Smith went 16-26 on the week for a .615 batting average and tallied a double, three home runs, 10 RBI, nine runs scored and slugged 1.000 in helping Radford go 6-2. In four Big South games, she hit an amazing .846 (11-13) at the plate with two round-trippers, seven RBI, five runs scored and a 1.385 slugging percentage. She recorded three-straight three-hit game and registered at least one RBI in each contest. Smith's performances helped her batting average jump 57 points from .254 to .311. She's currently on an eight-game hitting streak with multiple hits in five of those games.

Felix went 4-0 last week with a 1.88 ERA in four complete games, picking up victories over Virginia and Conference foes Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. In those contests, Felix struck out 32 batters and walked just one in 26 innings of work. Against Appalachian State, she tallied nine strikeouts and allowed four hits, breaking the Radford single-season strikeout record. Against Virginia, she allowed just four hits and struck out five batters. Felix won her school-record 21st game of the season with a two-hitter vs. the Lady Buccaneers and closed out the week tying the single-game strikeout record for the second time this season with 14 strikeouts against the Lady Chants.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers suffered a four-game skid early last week, dropping a doubleheader on the road at Chattanooga and losing two at home to Jacksonville State before breaking their five-game losing streak by beating Conference foe Winthrop at home on Saturday in game one of the twinbill. BSC then lost the second game, 3-2, in its 13th one-run loss of the season. Junior **NIKKI ROMBOUGH**, who suffered a shoulder injury at Belmont on April 9, has re-entered the lineup and still leads the squad, batting .377 with 31 RBI and a .557 slugging percentage. Senior **KERRI OWENS** is in second with a .327 batting average.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

JILL SHONDEL, who has had the hot bat all season for the Lady Bucs, finally got one to leave the park as she hit her first home run of the year against Liberty. **JACQUI MINES** hit just her second home run of the season, while **KATIE MCKAY** had a great week, hitting one home run against Liberty, her fifth of the season. McKay went five-for-ten in the first four contests of the week, including a two-for-three performance in the win over South Carolina State.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal guaranteed itself at least a .500 record in the Big South Conference for the 10th consecutive season under head coach **JESS DANNELLY** and 16 out of 18 seasons under Dannelly overall.

LIBERTY

Wednesday's doubleheader with Radford will mark the final home games of the 2005 season and the final home contests in the careers of seniors **CASSIE CAMPBELL** and **TIFFANY JOHNSON**. Campbell will be leaving Liberty after a four-year starting career at second base, while Johnson is having a career-year at first base with seven doubles and four homes. The duo also mark the final two members of the Lady Flames 2002 Big South Championship team. The Lady Flames have certainly felt comfortable at home this year as Liberty has a .303 team batting average with 15 doubles, 20 home runs and a .539 slugging percentage in 14 contests. On Friday, Liberty continued to add to its home statistics as the Lady Flames scored 22 runs on 24 hits, including seven home runs, in sweeping Charleston Southern in a Big South doubleheader. **JESSICA MOORE** finished the week with three home runs, with all three coming in Liberty's doubleheader sweep over Charleston Southern, giving the starting shortstop 16 on the season. Moore needs just one more home run to tie Liberty's all-time record for home runs in a season as **SHANNON TANSKI** currently holds the record with 17 homers recorded in 1997.

RADFORD

Radford had a record breaking week as team and individual records were either tied or broken. The Highlanders broke the single-season home run record with its 28th against Charleston Southern, then tied the single-season win record with their 33rd vs. Coastal. **BREANNA FELIX** broke the single-season strikeout record vs. Appalachian State and the single-season victory record vs. CSU. **LARA WOHLGEMUTH** broke the all-time walk record vs. CCU. Also, **ASHLEY SMITH** (118) is just three RBI shy of becoming RU's all-time run producer. RU came out swinging this week, hitting .327 in eight games, including .392 in four conference games this weekend. Radford's batting average jumped 11 points from .247 to .258. Also, Smith made the biggest jump from .254 to .311.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

CRYSTAL RUSSELL and **SHANNON STEIN** combined to go five-for-eight at the plate with five runs batted in to lead the Islanders to a 6-1 win over No. 4 Texas in the nightcap of the doubleheader vs. the Longhorns. The win over Texas was the first in 11 chances dating back to the 2001 season. TAMUCC completed the regular season over the weekend with a sweep of Texas Southern. The Islanders will be idle until May 12 when they head to Rock Hill, S.C. for the Big South Conference Tournament.

WINTHROP

Despite losing 1-0 on Saturday to Birmingham-Southern, senior pitcher **KELLI JOHNSON** extended her streak of no earned runs to 13 innings. It was the fourth time this season that the team failed to score a run while Johnson is on the mound. Winthrop reached the 30-win mark this week for the second-straight season and the fifth time in **MARK COOKE**'s career. Cooke also reached another milestone, picking up his 500th career victory in a double-header sweep of Furman last Thursday. Cooke is 501-489-3 in his career and has coached over 1,000 games. Of his 500 victories, 417 of them have been with the Lady Eagles.
