In his first game as the Flames' starting running back, Terrell rushed for 241 yards and two touchdowns against Chattanooga Saturday. Baldwin tallied 16 tackles (five solo, 11 assists) in VMI's 34-12 win over Conference foe Charleston Southern, helping the Keydets to their first 2-0 start in the Big South. He recorded one-half tackle for loss, recovered a fumble in the contest, and intercepted a pass deep in VMI territory for a six-yard return to end a CSU scoring threat. VMI scored a touchdown on the ensuing possession.

Smith tied a career-long with a 50-yard field goal in the fourth quarter Saturday night, becoming the first kicker in Big South history to hit two 50-yard field goals in a career. The kick capped a perfect 2-for-2 effort on trifectas against No. 8 Hampton. Smith also made his lone extra point attempt to finish with seven points on the evening. He is now 6-of-7 on field goals in 2005, ranking No. 22 nationally in per game average, and has connected on 13-straight PATS (20-of-22 overall).

BIG SOUTH TELEVISION COVERAGE CONTINUES SATURDAY AT COASTAL CAROLINA

The Big South's 2005 television schedule continues this Saturday with Gardner-Webb at Coastal Carolina on Comcast/Charter Sports Southeast (CSS). The game can also be seen nationally by digital cable subscribers on Fox College Sports (FCS) Atlantic for those who have access to FCS through their cable company (to find out about availability of FCS in a particular market, call 1-877-2-GET-FCS), while WJZY-UPN 46 in Charlotte and WWMB-UPN 21 in Conway/Myrtle Beach will serve as the local affiliates. Triple-A Charlotte Knights broadcaster **MATT SWIERAD** and **NATE ROSS** will call Saturday's action.

VMI IMPROVES TO 2-0 IN BIG SOUTH

With its 34-12 win over Charleston Southern, the Keydets are 2-0 in the Big South for the first time. VMI is the third team in history to open Conference play 2-0, joining Gardner-Webb (2002 and 2003) and Coastal Carolina (2004) -- the three previous Big South champions. Keep in mind that GWU and CCU have yet to open Big South play in 2005.

TV DINNER

No. 15 Coastal Carolina hosts Gardner-Webb this Saturday in the Big South opener for both teams. Coastal is riding a five-game Conference win streak (second-longest in League history) and nine-game home win streak (second-longest in League history). Gardner-Webb owns both records. The Runnin' Bulldogs won seven-straight Big South games from 2002-03, as well as 11-straight at home from August 31, 2002 to Nov. 15, 2003.

MORE ON COASTAL'S HOME STREAK

No. 15 Coastal Carolina, which has won 14 of its last 16 games, is looking to become the second Big South team ever to win 10-straight home games. In their current span, the Chanticleers have scored 377 points at Brooks Stadium, for an average of 41.9 per game, and have held their opponents to 148 points, or 16.4 per contest during the streak.

"I JUST FELT LIKE RUNNING"

Liberty true freshman **ZACH TERRELL** racked up 241 rushing yards this past Saturday against Chattanooga, the second-most in a game in Big South history. He did set a Conference freshman record in the process. The record is 245 rushing yards, set by Elon's Rashaud Palmer in 2002. Terrell is the eighth different player in Conference history to rush for 200 yards in a game. A GREAT CATCH

VMI receiver **ZOHN BURDEN** caught three passes against Charleston Southern to increase his Big South total to 122, surpassing former Gardner-Webb receiver **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** for second all-time. Burden stands at 122 and needs three more receptions to displace CSU's **AARON DUNKLIN** (124) as the all-time leader. Meanwhile, Burden and teammate **GARY PRICE** have each caught a pass in a school-record 29 straight games. Both streaks began in 2003 against Navy. Price is 11 receptions away from the century mark.

THE HUNT FOR RED OCTOBER

Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** became the first player in Big South history to make two 50-yard field goals in a career when he hit a 50-yarder Saturday against Hampton. Smith also nailed a 50-yard field goal last season against Southeastern Louisiana. The other kickers in Big South history with a 50-yarder are both from VMI. **MATT SHARPE** (2003) and **BARRETT WAY** (2004) share the record for longest field goal at 53 yards.

RANK AND FILE

For the fifth time in seven weeks, a nationally-ranked opponent is on the Big South schedule. Of course, this weekend it involves a Conference game, as Gardner-Webb visits #15 Coastal Carolina. It will be the Runnin' Bulldogs third-straight nationally-ranked opponent.

LONG AND SHORT OF IT

Charleston Southern kick returner **TAVARES SHORTER** recorded a 74-yard kickoff return Saturday at VMI, the sixth-longest kickoff return in Big South history. Two weeks ago, Shorter returned a punt 49 yards at North Greenville, which is the fifth-longest punt return in League annals. For the season, he is averaging 13.4 yards per punt return and 22.4 per kickoff return.

FRESHMAN 15

VMI true freshman RB **BRYAN ROYSTER** enjoyed a break-out game Saturday against Charleston Southern with 134 rushing yards on 22 carries (6.09 AVG) and two touchdowns, with a long run of 29 yards. In three games, Royster has gained 196 yards on 41 attempts for a 4.8 average. He gained 44 yards on 13 carries vs. Liberty, and 18 yards on six attempts in his debut vs. Lehigh.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** returned from injury against Howard in Week 5 and caught nine passes for a Big South single-game record 189 yards. The previous record was 179 yards, held by CSU's **AARON DUNKLIN** against North Greenville on Oct. 25, 2003. In three games this season, Price has 23 catches for 385 yards and one touchdown, ranking first in the League in total receiving yards. His 65-yard touchdown reception against the Bison is tied for the 12th-longest in Big South history.

PICKED APART

VMI leads the Big South with nine interceptions through the first six weeks of the season. The total surpasses the squad's entire 2004 total of five interceptions. The Keydets have recorded an interception in five of their six contests (including seven in the last three). VMI's 191 interception return yards are sixth-most in a single-season in the Big South. Meanwhile, Coastal Carolina, last year's INT leader with 27, is second to VMI with seven picks this season. Coastal has intercepted a pass in its last three contests and 13 of its last 16 games.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 27 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 23 contests. The League record is 35-straight games, held by Liberty from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of this season when it was shutout by Connecticut.

MMM, GOOD

Gardner-Webb redshirt freshman quarterback **DEVIN CAMPBELL** has made the most of his opportunity under center for the Runnin' Bulldogs. He has a 138.64 passing efficiency rating in his four appearances, completing 27-of-49 passes (=55.1) with four touchdowns (one in each game). Against #8 Hampton this past weekend, he threw for 127 yards and a touchdown, while gaining 27 on the ground. At #7 Furman, Campbell was 7-of-13 for 85 yards and a score.

RED STRIPE, HOORAY...

VMI leads the Big South in Red Zone proficiency with a 90.5% success rate (19-of-21). The Keydets have scored 13 TDs (11 run, two pass) and kicked six field goals. VMI is the lone Big South team with an average time of possession above 30 minutes (32:14) and ranks first in third-down conversions at 47.7% (42-of-88).

HOKE FIRST TO HIT 100 PATs

Coastal Carolina junior kicker **JOSH HOKE** is the first Big South kicker to record 100 PATs, as he reached the mark with the game-winning PAT in CCU's win over No. 17 South Carolina State in Week 5. Hoke is 10-of-10 this season and 100-105 (=95.2) in his career. Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** is second all-time with 68 PATs. Hoke has converted his last 38 PAT attempts, while Smith has nailed 13-straight.

ALSTON SIXTH BIG SOUTH PLAYER WITH 1,000 RECEIVING YARDS

Gardner-Webb WR **KORY ALSTON** became the sixth player in Big South history to surpass 1,000 career receiving yards when he reached the milestone in Week 5 at Furman. He currently ranks fifth all-time at 1,137, surpassing former CSU receiver **HARRY SEABROOK** (1,101). VMI receiver **GARY PRICE** is next in line for 1,000, as he stands at 990 receiving yards in his Big South tenure.
