession of second place in the Conference standings. Against Coastal Carolina, she tallied 16 points and four assists. On the road at UNC Asheville, Martin poured in 16 points and added five rebounds, six assists and three steals, while shooting .438 (7-of-16) from the floor and .500 (2-of-4) from the three-point line. Martin is ranked in the top-five in Conference scoring (14.1), assists (3.6) and steals (2.2).

NEW BALANCE Freshman of the Week

Ashton Barton G • UNC Asheville Rosman, N.C.

Barton recorded careerhighs in points and rebounds last week with a 17-point, eight-rebound performance against High Point. She went 5of-11 from the floor, including 2-for-4 from three-point range and 5-of-8 from the line. Barton added three points and five boards at Radford. For the week, she averaged 10.0 points and 6.5 rebounds per contest, while shooting .500 from beyond the arc.

STILL STANDING

Liberty is still standing strong atop the League standings at 10-0, and doing it quite easily as the Lady Flames are winning Big South games by an average of 24.7 points. With a current record of 18-5, the Lady Flames have already claimed their 10th-consecutive winning season and 13th winning season in school history. LU is riding a 57-game Conference winning streak, including postseason play, dating back to the 2001-02 season and hasn't lost to a current Big South member since dropping a 58-53 decision to High Point on Feb. 17, 2001. Liberty has already knocked off everyone in the League in the first goaround of Big South action and swept UNC Asheville, Birmingham-Southern and Charleston Southern.

PANTHERS CLAW THEIR WAY UP

After four-straight wins, High Point has clawed its way out of a log jam to stand solo at second-place in the Conference standings. The Panthers captured key victories recently over Radford, Coastal Carolina and UNC Asheville, with all, except CCU, at one point in the season being in a race for second place. HPU will take on Birmingham-Southern tonight before traveling up to Liberty for a hopeful upset of the top Conference squad.

RECORD WATCHIN'

LU's **KATIE FEENSTRA** and RU's **TARYN CAUSEY** are enjoying outstanding senior seasons, and are looking to etch their name in the Big South Record Books. Both are challenging a few Big South marks this year:

HOW LOW CAN YOU GO?

Liberty is holding Big South opponents to a mere 48.2 points per game, with its latest foe, Charleston Southern, scoring just 24 points and hitting only nine buckets Feb. 19. The 24 points was a Big South season low, as was the .173 the Lady Bucs shot from the field. CSU holds the single-game record for lowest point total (23) and field goal percentage (.170). Meanwhile, the Lady Flames are ranked 5th nationally in field goal percentage defense and 26th in scoring margin.

TARYN' IT UP

Radford's **TARYN CAUSEY** has quietly worked her way to the top of the Conference Scoring list, averaging 16.2 points per game and is the third-leading scorer in all games played this season (14.9 ppg). In addition, Causey is adding 4.6 rebounds, 4.0 assists and 3.2 steals in Big South contests, while shooting .456 from the floor, .395 behind the arc and .855 from the charity stripe. Causey has put up 11 or more points in nine of Radford's 10 Conference games, including five games of 18+ points, and recently knocked in 5-of-6 three-pointers at Birmingham-Southern.

FEAR THE FEENSTRA

Big South Preseason Conference Player of the Year KATIE FEENSTRA is certainly holding up her end of the bargain, averaging 16.6 points and 9.9 rebounds per game this season, while shooting an impressive .686 from the floor. Feenstra is the only player in the country to lead her Conference in scoring (16.6), rebounding (9.9), FG percentage (.686) and blocks (2.41). After scoring 17 points against Charleston Southern in Week Eight, she became just the third Big South women's player to amass 1,500 points and 800 rebounds in her career. Feenstra accomplished the second half of that feat in Week Six. She also become the League's all-time career shot blocker after tallying four at Birmingham-Southern to surpass the record of 225 and now has 228 career blocks.

CENTURY MARKERS

In just her seventh season leading the Highlanders head coach, **JERI PORTER** is looking to capture her 100th victory. She is just one win away from accomplishing that feat, as her record stands at 99-87. Earlier this season, Coastal Carolina head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** earned his 100th victory at Coastal Carolina with a 51-47 win over UNC Wilmington, Nov. 30. He is just the fifth Big South coach to reach the century mark, and is the only coach in Division I to win 100 games in both men's and women's basketball.

WE'VE GOT O'DELL

Just like the computer, High Point's KATIE O'DELL has been a consistent performer for the Panthers this season. She is pouring in 15.0 points and 8.1 rebounds a game through 21 contests. She is currently 3rd in the League in scoring, 2nd in rebounding, 7th in free-throw percentage and 10th in three-point field goals per game. O'Dell has scored double figures in 18 of 21 games played this season and is credited with six double-doubles, with her latest coming against Charleston Southern (11 points, 15 rebounds).

The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, March 8, with the Semifinals following on Friday, March 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, March 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers defeated Winthrop last Saturday, finally winning a Conference road game and only their second road game of the season. BSC is now 2-1 without leading scorer STACEY ANTHONY, who is out temporarily with an injury. BSC, ranked third in the nation in steals per game, grabbed 17 more steals against Winthrop. Sophomore BRITNI BALLARD tied her career-high against Winthrop with 14 points and junior LAWANDA YOUNG led all scorers with 15 points.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs split last week, dropping their second game after a strong win at Winthrop. At Winthrop, the Lady Bucs used three strong performances to put together a solid victory. Sophomore **KEENA WICKER** got back on track leading CSU with 15 points and five rebounds. Junior **ERICA MCCOY** was next with 13 points, including connecting on her first three-point attempt on the season. Senior **AMANDA EKBERG** stepped back up and scored 10 points for the first time since Dec. 16. The second game of the week was a different story for the Lady Bucs as they struggled offensively, shooting just 17 percent for the game including going 1-13 from behind the arc vs. Liberty.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior KIM TURNER had 17 points and 11 rebounds in a 61-52 loss to High Point Feb. 15. It was the second double-double of the season for a Coastal playe as junior DEMARIA YOUNG went for 14 points and 10 rebounds in a loss to Charleston Southern Jan. 29. Coastal Carolina came through in the gut check time in the 50-46 win over Radford Feb. 19. In the last four minutes of the game, the Lady Chants were 3-of-4 from the field and 4-of-5 from the line. Radford tied the game twice in the last four minutes, but Coastal had an answer from the line as Turner and freshman C.J. WARE hit two free throws a piece to ice the game.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers won their fourth-straight game and kept sole possession of second place in the Big South with their Saturday win over UNC Asheville. High Point returns home on Monday to play Birmingham-Southern in the Millis Center at 7:00 pm.

LIBERTY

LU used an 18-0 run to start off the first-half and never looked back, as the Lady Flames claimed its 10th Big South win of the season over Charleston Southern, 67-24. Liberty held CSU to a season-low .173 from the field and only nine made baskets. Liberty will be back in action on Monday at Coastal Carolina. The Lady Flames need two more wins to claim the Big South regular season title.

RADFORD

JERI PORTER's next victory will be her 100th as she is 99-87 in her seventh season as a head coach. Radford has lost its last five road games and is just 2-9 away from the Dedmon Center this season. Away, the Highlanders are only averaging 53.9 ppg and shooting 35.3 percent, while allowing 62.1 ppg and 42.3 percent shooting. At home, RU is scoring 64.8 ppg and shooting 39.3 percent, while giving up only 54.0 ppg and holding its opponents to 34.5 percent shooting. Senior JESSE BRUNJAK scored a careerhigh 24 points and tied a school and Dedmon Center record by going 6-of-9 from three point land against UNC Asheville. She tied the mark of six three-point field goals held by KYLIE WILLIAMSON (twice) and PATRINDA TONEY. Williamson and Toney also share the Dedmon Center record.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville has lost three-straight games for the first time since beginning the season 0-4. The Bulldogs struggled from the floor last week, shooting 34 percent from the floor and 21 percent from three-point range in losses to Radford and High Point. KRISTAL HOOD scored 28 points at Radford, while ASHTON BARTON recorded career-highs in points with 17 and rebounds with eight against High Point. The Bulldogs have not lost back-to-back games at the Justice Center in two years and will try to continue that streak as they host Winthrop on Wednesday.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles lost both games last week and are riding a 13-game losing streak, which ties for the school record held by the 1994-95 team. In the loss to Birmingham-Southern Saturday, **KATIE KILCOLLIN** led the Lady Eagles with a season-high 14 points. She hit a career-best four three-pointers (4-for-5 from three) and also had four steals. Winthrop hit six three-pointers against Birmingham-Southern on Saturday and in the process broke the single-season school record for three-pointers made. The previous record was 113 set by the 2000-01 team. Winthrop reached the record in 15 fewer attempts and is likely to break the attempt record in its next game.
