Drafts earns his second weekly honor after helping the Buccaneers defeat Gardner-Webb 38-7 in Boiling Springs, N.C. Drafts was 23-of-28 passing (82.1 percent) for 247 yards and two touchdowns, and rushed for 51 yards and two scores in compiling 298 yards of total offense. He completed his first 13 passes and led CSU to a 28-7 halftime lead, helping the Bucs end a nine-quarter scoreless drought against the Runnin' Bulldogs. It was Charleston Southern's second-ever Big South win and first on the road. Drafts also notched his sixth-straight 200-yard passing game and seventh consecutive game with a touchdown pass in the win.

NEW BALANCE
DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Charleston Southern Defense

The Buccaneers' defensive unit held the nation's No. 6 offense to just 288 yards of total offense, allowed no offensive touchdowns and intercepted three passes in the 38-7 win over Gardner-Webb. The squad held the Runnin' Bulldogs, which entered the game averaging 465.5 yards and 38.3 points, to 1-of-13 on third down conversions and 1-of-5 on fourth down, as well as just 4.4 yards per play. Gardner-Webb quarterbacks combined for 16-of-43 passing for 37.2 percent on the day. GWU rushers totaled 100 yards, down from its season average of 194.1.

Parker totaled seven kick returns for 128 yards Saturday at Savannah State. Parker returned four punts for 39 yards (9.8 average), including a 21-yarder in the second quarter that set up a CCU score, as well as a 12-yard return. On three kickoff returns, Parker totaled 89 yards (29.7 average), including a 56-yard return (second-longest in school history) late in the third quarter that gave CCU the ball at the SSU 35-yard line.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Cooke made 13 tackles against the Buccaneers, including a career-high nine solo hits. He tallied one tackle for loss (three yards) and intercepted a pass and returned it 10 yards to thwart a CSU drive in the third quarter. Cooke's 13 stops was his second-highest tackle total this season and fifth game with at least 10. He leads Gardner-Webb in tackles (81) and interceptions (three) this year.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN HANDS GARDNER-WEBB ITS WORST BIG SOUTH LOSS

Charleston Southern defeated Gardner-Webb Saturday 38-7, the Runnin' Bulldogs worst loss in Big South play (31 points). It was just the second-ever Conference win for the Bucs and their most points scored in League action. Charleston Southern's previous high was 28 points at Coastal Carolina in 2004. CSU snapped a four-game Big South losing streak, and captured its first League road win in the process.

THIRD TIME'S THE CHARM?

Charleston Southern has won three-straight games, its longest win streak since winning three-in-a-row early last season from Sept. 18-Oct. 2. CSU also won three-straight games in the 2002 season. The Buccaneers' five wins ties a school record, set in 2001 and matched last season. Charleston Southern has never won four consecutive football games.

BUC-ING THE TREND?

Charleston Southern, at 1-1 in the Conference, is the lone remaining team in the Big South's championship race with 3-0 Coastal Carolina. CSU must win Saturday over Liberty and vs. Coastal Carolina Nov. 19 to clinch a share of the title with the Chanticleers. A loss to either the Flames or Chants would eliminate the Bucs and give CCU the outright Big South title.

SEVEN-AND-SEVEN

Charleston Southern held Gardner-Webb to seven points Saturday, its fewest allowed in a Big South game. CSU's previous low was 17 points allowed against Liberty in 2003. Meanwhile, Gardner-Webb's seven points Saturday was its fewest-ever in League action. The Bulldogs' previous low was nine points against Liberty last season.

LEADER OF THE PACK

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** recorded his single-season Big South record fifth 100-yard receiving game Saturday at Gardner-Webb, finishing with 11 catches for 111 yards. It was his sixth such effort in his career, tying the Big South record set by former CSU wideout **AARON DUNKLIN**. Price also took over the Conference season lead in receptions (51) Saturday and increased his yardage lead to 798. The 798 receiving yards are third-most in a single-season. A CSU receiver has led the League in receiving each year of Big South football.

SIX PACK

In his last six games, Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** has thrown 15 touchdown passes and has surpassed 200 yards in each game, averaging 252.33 in that span. He is 113-of-179 for 63.1 percent. In his last four appearances, Drafts has rushed for 135 yards and six touchdowns.

T-MOBILE

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** is 91 rushing yards away from becoming the second Big South quarterback with 1,000 career rushing yards. On the season, he has gained 376 yards, which is sixth-best in the Conference this season and second-most ever by quarterback in a campaign. The most rushing yards by a quarterback in a single-season is 384, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2003. Roberts is second to Thigpen this year at 369, the third-most in a season by a QB.

WHAT A RUSH!!

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** has scored seven rushing touchdowns this season, tying the Big South record for rushing TDs by a quarterback. **NICK ROBERTS** set the record in 2003. Roberts has six rushing scores this season and 19 in his career, ranking in the top 10 in that category in Big South annals.

ALSTON POWERS

Gardner-Webb's **KORY ALSTON** returned a punt 76 yards for a touchdown Saturday against Charleston Southern, the second-longest punt return in Conference history and the longest in a Big South game. It is Alston's second punt return touchdown this season, tying the season record shared by Coastal Carolina's **GREG WILLIAMSON** and Liberty's **ERICK HARRIS**. Alston leads the Big South with a 16.5 punt return average and is 11 yards away from setting the single-season record for punt return yardage (208 - **MIKE WASHINGTON**, CSU, 2002).

COASTAL GOES FOR HOME-GAME WIN STREAK RECORD SATURDAY

The Chanticleers, 19-2 in their last 21 games, have won 11-straight home games, tying the League record set by Gardner-Webb. In the 11-game span, Coastal has averaged 40.8 points and has held its opponents to 17.5 points at Brooks Stadium. Coastal's final home game of the season is this Saturday vs. Mansfield at 12:30pm.

COASTAL ESTABLISHES CONFERENCE-GAMES WIN STREAK

No. 9 Coastal Carolina defeated VMI 38-14 in Week 9 to run its win streak in Conference Games to eight, setting a new mark. The previous record of seven was set by Gardner-Webb from 2002-03. Coastal's 38 points against the Keys was its third-highest total in Big South competition. In the eight-game span, CCU has scored 284 points (35.5 average), while holding League foes to 147 points (18.4). Meanwhile, Coastal is 38 points away from tying its record for most points scored in a Big South season, having totaled 99 points in three Conference games this season. CCU scored 137 points in last year's Big South championship run.

DOOH!

Coastal Carolina sophomore WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has already exceeded his receiving totals as a freshman last year. Simpson has 30 catches for 495 yards and nine touchdowns, bettering his first season totals of 26, 419 and eight. He is one TD reception away from becoming the second player to have 10 in a single-season. Simpson is second all-time in the Big South in career touchdown catches with 17, four away from **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.**'s record of 21.

CHART TOPPERS

Chanticleers WR **JEROME SIMPSON** needs 86 yards to reach the 1,000 yard plateau in his career, which would make him the ninth player in Big South history to reach the milestone. This season has seen three players surpass the barrier -- **KORY ALSTON** (Week 5), **GARY PRICE** (Week 7) and **MAURICE PRICE** (Week 8). Alston is fifth all-time with 1,256 yards, Gary Price is sixth at 1,201 and Maurice Price is seventh at 1,199.

FLAMES COOLING OFF OPPOSING BIG SOUTH OFFENSES

Liberty has the distinction of becoming the first Big South team to be involved in three Conference games decided by six points-or-less. The Flames lost by three to VMI (10-7), six to Coastal in triple overtime (27-21) and five points at Gardner-Webb (21-16). The Flames' defense is holding League foes to a 19.3 scoring average, the best in the Big South this season, while ranking first in total defense (348.7) and passing offense (251.7) against League competition. The Flames are second in rushing defense (172.7). Charleston Southern is second in scoring defense (20.5) and total defense (358.5) in League games.

THIS NOTE IS OFFENSIVE TO THREE PLAYERS

If Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** (249.6), Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (245.6) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (198.9) can remain above 200 yards per game in total offense, it would mark the first time the Big South has had three players accomplish the feat in the same season. The most 200-yard performers in a season is two players, done last year by Roberts and Drafts.

CLOSING THE GAP

Through eight Conference games, five contests have been decided by six points-or-less, the most in a Big South single-season. In all, the average margin of victory this Conference season is 12.1 points. Last season, just one Big South game was decided by six points-or-less, and the average margin of victory was 15.7 points. In 2003, one game met the criteria, while the 10 Conference games averaged a 20.6 winning margin. The first year of Big South football in 2002 saw none of the six League tilts decided by less than a touchdown, while the winning margin was 17.7 points.

BICENTENNIAL MEN

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the first Big South player to score 200 points when he scored the first of his two touchdowns at Liberty in Week 8. He now owns 206 career points and has scored a TD in five of his nine appearances this season, including four-straight games from Sept. 24-Oct. 22. Perkins also extended his Conference career rushing touchdowns record to 34. Chanticleers kicker **JOSH HOKE** has scored exactly 200 points in his career, the first kicker in Big South history to reach the plateau.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty true freshman **ZACH TERRELL** is fourth in the Big South in rushing with 533 yards, just 70 away from the top spot. In his last four games, Terrell is averaging 126.5 yards (506 total), as well as 5.82 yards per carry. He has caught 12 balls for 106 yards in that same span. If Terrell can overtake the rushing lead, he would become the first freshman -- true or redshirt -- to lead the Big South in rushing.

NO BURDEN IN HOSTING THIS RECEPTION

VMI receiver **ZOHN BURDEN**, the Big South's all-time leading receiver with 143 catches, is the first player in League history with two 50-catch seasons. He is second in the Conference with 50 receptions, the seventh-most in a single-season in League annals. Burden caught 57 passes last season.

GETTING THEIR KICKS

Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE**, the second-leading all-time scorer in Big South history with 200 points, has converted his last 54 PAT attempts, and has made 116-121 (=95.9) in his career. Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** has a career-high 61 points already, and has scored 163 in his career. He is second all-time with 82 PATs, and has made his last 25 attempts. VMI kicker **BARRETT WAY** is looking to become the third kicker to surpass 100 points, currently at 93 in his young career. The remaining kickers in the Big South -- **NICK ELLIS** (CSU) and **ZACRY KOLEGUE** (LU) -- have scored 86 and 72 points, respectively.

TEAL OF APPROVAL

Coastal Carolina senior DB **QUINTON TEAL** leads the Big South with five interceptions. Last year's INT leader with six, Teal is looking to become the first player in League history to lead the Big South in that category in back-to-back years. He is the Conference's all-time interceptions leader with 13. Teal's 74-yard interception return Saturday against Savannah State is the third-longest in Big South history.

PETER PIPER

VMI punter **ADAM PETERS** became the Big South's all-time leader in punts Saturday at Richmond. He owns a career record 161 punts, surpassing Gardner-Webb's **GRAHAM WHITLOCK** (152). Peters is 175 yards away from breaking Whitlock's career yardage record of 6,476. Liberty's **NOAH CROUCH** is behind Whitlock with 146 career punts.

COASTAL RIDING SIX-GAME WIN STREAK

The Chanticleers have won six-straight ballgames, the second-longest in-season winning streak in League history and third-longest ever. Coastal and Gardner-Webb share the longest in-season win streak at eight games, while the Chanticleers' 10-game win streak from 2004-05 is the longest overall.

50-50 RAFFLE

Gardner-Webb has three 50-point games this season, tying the Big South single-season record. Coastal Carolina set the record last year with three such contests. Gardner-Webb has now scored 50 points in a game a League-high seven times during its Big South tenure.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 31 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 27 contests. The League record is 35-straight games, held by Liberty from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of this season when it was shutout by Connecticut.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS

VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** and **GARY PRICE** each extended their pass-catch streak to 33 games Saturday at Richmond. Both streaks began in 2003 against Navy.

KICK START

Coastal Carolina placekicker **JOSH HOKE**'s 12 field goals thus far are second-most in a single-season by a Big South kicker. Former VMI kicker **MATT SHARPE** owns the season record with 17 field goals in 2003. Hoke is the Big South career field goal leader with 28.

BALANCING ACT

Charleston Southern's **ANDRE COPELAND** rushed for 114 yards at Gardner-Webb Saturday, while **MAURICE PRICE** had 111 yards receiving, the third time this season and 11th time in Big South history that one team had a 100-yard rusher and 100-yard receiver in the same game.
