Margeviciute averaged 17.7 points and 5.0 rebounds last week in games against Virginia, Tennessee State and No. 17 Kansas State, while shooting a staggering 62.5 percent from the field, including 85.7 from behind the arc. She poured in a career-high 23 points to go along with eight rebounds at UVA, accounting for almost half of the Lady Flames' point total (58). She chipped in 14 points vs. Tennessee State in the opening game of the Commerce Bank Wildcat Classic and followed that up with a 16-point effort in the championship game against the host Wildcats. Her solid contributions helped Liberty snap Kansas State's 35-game home winning streak and earned her all-tournament team accolades.

ROLI-ANN NIKAGBATSE, G/F, LIBERTY
Averaged 4.0 PTS, 6.7 RBS in 3 G ... Game-high 13 RBS vs. #17 Kansas State

CAN I HAVE THE UPSET SPECIAL?

Liberty snapped No. 17 Kansas State's 35-game home winning streak and picked up the biggest win in the history of the program, downing the Wildcats, 77-56, to win the 10th Annual Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament over the weekend. The win marked just the second time in school history that the Lady Flames' have knocked off a ranked opponent, as LU defeated No. 25 Virginia, 77-69, in overtime at the Vines Center during the 2002-03 season.

100+

Coastal Carolina head coach **ALAN LEFORCE** earned his 100th victory at Coastal Carolina with a 51-47 win over UNC Wilmington Nov. 30. He is just the fifth Big South coach to reach the century mark, and is believed to be the only coach in Division I to win 100 games in both men's and women's basketball. LeForce is the winningest head coach in Coastal women's basketball history with a record of 100-101, surpassing former Chanticleer head coach **GINA MARKLAND** last season. Overall, LeForce is 340-280 in 22 years as a head coach.

FEENSTRA WATCH

Liberty senior All-American **KATIE FEENSTRA** is quickly climbing the Big South record books this season, and could become just the third Big South women's player to amass 1,500 points and 800 rebounds in her career, having tallied 1,343 points and 581 rebounds. So far this season, Feenstra is leading the Big South in rebounds (9.5), field-goal percentage (.684) and blocks (2.0). She has also tallied two double-doubles, while scoring in double-digits on three occasions.

3-POINT QUEENS

Winthrop's **GENE'T MOORE** has connected on a League-leading 16 treys in seven games for the Eagles this season. Not too far behind Moore are Birmingham-Southern's **STACEY ANTHONY** and Liberty's **KRISTAL THARP** with 12 apiece. The Big South record for three-pointers in a season is 91, set by Elon's **LORETTA LAWSON** during the 1999-2000 season.

WHICH KATIE?

Don't think that Liberty's **KATIE FEENSTRA** is the only Katie making an impact on Big South hoops this season. High Point's **KATIE O'DELL** is stating her cause early, averaging 21.0 points and 9.2 rebounds through four contests. She is first in the League in free-throw percentage, second in scoring and rebounds, 10th in field goal percentage and and steals. O'Dell dropped a career-high 31 points in High Point's season-opening win over Campbell, while adding 12 rebounds for her fifth-career double-double.

TAG TEAM

In what might be the trend for High Point women's hoops this season, **KATIE O'DELL** and **CHARLENA MARTIN** scored in double figures in the same game for the third time against Western Carolina Dec. 1. The duo became the first pair of teammates to score 20 or more points in the same game, with O'Dell pouring in 27 points, while Martin added 24. O'Dell and Martin have combined to make up 52 percent (173 points) of the Panthers' offense this season. Liberty's scoring pair of **KATIE FEENSTRA** and **KRISTAL THARP** combined for Liberty's scoring threat against No. 17 Kansas State, as Tharp had 26 points and Feenstra tallied 22.

TWO-TIMING

For the first two weeks of Big South reporting, UNC Asheville freshman **STACY SHEPARD** had grabbed both Freshman of the Week honors. She is the first freshman to earn the honor the first two weeks of the season since teammate **KRISTAL HOOD** at the beginning of the 2002-03 campaign. Shepard is averaging 9.5 points per game, while shooting .629 (22-of-35) from the field, which is second in the Conference behind All-America **KATIE FEENSTRA**.

DOUBLE-DIGITS

Sixteen Big South women's basketball players are scoring in double-digits so far in the opening weeks of play. Charleston Southern (**LAKEISHA BRYANT** - 12.2, **ERICA MCCOY** - 11.2, **KEENA WICKER** - 10.2), Coastal Carolina (**KIM TURNER** - 10.2, **JASMINE TYLER** - 10.2, **COURTNEY BROWN** - 10.0) and Liberty (**KATIE FEENSTRA** - 16.8, **RIMA MARGEVICIUTE** - 14.4, **KRISTAL THARP** - 13.2) boast three players in the top-16, while High Point (**CHARLENA MARTIN** - 22.2, **KATIE O'DELL** - 21.0) and Radford (**JESSE BRUNJAK** - 13.8, **TARYN CAUSEY** - 10.2) list two players. Birmingham-Southern (**STACEY ANTHONY** - 10.8), UNC Asheville (**KRISTAL HOOD** - 13.2) and Winthrop (**GENE'T MOORE** - 10.0) each have one each scoring in double-figures.

HIGH-POINTS

Through two full weeks of action, High Point is leading the Big South in scoring offense with an average of 83.2 points per contest, a whopping 15.8 points over next-in-line Liberty (67.4). The Panthers reached the century mark in their second game of the season, routing Queens, 100-58, and have not scored less than 72 points in four contests. HPU also is atop the League in rebounds (47.5), blocks (5.0), turnover margin (+6.25), offensive rebounds (22.0) and three-point FG made (7.0).

1-2-3 BREAK

As the end of the 2004 fall semester winds down, Big South student-athletes will be focused heavily on exams, which means a break in the schedule. Most League schools' loads will lighten within the next two weeks in preparation for those end-of-the-year finals.

THREE-POINT PLAY

For the third year in a row, the Big South Conference will be changing up the format for the 2005 Advance Auto Parts Women's Basketball Championship to accommodate television coverage. This year, the four first-round games will be played on the campus of the higher-seeded teams. The teams that advance will play the two Semifinal games and Championship game at the site of the Big South regular-season champion. The opening round of this year's Conference tournament will be held on Tuesday, Mar. 8, with the semifinals following on Friday, Mar. 11. The Championship Game will be played on Saturday, Mar. 12 at 2:00pm. Last season, each round of the Conference tournament was played at the campus of the higher-seeded team, while in 2003, the first rounds were played on campus sites, with a "final four" played in Lynchburg, Va.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers played their first road game of the season last Thursday night, traveling eight miles down the road to play Samford. BSC lost the close game, 70-65, and Samford moved to 4-0 to remain undefeated. **STACEY ANTHONY** leads the team with 10.2 points per game, and **MARTINA KNOTKOVA** and **CRYSTAL REED** are both tops in rebounding with 6.0 boards a game. Reed is also putting up 9.0 points a contest, while Knotkova is averaging 8.2.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

LAKESHIA BRYANT continues to lead the Lady Bucs offensively, averaging 12.2 points per game, scoring 49 points in four games so far for CSU. **ERICA MCCOY** is second with 45 points on the season, including an 18 point output against North Carolina A&T. McCoy also has 26 rebounds on the season to lead CSU. The Lady Bucs will take their two-game winning streak on the road this week as they face Morehead State and the University of Kentucky.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Lady Chanticleers cannot be accused of being "Grinches" during this holiday season, as they have shown the ability to share the rock. Coastal has five players averaging six points or more in the first four games, led by juniors **JASMINE TYLER** and **KIM TURNER**'s 10.3 points a game. Coastal will have the upcoming week off for finals and will return to the court Sunday, Dec. 12 against North Carolina. The Tar heels are ranked as high as second in the latest polls and it will be Coastal's first road game of the season. Game time is at 1 p.m. at Carmichael Auditorium.

HIGH POINT

In High Point's lone contest of the week, the Panthers led by as many as 16 points in the second half before Western Carolina stormed back to claim a 95-85 home win on Wednesday. The Catamounts survived 27 points and nine rebounds from **KATIE O'DELL** and 24 points and six assists from **CHARLENA MARTIN**. HPU has scored at least 72 points in all five contests this season, and 85 or more points in three games. The Panthers are shooting 41 percent from the field. The Panthers are two contests into a seven-game stretch away from home, and visit Chattanooga, Longwood and UNC Greensboro this week. High Point's next home game is Jan. 2, 2005, against Appalachian State.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames dominated the glass this past week, out-rebounding their opponents by 12.3 rebounds per game. At the Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament, Liberty outrebounded their opponents by 20.0 boards a game, pulling down 60 against Tennessee State and 42 against No. 17 Kansas State. At the 10th Annual Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament, senior **KATIE FEENSTRA** added another award to her collection as she was named the tournament MVP. During her two games, Feenstra averaged 19.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.5 assists per game, while shooting 81.3 percent from the field and 81.3 percent from the free throw line.

RADFORD

Radford has scored less than 60 points in its first four games, averaging 50.5 points during this stretch. It is the first time since the 1972-73 season, the Highs have not scored 60+ points in at least one of their first four games. Radford has started 0-4 for the first time since the 1998-99 season and have only started 0-5 one other time in school history (1996-97).

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have won two-straight after defeating Western Carolina in the fifth-annual Mountain Hoops Classic. UNCA had four players score in double figures as it scored a season-high 82 points against the Catamounts. **KRISTAL HOOD**'s streak of four-straight games in double figures came to an end against Montreat but **STACY SHEPARD** and **KATIE BALDWIN** have been in double figures in the last two games. Baldwin has made her last 12 free throws and is 14-16 from the stripe this season. She and **ALLI OPFER** recorded career-highs in points against Montreat and **ANDREA CLAPP** matched her career-high with 16 points against Western Carolina. Asheville has shot over 50 percent from the floor in its last two games.

WINTHROP

After six of the first seven games away from home that included three tournaments, the Lady Eagles finally get a break. The team will have its next game at home on Dec. 11 at 7 p.m. vs. Campbell and then will hit the road again for games on the 19th and 21st. **ARIN KRESS** was named to the All-Tournament team at the Brown Classic for averaging 13 points, 4.5 rebounds, 6.5 assists and 2.0 steals in the two losses. She shot 63 percent from the field.
