Nick Roberts • QB • Senior
Gardner-Webb • Springville, Ala.

Roberts led the Bulldogs' high-powered offense to a 55-52 triple-overtime win at Conference leader VMI Saturday. He accounted for 356 yards of total offense (sixth-highest in Big South history) and was responsible for five of Gardner-Webb's seven touchdowns. Roberts rushed for 76 yards on 17 carries with two touchdowns, including a 1-yard plunge on fourth down to give GWU a 38-35 lead late in the fourth quarter. He also was 26-of-39 passing (66.7 percent) for 280 yards and three scores through the air, ending the day with a 142.10 pass efficiency rating and helping the Bulldogs amass 533 yards of total offense.

CO-SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

Hunter Smith • Kicker • Junior
Gardner-Webb • Greensboro, N.C.

Smith was perfect for the Bulldogs on Saturday, connecting on two second-half field goals, including the game-winning 30-yard kick in overtime, and all seven PAT attempts to finish with 13 points. His 27-yard field goal in the fourth quarter gave GWU a 31-28 lead. Smith has a career-high 58 points and has connected on a career-best 9-of-11 field goals this season. He has made 22-straight PATs and 31-of-33 this year.

Barrett Way • Kicker • Sophomore
VMI • Richmond, Va.

Way totaled 14 points for VMI in the Keydets' triple-overtime loss to Gardner-Webb. He converted three field goals from 47, 51 and 37 yards, and hit all four PAT attempts. The 14 points are the third-best in a single-game by a kicker in Big South history, while his 51-yard field goal is the second-longest in Conference annals. Way is also the second kicker in League history with two career 50-yard field goals.

Pavelko posted a Big South-record 24 tackles in his first career start in Gardner-Webb's triple-overtime TV game at VMI. He had 22 hits through regulation, and finished with a team-high eight solo stops in addition to 16 assisted tackles. Pavelko recorded one tackle for loss of two yards and deflected the final VMI pass that led to the game-ending interception, sealing Gardner-Webb's victory.

Calvary recorded a career-best three pass breakups against No. 14 Coastal Carolina on Saturday and finished the game with five tackles, tying for his second-best tackle performance of the year. He also recovered his first career fumble and returned it seven yards in Liberty's near-upset of the Chanticleers. Calvary leads the Flames and ranks first in the Big South with eight PBUs.

BIG SOUTH ENJOYS THRILLING WEEKEND OF TRIPLE OVERTIMES

The Big South saw two Conference games reach triple-overtime Saturday, as Gardner-Webb defeated VMI, 55-52 before a television audience earlier in the day, while Liberty and No. 14 Coastal Carolina needed three extra-sessions to decide their ballgame Saturday night before Coastal prevailed, 27-21. **MATT HOGUE**, who doubles as the Big South's TV voice and Coastal's radio play-by-play man, had the distinction of calling both triple-OT contests Saturday. In an informal survey of the 26 combined I-A and I-AA football Conferences, 15 leagues have never experienced a Conference overtime weekend as the Big South did Saturday. Nine leagues had yet to respond as of late Monday afternoon.

GARDNER-WEBB AND VMI SET POINTS RECORD

The 55-52 triple-overtime game between Gardner-Webb and VMI set the Big South record for combined points (107) in a Conference game and overall contest. The previous record for combined points in a League affair was 91, held by Liberty-Elon on Nov. 9, 2002. Elon won the ballgame, 56-35. The previous record for combined points in any game was 105 points, set by GWU in 2004 vs. Morgan State (W, 56-49) and tied just last week by Charleston Southern (W, 63-42 over West Virginia Wesleyan.

MORE ON GARDNER-WEBB, VMI

Gardner-Webb and VMI's record-setting performance also saw 183 combined plays. Gardner-Webb had a Big South single-game record 99 plays Saturday, while VMI had 84. The teams combined for 1,060 yards of total offense (453 rushing and 607 passing), 11 touchdowns, five field goals and 235 yards in kickoff returns. VMI's 327 passing yards are ninth-most in a single-game in League history.

VMI STILL ALIVE IN CHAMPIONSHIP HUNT

Despite its 55-52 triple-overtime loss to Gardner-Webb Saturday, VMI can still clinch at least a share of the Big South championship crown with a win Saturday at Coastal Carolina. A victory would give the Keydets a 3-1 Conference record, and would mark the first time the Big South champ did not go undefeated in a season. A loss would eliminate VMI from the race.

CLOSING THE GAP

Through five Conference games, three contests have been decided by three points-or-less, the most in a Big South single-season. A fourth game this year was decided by six points, and in all, the average margin of victory this Conference season is 7.4 points. Last season, just one Big South game was decided by three points-or-less, and the average margin of victory was 15.7 points. In 2003, one game met the criteria, while the 10 Conference games averaged a 20.6 winning margin. The first year of Big South football in 2002 saw none of the six League tilts decided by a field goal-or-less, while the winning margin was 17.7 points.

COASTAL TIES CONFERENCE GAMES WIN STREAK RECORD

Coastal Carolina defeated Liberty 27-21 in triple-overtime to extend its winning streak in League competition to seven, tying Gardner-Webb's record set from 2002-03. Coastal will look to break the record Saturday at home against VMI. The Chanticleers, 17-2 in their last 19 games, have won 10-straight home games, one shy of the League record (11 - Gardner-Webb). In the 10-game span, Coastal has averaged 41.1 points and have held its opponents to 17.9.

ON THE RECEIVING END

VMI's **ZOHN BURDEN** had 153 receiving yards Saturday against Gardner-Webb, a League record for a Big South Conference match-up. In fact, Gardner-Webb's **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER**'s 141 receiving yards against the Keydets also surpassed the previous record of 129 yards, set by teammate **AARON RICHARDSON** at Liberty last year on Oct. 2. Meanwhile, Burden and Flagler gave the Big South its first game with a receiver from each team surpassing 100 yards in a game.

WORKING OVERTIME

The Big South, which never had a Conference game reach overtime in the first three years of football, has seen two-straight League weekends reach the extra session and three total overtime games.

BALANCING ACT

VMI's **NAT JACKSON** rushed for a career-high 149 yards Saturday against Gardner-Webb, while **ZOHN BURDEN** had a personal-best 153 yards receiving. It marked the second time this season and 10th time in Big South history that one team had a 100-yard rusher and 100-yard receiver in the same game. Last week, Charleston Southern's **ANDRE COPELAND** (226 rush yards) and **MAURICE PRICE** (158 receiving) turned the trick. For a complete list, see page seven of this report.

CAPTURE THE FLAG

Gardner-Webb WR **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** had a career day at VMI Saturday. He hauled in six passes for a career-best 141 yards and two touchdowns, including scoring grabs of 48 and 27 yards. Flagler finished the day with 221 all-purpose yards, as he had 12 yards on two rushing carries and 68 yards on two kickoff returns, including a long return of 39. Flagler leads the Big South in all-purpose yards with 844, and in average per game with 120.6.

RANK AND FILE

For the seventh time in nine weeks, a nationally-ranked opponent is on the Big South schedule. Of course, this weekend again involves a Conference game, as VMI visits #13 Coastal Carolina. Following this week, the trend will come to a halt. The next likeliest week against a ranked opponent is the final weekend of the season Nov. 19.

50-50 RAFFLE

Gardner-Webb has three 50-point games this season, tying the Big South single-season record. Coastal Carolina set the record last year with three such contests. Gardner-Webb has now scored 50 points in a game a League-high seven times during its Big South tenure.

"I DID IT MY WAY"

VMI kicker **BARRETT WAY** nailed a 51-yard field goal Saturday against Gardner-Webb, and he now owns the two longest field goals in League history. He kicked a record-tying 53-yarder last season. Meanwhile, Way became the second player in Big South history to kick two 50-plus-yard field goals in a career. GWU's **HUNTER SMITH** is the first.

TAVARES GIVES CSU SHORT FIELD TO WORK WITH

Charleston Southern kick returner **TAVARES SHORTER** became the third player in Big South history to return a kickoff for a touchdown when he returned a kick 85 yards for a score Saturday against Savannah State. It was the fifth-longest kickoff return in League history. Shorter also returned a kickoff 74 yards earlier this season, which is the seventh-longest return in history. Of the three Big South kickoff return touchdowns, Charleston Southern has two of them. Shorter leads the Big South in both kickoff return average (24.7) and punt return average (12.1).

MAURICE PRICE SETS RECORD; JOINS 1,000 RECEIVING YARD CLUB

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** caught a Big South single-game record four touchdown passes Saturday against Savannah State. The previous record was three TD grabs, shared by Gardner-Webb's **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** (2003) and Coastal's **JEROME SIMPSON** (2004). Meanwhile, Price became the eighth player in League history to surpass 1,000 career receiving yards when he reached the milestone Saturday. He now has 1,088 career yards. This season has seen three players surpass the barrier -- **KORY ALSTON** (Week 5) **GARY PRICE** (Week 7) and now Maurice Price (Week 8).

TIDAL WAVE

Coastal Carolina's flair for the dramatic continued on Saturday with a 27-21 triple-overtime win at Liberty. It was the Chanticleers' fourth fourth quarter come-from-behind win this season. Coastal has now outscored its opponents 74-31 in the final stanza in '05. Here is a look at CCU's comeback magic this season:

"HEY, YOU'RE FROM THE SIXTIES"

Both Gardner-Webb QB **NICK ROBERTS** and VMI QB **JONATHAN WILSON** are pacing ahead of the League's single-season completion percentage record of 62.4, set last year by **COLLIN DRAFTS**. Roberts leads the Big South with a 65.9 success rate (143-of-217), and is looking to become the first Big South QB to have two seasons at 60-plus percent. Wilson is second to Roberts at 65.4 (142-of-217). Wilson has thrown for better than 63 percent in six of his eight games this season, while Roberts has five games of 66 percent or better. Wilson is currently the Big South career leader in completion percentage at 60.3 percent.

THE PRICE IS RIGHT

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** leads the Big South in receiving yards with 687 in five games, the seventh-highest single-season total in Big South history. Price has four 100-yard receiving games this season (112, 189, 158, 144), which ties the Conference single-season record set by **AARON DUNKLIN** in 2003. Price is averaging 137.4 yards per game, and if he remains in the lineup, he is on pace for 1,099 receiving yards, which would break the Big South record of 1,025, set by Dunklin in '03.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 29 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South. Gardner-Webb is second to CCU, having scored in each of its last 25 contests. The League record is 35-straight games, held by Liberty from the beginning of Big South football in 2002 to Week 2 of this season when it was shutout by Connecticut.

He now owns 206 career points and has scored a TD in his last four games and in five of his seven appearances this season. Perkins also extended his Conference career rushing touchdowns record to 34.
