Willis helped the Lady Eagles to a 5-1 record, including a perfect 4-0 in the Big South to capture first place in the regular season standings. She batted .684 with a slugging percentage of .895 with nine runs, one double, one homer and three RBI. She walked five times and also had two steals, while extending her hitting streak to seven games. She also was 3-4 with a run scored in the win at Virginia Tech. Willis followed that up by tallying four scores in an 11-3 romp of Charleston Southern. In the deciding 5-3 victory over Coastal, she went 3-3 with two runs, two RBI and a home run.

Johnson was a perfect 3-0 last week with a 1.64 ERA. She started the week with a victory over Virginia Tech, tossing five innings while allowing one unearned run on three hits with four walks and one strikeout. She then tossed back-to-back complete games in Conference wins over Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina. She allowed two runs on seven hits vs. Charleston Southern with one walk and seven strikeouts. Against the Lady Chants, Johnson allowed two runs on just three hits with a walk and seven strikeouts. In the second game vs. CCU, she threw three relief innings of no-hit ball to pick up her first save of the season, while walking one and striking out three. She completed Conference play with a 4-2 mark, 36 strikeouts to nine walks and a 1.84 ERA.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

After almost two weeks off, the Panthers return to action this weekend at the Big South Championship. BSC earned the fifth seed in the tournament over Liberty, due to splitting the regular season with top-seeded Winthrop. The BSC will square off with #4 Coastal Carolina at 5:00pm on Thursday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs continued to slide as they dropped two games to Winthrop to wrap up the regular season. After struggling in game one, freshman **JILL SHONDEL** took game two off. **ASHLEY ROBINSON** and **JACQUI MINES** each recorded two hits in game one. The Lady Bucs continued to struggle offensively, scoring just two runs in the first game. They left a total of 14 people on base in the two games.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers dropped their final two games of the regular season to Winthrop, 2-3 and 3-5, on Sunday. CCU will be the fourth seed in the upcoming Big South Championship, facing fifth-seeded Birmingham-Southern at 5:00pm Thursday.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames enter the Big South Softball Championship as one of the top offensive teams in the League, leading the Conference in batting average (.268), slugging percentage (.428), doubles (64) and home runs (42). The Lady Flames enter the Championship boasting of a .959 fielding percentage, which would rank second best in school history if the season entered today. Liberty is coming off one of its most successful offensive months in school history as the Lady Flames batted .295 during the month of April with 30 doubles, seven triples, 25 home runs, 107 RBI and a .481 slugging percentage, while averaging 4.8 runs per game. **JESSICA MOORE** enters the Big South Softball Championship with 17 home runs on the season, which is currently tied for the single season school record as **SHANNON TANSKI** hit 17 home runs in 1997. **ASHLEY WILLIAMS** might be one of the hottest hitters entering the Big South Softball Championship as the freshman catcher batted .385 over the month of April with four doubles, four home runs and a .590 slugging percentage, which was aided by a stretch in which she successfully recorded a hit in 18 out of 21 games, including a team-best nine game hitting streak.

RADFORD

ASHLEY SMITH became the all-time RBI leader with two-run home run vs. Campbell on Friday, knocking in her 121st and 122nd career RBI. She also recorded her 200th career hit with that round tripper. The two wins over Campbell put the Highlanders 15 game over .500, tying for the highest in school history. RU has won five straight and 12 of its last 15 games. Radford's second place finish tied for its highest in the Big South regular season since 1999. **BREANNA FELIX** continued to add to her record breaking season. With her two-hit shutout vs. Campbell, she tied the single-season and career shut out record of eight and 10 respectively.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

The Islanders earned the third seed in the Big South Softball Championship and will face sixth-seeded Liberty at 5:00 pm in the first day of the tournament. TAMUCC split with Liberty during the regular season.

WINTHROP

Junior **LINDSEY MERRIMAN** had a career day vs. Charleston Southern on Friday as she drove in seven runs in the doubleheader. She was 5-6 with two runs, two doubles and a three-run homer that clinched the second game in five innings. With her seven RBI, she moved into 10th on Winthrop's all-time list and with the home run, she moved into 6th on the all-time list. **SHAHNA ASHARD** has had a breakout season, setting career-highs in wins, innings pitched, strikeouts, and complete games. She's moved into 6th on the all-time wins list, 3rd in strikeouts, and 5th in complete games. She finished with a 4-1 record in the Big South with a 2.38 ERA and 34 strikeouts to 10 walks. The Lady Eagles took the top-spot in this week's Conference Championship, receiving a first-round bye. Winthrop will take on the winner of the Coastal Carolina/Birmingham-Southern game at 7:00pm Thursday.
