Moore extended her hitting streak to five-straight games by hitting safely in all four of Liberty's contests last week, leading the Lady Flames with a .538 batting average. She also finished the week with a .692 slugging percentage, a .563 on-base percentage and was 2-for-2 in stolen base attempts. Against UNC Greensboro, Moore finished the doubleheader a combined 3-for-7 from the plate, as she was 2-for-4 with an RBI in the first game and 1-for-3 with an RBI and a double in the second contest. At the Tar Heel Classic, Moore went 1-for-3 with a run scored and an RBI double against Lipscomb and a perfect 3-for-3 with a run scored and an RBI against Florida Atlantic, her 15th multiple-hit game of the year.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 3-1 this past weekend on the road in Big South action, splitting with Charleston Southern on Saturday and sweeping Coastal Carolina on Sunday. Two of the four games went to 10 innings, with BSC going 1-1 in those games. The Panthers are now riding a three-game winning streak. Nikki Rombough leads the Panthers with a batting average of .404 a slugging percentage of .596, and an on-base percentage of .468. Kristina Villavicencio extended her record on the mound to 13-10 this weekend and owns a 2.96 earned run average.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

After having a week off, the Lady Bucs opened the conference season at home against BSC. Game one was a pitchers duel with Amanda Noble coming out on top, pitching all 10 innings of the game. She gave up only two runs on eight hits, and struck out three batters. Noble then came into the second game in relief and pitched four and a third innings, giving up one run on three hits and striking out two. Pinch hitter Ashley Conway became the hero for the Lady Bucs in game one as she singled into the outfield to score the game winning run in the bottom of the tenth inning.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina's softball squad was swept by visiting Birmingham-Southern this weekend, dropping to 1-3 in League play. Coastal returns to action, going south to take on the College of Charleston, Wed., April 6 at 4 p.m.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames played their sixth and final regular season tournament of the year this past weekend as they participated in the Tar Heel Classic hosted by North Carolina. Rain shortened the event to just one day with Liberty splitting its two contests with a 6-3 win over Lipscomb and a 5-4 heart-breaking loss to Florida Atlantic. The Lady Flames finished the week with a season-best 10 doubles in just four games, including four doubles in their 6-3 win over Lipscomb at the Tar Heel Classic. On the season, the Lady Flames now have 40 doubles with 13 of the 18 players on the squad having recorded at least one double on the year. The Lady Flames have the largest homestand of the season this week as Liberty will host four-straight home games with in-state opponents Hampton and Virginia Tech coming on Tuesday and Wednesday, while UNC Wilmington and West Virginia Tech will travel to Lynchburg for the weekend.

RADFORD

With a pair of home runs vs. Virginia Tech, the Highlanders have now hit 20 this season. It is the second most in school history and only the second team to reach the 20+ homer total. The Highlanders have been solid in the field this season. They are posting a .965 fielding percentage and have not committed an error in the last 43 innings.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

Sarah Pauly pitched two complete games, allowing just four hits over 14 innings to lead the Texas A&M-Corpus Christi Islanders to a 2-1 and a 1-0 win over Houston. The Islanders will remain at home when they host Texas-San Antonio for a doubleheader on April 6 at 1 p.m. on Islander Field.

WINTHROP

Freshman Stephanie Reid continues to shine for the Lady Eagles as she went 3-for-6 in the double-header victory over North Carolina A&T this past week. She currently has a career-best nine-game hitting streak. She still leads the team with a .373 batting average and has only seven strikeouts in 83 at-bats. Shahna Ashard had another good week as she was 2-0, improving to 12-8 on the year. Ashard is quickly moving up as one of the all-time best in strikeouts in Winthrop history. She started the season ranked 6th all-time. This season she's recorded 152 strikeouts in just 130 innings pitched. She's now ranked fourth all-time with 372 strikeouts.
