Tyler Thigpen • QB • Junior
Coastal Carolina • Winnsboro, S.C.

Thigpen totaled 269 yards of total offense in Coastal's 38-14 win over VMI, clinching at least a tie for the Big South championship. He rushed for a career-high 112 yards on 11 carries (10.2 average) and scored three rushing touchdowns, which tied the Conference record for most touchdowns scored by a quarterback in a single-game. One score was a 77-yard run, which is the longest by a quarterback and third-longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history. Thigpen also was 10-of-18 passing for 157 yards and one touchdown, leading CCU to five consecutive scoring drives in the second and third quarters. His 269 total yards accounted for 57 percent of Coastal's season-high 472 yards.

NEW BALANCE
DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Brian Johnston • Defensive End • Sophomore
Gardner-Webb • San Diego, Calif.

Johnston recorded a career-high 13 tackles (seven solo, six assists) in Gardner-Webb's 21-16 win over Conference rival Liberty. He posted four tackles on Liberty's final drive, which started with 2:03 left to play, including an eight-yard sack on second down, and a quarterback hurry that led to the game-clinching interception. Earlier in the game, Johnston sacked and stripped Liberty's quarterback that set up another Bulldog touchdown. He finished the day with 3.0 tackles for loss (16 yards), including two sacks, as well as a forced fumble and three quarterback hurries.

Crouch averaged 40.4 yards per punt on five kicks in LU's five-point loss at Gardner-Webb Saturday. He had punts of 47, 48 and 41 yards, as well as one inside the 20-yard line for the 14th time this season. Liberty's punt coverage held the Bulldogs to 4.6 yards per return, while Gardner-Webb's average start following Crouch's kicks was its own 25-yard line. Crouch has now averaged 40-or-more yards six times this season and 17 times during his career.

FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Smith was 17-of-26 passing for 261 yards and a touchdown in his first career start Saturday at Gardner-Webb. He completed 65.4 percent of his passes, averaged 15.4 yards per completion and had a long throw of 58 yards to Brandon Turner in the fourth quarter that set up a Flames touchdown. Smith helped the Flames surpass the 300-yard passing mark for the first time this season as he combined with Brock Farrel to help Liberty pass for a season-best 322 yards.

COASTAL ESTABLISHES CONFERENCE-GAMES WIN STREAK

No. 8 Coastal Carolina defeated VMI Saturday 38-14 to run its win streak in Conference Games to eight, setting a new mark. The previous record of seven was set by Gardner-Webb from 2002-03. Coastal's 38 points Saturday was its third-highest total in Big South competition. In the eight-game span, CCU has scored 284 points (35.5 average) while holding League foes to 147 points (18.4). Meanwhile, Coastal is 38 points away from tying its record for most points scored in a Big South season, having totaled 99 points in three Conference games this season. CCU scored 137 points in last year's Big South championship run.

CHANTS CLINCH AT LEAST A TIE FOR BIG SOUTH CHAMPIONSHIP

With its 38-14 win over VMI Saturday, Coastal Carolina has clinched at least a tie for the Big South football championship. The 3-0 Chanticleers would need to defeat Charleston Southern Nov. 19 for the outright title. A loss to the Bucs, coupled with Gardner-Webb winning this weekend to finish at 3-1, would give both teams a share of the title. A Gardner-Webb loss to CSU Saturday would eliminate the Bulldogs from contention.

COASTAL TIES HOME GAME WIN STREAK MARK

The Chanticleers, 18-2 in their last 20 games, have won 11-straight home games, tying the League record set by Gardner-Webb. In the 11-game span, Coastal has averaged 40.8 points and have held its opponents to 17.5 at Brooks Stadium. Coastal's final home game of the season is Nov. 12 vs. Mansfield at 12:30pm.

VMI FINISHES CONFERENCE SLATE 2-2

For the second time in three years, VMI concludes the Big South season with a 2-2 record. The Keydets are 4-8 all-time in the Big South.

IN THE THIG OF THINGS

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** tied a Conference record for most touchdowns scored by a quarterback with his three scores Saturday against VMI. Thigpen scored two 1-yard TDs, and galloped 77 yards for his third score of the game, which is the longest run by a QB and third-longest rush from scrimmage in Big South history. Elon QB **JAMES MURDAUGH** scored three times against Liberty on Nov. 9, 2002 to establish the mark. Meanwhile, Thigpen is nine passing yards away from 3,000 in his career.

THIS NOTE IS OFFENSIVE TO THREE PLAYERS

Gardner-Webb's **NICK ROBERTS** (264.1), Charleston Southern's **COLLIN DRAFTS** (243.5) and Coastal Carolina's **TYLER THIGPEN** (201.5) are all averaging more than 200 yards of total offense this season. If the trio can continue the output, it would mark the first time the Big South has had three players accomplish the feat in the same season. The most 200-yard performers in a season is two players, done last year by Roberts and Drafts.

CLOSING THE GAP

Through seven Conference games, four contests have been decided by five points-or-less, the most in a Big South single-season. A fifth game this year was decided by six points, and in all, the average margin of victory this Conference season is 9.0 points. Last season, just one Big South game was decided by five points-or-less, and the average margin of victory was 15.7 points. In 2003, one game met the criteria, while the 10 Conference games averaged a 20.6 winning margin. The first year of Big South football in 2002 saw none of the six League tilts decided by less than a touchdown, while the winning margin was 17.7 points.

ZACH ATTACK

Liberty true freshman **ZACH TERRELL** is second in the Big South in rushing with 533 yards, just 43 away from the top spot. In his last four games, Terrell is averaging 126.5 yards (506 total), as well as 5.82 yards per carry. He has caught 12 balls for 106 yards in that same span. If Terrell can overtake the rushing lead, he would become the first freshman -- true or redshirt -- to lead the Big South in rushing.

SCORING MACHINE

Gardner-Webb's 306 points scored this season are tied for fifth-most on the Big South single-season chart. The Bulldogs are averaging 38.2 points this season, ahead of Coastal's record of 37.5 points last season. Gardner-Webb is on pace to score 420.6 points, which would break the Chanticleers' record of 413 last year. The Runnin' Bulldogs are pacing well ahead of the single-season records for total offense (465.5) and total plays per game (81.0). The current mark is 414.9 and 73.8, respectively, set by Gardner-Webb in the 2002 campaign.

FLAMES COOLING OFF OPPOSING BIG SOUTH OFFENSES

Liberty has the distinction of becoming the first Big South team to be involved in three Conference games decided by six points-or-less. The Flames lost by three to VMI (10-7), six to Coastal in triple overtime (27-21) and five points at Gardner-Webb (21-16). The Flames' defense is holding League foes to a 19.3 scoring average, the best in the Big South this season.

IT'S BETTER TO RECEIVE

One week after VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** set the League record for receiving yards in a Conference Game with 153 against Gardner-Webb, Liberty sophomore **BRANDON TURNER** eclipsed that record this past weekend against the Bulldogs with his seven catch, 178-yard performance. It is the most receiving yards in a Conference match-up and third-highest total in League history. In fact, five performances this year have moved into the single-game top eight:

NICK NUMBERS

Gardner-Webb quarterback **NICK ROBERTS** is 246 passing yards away from becoming the first Big South QB to have three consecutive 2,000-yard passing seasons. In addition, no Big South signal-caller has thrown for 2,000 yards in three different years. Roberts threw for 2,201 yards in 2003 and 2,410 last season.

A SHOOT-OUT AT THE OK CORRAL?

Saturday's Charleston Southern at Gardner-Webb Conference match-up features the top two prolific passers in Big South history, as GWU's **NICK ROBERTS** and CSU's **COLLIN DRAFTS** continue to chase each other on the League's all-time quarterback record charts. NO BURDEN IN HOSTING THIS RECEPTION

VMI receiver **ZOHN BURDEN**, the Big South's all-time leading receiver with 141 catches, became the League's all-time leader in receiving yards this past weekend at Coastal Carolina. He totaled 98 yards receiving to move past **AARON DUNKLIN** (1,748) of Charleston Southern for the No. 1 spot. Burden's record stands at 1,824 with two games to play. Meanwhile, Burden is two catches away from becoming the first player in Big South history with two 50-catch seasons. His 48 receptions this year are currently the sixth-most in a single-season in League annals.

DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME

Coastal Carolina RB **PATRICK HALL** is 13 yards away from becoming the third rusher in Big South history with 2,000 career yards. Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** is seven yards from moving into the Top 10. Below is an updated look at the career rushing leaders (active players in ALL CAPS):

50-50 RAFFLE

Gardner-Webb has three 50-point games this season, tying the Big South single-season record. Coastal Carolina set the record last year with three such contests. Gardner-Webb has now scored 50 points in a game a League-high seven times during its Big South tenure.

“I DID IT MY WAY”

VMI kicker **BARRETT WAY** nailed a 51-yard field goal against Gardner-Webb in Week 8, and he now owns the two longest field goals in League history. He kicked a record-tying 53-yarder last season. Meanwhile, Way is the second player in Big South history to kick two 50-plus-yard field goals in a career. GWU’s **HUNTER SMITH** is the first.

TAVARES GIVES CSU SHORT FIELD TO WORK WITH

Charleston Southern kick returner **TAVARES SHORTER** became the third player in Big South history to return a kickoff for a touchdown when he returned a kick 85 yards for a score against Savannah State in Week 8. It was the fifth-longest kickoff return in League history. Shorter also returned a kickoff 74 yards earlier this season, which is the seventh-longest return in history. Of the three Big South kickoff return touchdowns, Charleston Southern has two of them. Shorter leads the Big South in punt return average (12.1) and is second in kickoff return average (24.7).

MAURICE PRICE SETS RECORD; JOINS 1,000 RECEIVING YARD CLUB

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** caught a Big South single-game record four touchdown passes against Savannah State in Week 8. The previous record was three TD grabs, shared by Gardner-Webb’s **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** (2003) and Coastal’s **JEROME SIMPSON** (2004). Meanwhile, Price became the eighth player in League history to surpass 1,000 career receiving yards when he reached the milestone vs. the Tigers. He now has 1,088 career yards. This season has seen three players surpass the barrier -- **KORY ALSTON** (Week 5) **GARY PRICE** (Week 7) and now Maurice Price (Week 8).

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** leads the Big South in receiving yards with 687 in five games, the seventh-highest single-season total in Big South history. Price has four 100-yard receiving games this season (112, 189, 158, 144), which ties the Conference single-season record set by **AARON DUNKLIN** in 2003. Price is averaging 137.4 yards per game, and if he remains in the lineup, he is on pace for 1,099 receiving yards, which would break the Big South record of 1,025, set by Dunklin in ‘03.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 30 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 26 contests. The League record is 35-straight games, held by Liberty from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of this season when it was shutout by Connecticut.

SPEAKING OF STREAKS

VMI’s **ZOHN BURDEN** and **GARY PRICE** each extended their pass-catch streak to 32 games Saturday at Coastal Carolina. Both streaks began in 2003 against Navy.

HEY, YOU’RE FROM THE SIXTIES”

Both Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** and VMI QB **JONATHAN WILSON** are pacing ahead of the League’s single-season completion percentage record of 62.4, set last year by **COLLIN DRAFTS**. Roberts leads the Big South with a 66.0 success rate (159-of-241), and is looking to become the first Big South QB to have two seasons at 60-plus percent. Wilson is second to Roberts at 63.7 (158-of-248). Wilson has thrown for better than 63 percent in six of his nine games this season, while Roberts has six games of 66 percent or better. Wilson is currently the Big South career leader in completion percentage at 60.0 percent.

BICENTENNIAL

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** became the first Big South player to score 200 points when he scored the first of his two touchdowns at Liberty in Week 8. He now owns 206 career points and has scored a TD in five of his eight appearances this season, including four-straight games from Sept. 24-Oct. 22. Perkins also extended his Conference career rushing touchdowns record to 34.

KICK START

Coastal Carolina placekicker **JOSH HOKE**’s 12 field goals thus far are second-most in a single-season by a Big South kicker. Former VMI kicker **MATT SHARPE** owns the season record with 17 field goals in 2003. Hoke is the Big South career field goal leader with 28.

RANK AND FILE

For the eighth time in 10 weeks, a nationally-ranked opponent is on the Big South schedule. VMI will travel to #18 Richmond, which is ranked between 18-23 in the four major national polls.

GETTING THEIR KICKS

Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE**, the second-leading all-time scorer in Big South history with 194 points, has converted his last 48 PAT attempts, and has made 110-115 (=95.6) in his career. Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** has a career-high 61 points already, and has scored 163 in his career. He is second all-time with 82 PATs, and has made his last 25 attempts. VMI kicker **BARRETT WAY** is looking to become the third kicker to surpass 100 points. He has 90 entering Saturday's game at Richmond. The remaining kickers in the Big South -- **NICK ELLIS** (CSU) and **ZACRY KOLEGUE** (LU) - have scored 78 and 72 points, respectively.

TEAL OF APPROVAL

Coastal Carolina senior DB **QUINTON TEAL** leads the Big South with four interceptions. Last year's INT leader with six, Teal is looking to become the first player in League history to lead the Big South in that category back-to-back years. He is the Conference's all-time interceptions leader with 12.

BALANCING ACT

VMI's **NAT JACKSON** rushed for a career-high 149 yards against Gardner-Webb in Week 8, while **ZOHN BURDEN** had a personal-best 153 yards receiving. It marked the second time this season and 10th time in Big South history that one team had a 100-yard rusher and 100-yard receiver in the same game. Charleston Southern's **ANDRE COPELAND** (226 rush yards) and **MAURICE PRICE** (158 receiving) turned the trick in Week 7. A complete list appears on the right.

BIG SOUTH ENJOYS THRILLING WEEKEND OF TRIPLE OVERTIMES

The Big South saw two Conference games reach triple-overtime in Week 8, as Gardner-Webb defeated VMI, 55-52 before a television audience earlier in the day, while Liberty and No. 14 Coastal Carolina needed three extra-sessions to decide their ballgame before Coastal prevailed, 27-21. **MATT HOGUE**, who doubles as the Big South's TV voice and Coastal's radio play-by-play man, had the distinction of calling both triple-OT contests. In an informal survey of the 26 combined I-A and I-AA football Conferences, 15 leagues have never experienced a Conference overtime weekend as the Big South did Oct. 22. Nine leagues did not respond.

GARDNER-WEBB AND VMI SET POINTS RECORD

The 55-52 triple-overtime game between Gardner-Webb and VMI set the Big South record for combined points (107) in a Conference game and overall contest. The previous record for combined points in a League affair was 91, held by Liberty-Elon on Nov. 9, 2002. Elon won the ballgame, 56-35. The previous record for combined points in any game was 105 points, set by GWU in 2004 vs. Morgan State (W, 56-49) and tied just last week by Charleston Southern (W, 63-42 over West Virginia Wesleyan.

BIG SOUTH NFL UPDATE

Former Gardner-Webb standout LB **JIM MAXWELL** was signed by the San Francisco 49ers Oct. 17 and has made five tackles in two games.
