## CHOICE HOTELS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Jessica Moore • Sophomore SS • Liberty Chesapeake, Va.

Moore led the Lady Flames last week, batting .385 (5-13), with a double, one home run, two runs batted in and a .692 slugging percentage. Against Radford, she was a combined 3-6 (.500) with a double and a stolen base in helping the Lady Flames split a Conference doubleheader with the Highlanders. She then helped Liberty pick up its first road victory of the season at Birmingham-Southern, going 2-4 with the gamewinning two-run homer in the sixth inning of Game Two. Moore's homer against the Panthers marked her 17th round tripper of the year, which ties LU's single season record for home runs.

## NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Ashley Taylor • Freshman Radford Ringgold, Va.

Taylor went 2-0 with a 0.54 ERA on the road against Conference foes Liberty and Birmingham-Southern. She struck out 16 batters and did not allow a walk in 13 innings of work. The rookie tossed a three-hit complete game shutout vs. the Panthers, striking out eight batters. Against the Lady Flames, she went six innings and allowed just one run on six hits and tallied eight more strikeouts, helping the Highlanders to an 8-4 finish in the Big South -- their best since completing the 1999 season with a 10-4 Conference mark.

#### NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

#### **BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN**

The Panthers went 3-4 this week in a homestand that closed out their regular season schedule, losing to No. 8 Alabama, sweeping Austin Peay, splitting with Liberty, and getting swept by Radford. The 0-8 five-inning loss to Radford on Senior Day was BSC's first time this season on the losing end of a game ended early due to the eight-run rule. The Austin Peay sweep was the Panthers' first home doubleheader sweep since the season opener against Alabama A&M, Feb. 12. Junior NIKKI ROMBOUGH has battled through a shoulder injury but still leads the team batting .366 with 13 doubles, two triples, two home runs and 35 RBI.

#### **CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

Freshman JILL SHONDEL still leads the team offensively, hitting .353 on the season. She has amassed 26 RBI this season, which is tied for the team lead with junior KATIE MCKAY. McKay leads the Lady Bucs in home runs, smashing five this season. The Lady Bucs will take the field again Friday as they travel to Winthrop to wrap up the Conference season.

#### **COASTAL CAROLINA**

The Chanticleers will close out the regular season this week, facing Winthop in a Conference doubleheader in Conway, S.C. Gametime is set for 2:00 pm.

#### LIBERTY

JESSICA MOORE's two-run homer in the sixth inning not only lifted the Lady Flames to a 5-3 Big South win over Birmingham-Southern on Saturday, but it also tied the school's single season home run record as Moore is now tied with record holder SHANNON TANSKI who hit 17 homers in 1997. For the first time in three seasons, Liberty has reached the 20-win plateau as the Lady Flames' 5-3 come-from-behind victory over Birmingham-Southern on Saturday upped LU's record to 20-30. The last time Liberty reached the 20-win plateau was in 2002 when Liberty finished the season 28-35 en route to their first-ever Big South Softball Championship and an appearance in the NCAA Regionals. Liberty's 5-3 come-from-behind victory over Birmingham-Southern on Saturday gave the Lady Flames their first road victory of the year as Liberty entered the game having dropped its previous 11 away contests. TERRA LOWE picked up her career-best ninth victory of the season in a three-hit shutout victory over Radford on Wednesday. Lowe needs just one more victory to give Liberty its second-ever pair of 10-game winners in the same season as SARAH SWOR leads the team with 11 victories. The only other time in school history that the Lady Flames have had more than one 10-game winner in a season was in 1999 when Liberty had three 10-game wins in AMY CSIDER (14 wins), LESLIE INGE (14 wins) and KATIE PHILLIPS (13 wins).

#### **RADFORD**

With the victory over Liberty, Radford won its school record 34th game of the season, breaking the 1996 team's record of 33. Also, RU is 13 games over .500 for the first time since April 11, 1996. The record is 15 games, reached twice that season. Radford committed an error in third inning of Game One vs. BSC, marking the first time this season the Highs have made a miscue in a Conference game. Prior to Sunday, Radford had gone 66.2 innings and 255 attempts without an error. They made an error in game two as well, dropping their fielding percentage to .993 in 12 Big South games. **ASHLEY SMITH** is two RBI shy of breaking the career record of 120.

#### TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

The Islanders will be idle until May 12 when they head to Rock Hill, S.C. for the Big South Conference Tournament.

#### WINTHROP

STEPHANIE REID is having an outstanding freshman season. The shortstop is leading the team with a .336 average in 47 games (42 starts) and has 18 runs, five doubles, three triples, four homeruns and 12 RBI with a slugging percentage of .520. All four of her homeruns have either tied the game or given Winthrop the lead. As a freshman shortstop, Reid is ranked in the top 10 in fielding percentage. KELLI JOHNSON and SHAHNA ASHARD have been a solid 1-2 punch on the mound for the Lady Eagles. Both have earned run averages under 2 (Johnson at 1.86 and Ashard at 1.98). With six regular season games left and into the Conference Tournament, Johnson will be looking to become the school's all-time strikeout leader. She trails Big South and Winthrop Hall of Famer LISA KEMME by 43.
