Moore was named to the Lobo Classic all-tournament team, after tallying two games with a pair of home runs, pushing her season total to 10.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-3 this past weekend, dropping two to Texas A&M-Corpus Christi in their Big South Conference opener on road in Rock Hill, S.C. BSC then split with Furman the following day, and swept South Carolina State the day after that to wrap up a three-day road trip with double-headers on each day. This week, the Panthers return home to take on Middle Tennessee State in a doubleheader that was rescheduled for the 23rd due to weather.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Despite going 1-4 on the weekend at the UCF Tournament, **JILL SHONDEL** continues to lead the Lady Bucs offensively. She is hitting .356 on the season, with 12 RBIs. That ties her with senior **JACQUI MINES**, and only **KATIE MCKAY** has more RBIs for the season with 13. Freshman pitcher **WHITNEY JAMES** continues to be the strongest for the Lady Bucs, with a 5-5 record on the season. **AMANDA NOBLE**'s record improved to 4-12 with a victory over Kent State in the first contest of the tournament.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior pitcher **BRITTANY NELSON** has stepped up to be a leader on this year's team for CCU. Nelson leads the team in wins (8), appearances (14), strikeouts (71) and has given up just 14 walks this year, an impressive ratio of 5-to-1 strikeouts-to-walks. Coastal has returned to making CCU Softball Field hard for visitors, posting a 5-2 mark at home so far this season. That will be tested this week, as the Lady Chanticleers host #26 South Carolina for a doubleheader on Tuesday. The two teams split the previous meetings this year in the Gamecock Classic, but Coastal got the big victory, a 3-2 win in the championship game of the event, only the third such victory for CCU in the 40-game series.

LIBERTY

Liberty played the second longest game in school history on Tuesday against 25th-ranked Texas A&M Corpus Christi as Liberty dropped a 2-1 heartbreaker to the Islanders in 10 innings on Tuesday. Liberty's longest game in school history was a 5-4 victory over Winthrop on May 5th in 11 innings at the 2001 Big South Softball Championship. The Lady Flames made their second-ever trip to the West Coast this past weekend as Liberty participated in the Lobo Classic, hosted by New Mexico in Albuquerque, N.M. The only other time that Liberty has traveled west of the Mississippi River to play softball came during 1999 when Liberty participated in the Kia Klassic hosted by Cal State Fullerton, where the Lady Flames faced Cal State Fullerton, Cal State Northridge, Utah, sixth-ranked Arizona State and fourth-ranked Washington. Liberty finished the Kia Klassic with a 1-4 record, picking up a 3-2 victory over Utah. Despite finishing the Lobo Classic without a victory (0-5), the Lady Flames placed two player on the all-tournament team as **JESSICA MOORE** and **ASHLEY WILLIAMS** were named to the Lobo Classic all-tournament team as Moore finished the weekend batting .412 (7-for-17) with four home runs and seven runs, while Williams batted .400 (6-for-15) with three doubles and a home run.

RADFORD

Radford hit seven homeruns in four games last week, giving them 18 this season, the most since they hit 18 in 1998. Six Radford players this season hit their first collegiate round trippers. Since starting the season 1-4, **ASHLEY TAYLOR** is 4-0 with a save and a 1.43 ERA in five starts and eight appearances. She's struck out 41 and walked just four batters in 44 innings. During this stretch, she's thrown six innings of shutout relief vs. ranked teams Georgia and Florida State, allowing four hits and striking out eight. In three relief appearance against ranked teams, she tossed nine shutout innings with nine strikeouts and five hits.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

The Islanders finished Conference play with a 6-4 record and are now 27-6 over all and will finally return home to face Houston on April 2 at Islander Field.

WINTHROP

Winthrop faced some of its toughest competition of the season last week and went 5-5. After a split with Texas A&M CC at home on Monday, Winthrop got back into action by winning its first game in Hawaii on Thursday over Tokyo Women's College 5-1. Winthrop also picked up wins over San Diego and Eastern Illinois and dropped two one-run games.
