Reid had a phenomenal week offensively for Winthrop as she helped the Lady Eagles to five wins, including three Conference victories. She hit .333 with six runs, five RBI and a slugging % of 833, while tallying three singles, a double, a triple and a career-first three homeruns. In the second game vs. Charlotte, Reid hit what proved to be the game-winning homerun in the sixth inning. Then, in the first game with Liberty, she hit a homerun and was intentionally walked in the bottom of the seventh to load the bases in the team's 4-3 win. Against Radford in game one, Reid hit a three-run homer that tied the game in the third inning. In the field, she finished the week with a team-high 16 assists.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC played only one game this week, traveling to Tuscaloosa to take on No. 9 Alabama. The Panthers were in the game for the first four innings, holding the score to 2-1 in favor of the Crimson Tide, but UA pulled away and eventually won, 7-1. It was the third top-15 opponent that the Panthers have faced this season, having lost to Arizona and Baylor earlier in the year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs had another tough offensive week against Coastal Carolina. After having Tuesday's games rescheduled due to the weather, CSU had to face Coastal after having a week off. The Lady Bucs managed only seven hits in two games, with **JILL SHONDEL** having two of those, as she went two-for-three in the second game. She is by far leading the team, batting .338 on the season. **AMANDA NOBLE** took the loss in game one, striking out three. She falls to 6-15 on the season, while Freshman **WHITNEY JAMES** dropped game two, falling to 5-9.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coming off an unintentional four-day layoff, Coastal snapped a four-game skid in resounding fashion, sweeping host Charleston Southern, 7-0 and 6-0 this past weekend. The 11 hits in each game tie the second most for the Lady Chanticleers this season, while the seven runs in the opener also tie for second most this year. Coastal has its busiest week of the regular season on tap this week, with four days of doubleheaders, starting with the College of Charleston at home. The other three are on the road, first at North Carolina State and then a pair of key Big South matchups at Liberty and at Radford.

LIBERTY

The first national stats of the season have been released and two Lady Flames current rank among the nation's best as Jessica Moore entered the week leading the nation with a 0.965 slugging percentage, while ranking third in runs, fifth in home runs, 10th in batting average, 12th in RBI and 29th in triples. Beth Hensley, who currently ranks fourth in school history with 28 career sacrifice hits, also ranked 13th in the nation in sacrifice hits per game (0.34). As a team, Liberty entered the week ranked 35th in the nation in home runs per game (.0.81), 49th in doubles per game (1.36) and 49th in slugging percentage (.428). The Lady Flames will play their final non-conference games of the year on Tuesday as they travel to Farmville, Va., for a non-conference doubleheader against Longwood, before closing out the year with three-straight home games against fellow conference foes Charleston Southern (4/22), Coastal Carolina (4/23) and Radford (4/27) and a road game at Birmingham-Southern (4/30).

RADFORD

Radford's win over Winthrop was its 27th, the third most in school history behind the 1996 (33) and 2004 (31) teams. **LARA WOHLGEMUTH** walked twice on Sunday and is now just three walks shy of breaking the career walk record of 66. Also, **BREANNA FELIX** is five strikeouts, three shutouts and three wins shy of breaking the single season record in those respective categories.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

The Islanders got three wins last week, after splitting a doubleheader with visiting Texas State, then took a pair of games on the road from Stephan F. Austin. TAMUCC is winding down the season with only two opponents left on the schedule before the Big South Conference tournament.

WINTHROP

Winthrop defeated South Carolina on Tuesday for the first time in 25 games. The second game was called in the seventh inning with two outs due to inclement weather. Sophomore catcher **JENNY SCRYMGEOUR** hit two homeruns this week and has three on the season after hitting none in 2004. Both of her homeruns proved to be the game-winning hits. Despite having a 4-2 record in conference play, Winthrop has only hit .219 as a team and has outscored its opponents 17-13. Pitching has been solid for Winthrop in conference with a team ERA of 2.09 with 35 strikeouts in 43 innings. **JANIVA WILLIS** continues to perform well in conference as she's hitting .375 with six runs and a slugging % of .625. Head coach **MARK COOKE** is just one victory short of 500 for his career. At Winthrop he has a total of 415 victories. He won his 400th at Winthrop on Mar. 11 vs. St. John's 9-6 in extra innings. His next opportunity at 500 will be Thursday vs. Furman at home.
