Swor finished last week with a 4-1 mark, a 1.93 ERA and two saves, which included the just the third time a Liberty pitcher recorded a perfect game. She finished off the last 3.5 innings vs. Hampton by allowing just one hit and followed up the second game vs. the Pirates scattering two hits in a complete effort, while striking out five batters to pick up her second win of the day. Swor got her second career save by halting a late-game rally from UNC Wilmington, as she recorded the final two outs with two runners on in a 1-0 win. In a 14-0 victory over West Virginia Tech, Swor tossed a perfect game, striking out nine batters to push her week total to 25.

Felix went 4-0 in four starts for the Highlanders last week, pitching 26.1 innings and tallying 22 strike outs, an 0.80 ERA and allowing just two walks. ## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

**BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN**

The Panthers took a break from Big South action this past weekend, traveling to Nashville, Tenn., to take on Belmont. BSC split with the Bruins to remain even with a 20-20 record on the season. This week the Panthers take on their third nationally-ranked team as they travel to Tuscaloosa, Ala., to face off against No. 10 Alabama in a single game at 7 p.m. on Wednesday. Junior **NIKKI ROMBOUGH** leads BSC, batting .400 on the season with 12 doubles, two triples, and two home runs. She is also tops in slugging percentage (.591) and on-base percentage (.466). Senior **KERRI OWENS** is second with a batting average of .338.

**CHARLESTON SOUTHERN**

The Lady Bucs had a tough week, dropping a double-header to cross-town rival College of Charleston. They rebounded to split with North Carolina A&T. In the lone victory of the week, Dorothy Page went 3-for-4 with two RBI and scoring twice. Jill Shondel had a great game reaching base safely all three at bats and recording one RBI. Jennifer Brooks also had two hits and two RBI. This 13-hit offensive explosion came after struggling to score in the previous three games. Against the College of Charleston they Lady Bucs dug a hole early letting the Cougars score all nine runs in the first two innings of play.

**COASTAL CAROLINA**

Coastal will have one of its busiest weeks of the regular season, playing three doubleheaders in five days, including wrapping up the week with a key Big South Conference doubleheader at Charleston Southern, Sat., Apr. 16. Sophomore **KIMBERLY CILLIS** has been solid for the Lady Chanticleers in recent weeks. In the last six games, Cillis is hitting .476 (10-for-21), including three RBI, one double and one home run. She has at least one hit in all six games and also added a pair of walks.

**LIBERTY**

The Lady Flames posted their most successful week of the season, winning six out of eight games, finishing up their longest homestand of the season with doubleheader sweeps over Hampton, UNC Wilmington and West Virginia Tech. The Lady Flames pounded out 11 home runs on the week, giving them 29 on the season, which set a new school record as Liberty's previous record was 26 homers set by the 2002 squad en route to the school's first-ever Big South Championship and NCAA Tournament appearance. Since returning from Spring Break, the Lady Flames offense has come to life as Liberty is batting .316 over the last 13 games, with 73 runs scored and a .516 slugging percentage, with 34.5 percent of its hits coming in the form of extra base hits (20 doubles, three triples and 14 home runs). **SARAH SWOR** joined the elite pitchers in Liberty history on Saturday, becoming just the third player in school history to toss a perfect game by striking out nine of the 15 batters she faced in a 14-0 victory over West Virginia Tech. The performance also marked just the ninth no-hitter in school history and the first since the 2001 season.

**RADFORD**

Radford won five-straight games for the first time since 1999 when they won eight-consecutive games. Radford has hit 24 home runs this season and are four shy of breaking the single-season record of 27 set back in 1996. **BREANNA FELIX** in three wins and nine strikeouts shy of setting the single-season win and strikeout record at Radford. She also recorded her sixth shutout this season and now is just two shy of tying the single-season and career record.

**TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI**

The Islanders faced just one opponent last week, splitting a doubleheader with visiting Texas-San Antonio. TAMUCC took the first game 2-0, but fell in the nightcap, 7-3. The Islanders take on Texas State at home this week and follow up that will a trip to Stephan F. Austin over the weekend.

**WINTHROP**

Winthrop has won a season-high six straight and much of the credit should be given to the team's hitting. During the streak the Lady Eagles are hitting .306 as a team by scoring 37 runs (6.2 per game). **JANIVA WILLIS** has scored 11 runs during the streak and **HILARY PEACOCK** has driven in eight runs. Winthrop's pitching has been solid all season and has been impressive during the win streak. **KELLI JOHNSON** is 2-0 with 0.69 ERA and Shanna Ashard is 4-0 with a 1.96 ERA.
