Price tied a Big South and CSU single-game record with 13 receptions Saturday in the Bucs' 31-30 win over Conference foe Liberty. He caught the game-winning touchdown with 1:10 left on fourth-and-goal, and added a 73-yard score - his third TD this season over 65 yards. Price finished the game with 171 receiving yards, extending his single-season League-record to six 100-yard receiving games, while setting the career mark with seven.

NEW BALANCE

Mitchell recorded 10 tackles, including a season-high eight solo stops, in CSU's win over Liberty, helping the Bucs secure their first-ever winning season in school history. He recorded two tackles for loss of 10 yards, one of which was a sack on the final play of the game to preserve the one-point victory. The Buccaneers are now 2-1 in the Big South and will play Coastal Carolina this Saturday for the Conference championship.

Smith receives his second freshman honor in three weeks following his 315-yard, three touchdown pass performance Saturday at Charleston Southern in just his second career start. His 315 passing yards are the highest in the Big South this season and eighth-most all-time, in addition to the second-most against a Conference opponent. Smith was 20-of-31 passing for 64.5 percent, and became the first Liberty quarterback to throw for 300 yards since 2001.

BIG SOUTH TELEVISION COVERAGE CONCLUDES SATURDAY WITH CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Big South's 2005 television schedule concludes this Saturday with the Big South Championship game between Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern on the Big South Television Network. A Chanticleer win would give CCU the outright title, while a Buccaneer victory would give CSU a share of the title with Coastal. The game can also be seen nationally by digital cable subscribers on Fox College Sports (FCS) Central for those who have access to FCS through their cable company (to find out about availability of FCS in a particular market, call 1-877-2-GETFCS), while WWMB-UPN 21 in Florence/Myrtle Beach and WMMP-UPN 36 in Charleston will serve as the local affiliates. "Voice of the Big South" **MATT HOGUE** and **NATE ROSS** will call Saturday's action.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN COMES BACK TO DEFEAT LIBERTY, 31-30 FOR FIRST WINNING SEASON

At 6-4, Charleston Southern has recorded its first winning season in school history, while improving to 11-9 since the start of the 2004 season. The Bucs won their school-record fourth-straight game Saturday in dramatic fashion, coming back from a 30-18 deficit to defeat Liberty, 31-30 to set up the championship contest against Coastal Carolina Saturday. Charleston Southern has already scored a team-record 81 points in Conference games.

COASTAL SETS POINTS RECORD IN WIN OVER MANSFIELD

Coastal Carolina defeated Mansfield Saturday, 71-8, setting the Big South record for most points scored in a game. The old mark was 69, set by Liberty against Norfolk State in 2003. Coastal's 10 touchdowns scored Saturday also sets the new standard, bettering the nine TDs shared by LU in 2003, and Gardner-Webb and Charleston Southern this season. In addition, CCU's 581 yards of total offense are fifth-most in a single-game. Coastal's 113 points the last two games falls six points shy of the record for points scored in two consecutive contests (119 - Gardner-Webb, set earlier this season).

COASTAL-CHARLESTON RIVALRY

The annual Coastal Carolina-Charleston Southern match-up has been played the final weekend of the regular-season all three years of the rivalry. Coastal leads the series 2-0, winning 48-14 in 2003 in Charleston and 52-28 last season in Conway. A CSU win would give the Bucs victories over the current Big South members for the first time.

COAST-TO-COAST

Coastal Carolina is one win away from becoming one of two programs nationally to win 10 *regular-season* games in back-to-back years. CCU went 10-1 last season. Hampton, at 10-0, is the other team, as the Pirates went 10-1 during the 2004 regular-season. Meanwhile, the Chanticleers are one of just seven I-AA teams nationally with one loss this season.

LEADER OF THE PACK

Charleston Southern WR **MAURICE PRICE** leads the Big South in receptions with 64 and receiving yards with 969. His reception total is fourth-highest in a season and 15 away from **AARON DUNKLIN**'s single-season record of 79. Price is 31 yards away from becoming the second receiver in Conference history with 1,000 receiving yards in a season, and 56 away from tying the mark of 1,025 set by Dunklin in 2003. A CSU receiver has led the League in receiving each year of Big South football.

NO. 7 IN YOUR PROGRAM

In his last seven games, Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** has thrown 17 touchdown passes and has surpassed 200 yards in each game, averaging 251.14 in that span. He is 134-of-211 for 63.5 percent. In his last five appearances, Drafts has rushed for 170 yards and seven touchdowns.

T-MOBILE

Coastal Carolina QB **TYLER THIGPEN** has gained 404 yards on the ground this season, the most ever by a Big South quarterback in a campaign. The previous record was 384 yards, set by **NICK ROBERTS** in 2003. Meanwhile, Thigpen is 63 rushing yards away from becoming the second Big South quarterback with 1,000 career rushing yards.

WHAT A RUSH!!

Charleston Southern QB **COLLIN DRAFTS** has scored eight rushing touchdowns this season, a new Big South record for rushing TDs by a quarterback. **NICK ROBERTS** set the record of seven in 2003.

DIRECT CONNECT

Charleston Southern duo **COLLIN DRAFTS** and **MAURICE PRICE** have connected on three scoring plays of 65 yards or longer this season. Against Howard, Drafts had a 65-yard scoring strike to Price, only to top it against Savannah State with a 68-yard TD pass. Saturday vs. Liberty, Drafts hit Price for a 73-yard score, the longest reception in a Big South game and tied for the seventh-longest in League history. The old Big South record was 71 yards set by Liberty against Gardner-Webb in 2002.

ALSTON POWERS

Gardner-Webb's **KORY ALSTON** broke the Big South single-season punt return yardage record Saturday at Savannah State. His 49 return yards pushed his season total to 247, surpassing **MIKE WASHINGTON's** record of 208, set in 2002. Alston is the third player in League history with two punt return touchdowns in a single-season, while his 76 yard return for a touchdown against Charleston Southern in Week 10 was the second-longest punt return in Conference history and the longest in a Big South game.

FIRST-AND-TEN

Coastal Carolina RB **AUNDRES PERKINS** scored his ninth and 10th touchdown of the year against Mansfield Saturday to become the first player in Big South history with three consecutive 10-touchdown seasons. Perkins scored a record 14 in 2003 and added 12 in 2004. He is the Big South's career touchdown leader with 36 and points with 216.

SECOND-AND-TEN

Gardner-Webb WR **DUVAUGHN FLAGLER** is the second player in Big South history to catch 10 touchdown passes in a single-season. Former Bulldog wideout **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.** caught a record 13 TD passes in 2003.

COASTAL SETS HOME GAME WIN STREAK RECORD

The Chanticleers, 20-2 in their last 22 games, have won a League-record 12-straight home games, breaking the old mark set by Gardner-Webb. In the 12-game span, Coastal has scored 520 points for an average of 43.3, while holding its opponents to 201 points (16.8 average) at Brooks Stadium. The Chanticleers' 12-game home win streak is tied for second-longest in I-AA.

COASTAL LOOKS TO EXTEND CONFERENCE-GAME WIN STREAK RECORD

No. 9 Coastal Carolina defeated VMI 38-14 in Week 9 to run its win streak in Conference Games to eight, setting a new mark. The previous record of seven was set by Gardner-Webb from 2002-03. In the eight-game span, CCU has scored 284 points (35.5 average), while holding League foes to 147 points (18.4). Meanwhile, Coastal is 38 points away from tying its team record for most points scored in a Big South season, having totaled 99 points in three Conference games this season. CCU scored 137 points in last year's Big South championship run.

DOOH!

Coastal Carolina sophomore WR **JEROME SIMPSON** has already exceeded his receiving totals as a freshman last year. Simpson has 30 catches for 495 yards and nine touchdowns, bettering his first season totals of 26, 419 and eight. Simpson is second all-time in the Big South in career touchdown catches with 17, four away from **WILLIAM ANDREWS JR.'s** record of 21.

CHART TOPPERS

Chanticleers WR **JEROME SIMPSON** needs 86 yards to reach the 1,000 yard plateau in his career, which would make him the ninth player in Big South history to reach the milestone. This season has seen three players surpass the barrier -- **KORY ALSTON** (Week 5), **GARY PRICE** (Week 7) and **MAURICE PRICE** (Week 8). Maurice Price is fifth all-time with 1,370, Alston is sixth with 1,256 yards and Gary Price is seventh at 1,201.

FIRED UP

Liberty is the first Big South team to have all four Conference games decided by six points-or-less. LU's four League losses were by a total of 15 points (3.8 per game). The Flames lost by three to VMI (10-7), six to Coastal in triple overtime (27-21), five points at Gardner-Webb (21-16) and one point at Charleston Southern (31-30).

RUSH TO JUDGEMENT

Coastal's 385 yards rushing Saturday against Mansfield was the seventh-highest in League history. Of the top eight rushing performances, the Chanticleers own five of them (third - 417, fourth - 412, sixth - 386, seventh - 385, eighth - 384).

CLOSING THE GAP

Through nine Conference games, six contests have been decided by six points-or-less, the most in a Big South single-season. In all, the average margin of victory this Conference season is 10.9 points. Last season, just one Big South game was decided by six points-or-less, and the average margin of victory was 15.7 points. In 2003, one game met the criteria, while the 10 Conference games averaged a 20.6 winning margin. The first year of Big South football in 2002 saw none of the six League tilts decided by a touchdown or less, while the winning margin was 17.7 points.

FRESHMAN 15

Liberty true freshman **ZACH TERRELL** is tied for second in the Big South in rushing with 615 yards, just eight away from the top spot. Gardner-Webb quarterback **NICK ROBERTS** is 122 passing yards away from becoming the first Big South QB to have three consecutive 2,000-yard passing seasons. In addition, no Big South signal-caller has thrown for 2,000 yards in three different years. Roberts threw for 2,201 yards in 2003 and 2,410 last season.

IT'S BETTER TO RECEIVE

GETTING THEIR KICKS

Coastal Carolina kicker **JOSH HOKE**, the second-leading all-time scorer in Big South history with 209 points, has converted his last 63 PAT attempts, and has made 125-130 (=96.2) in his career. Gardner-Webb kicker **HUNTER SMITH** has a career-high 68 points already, and has scored 170 in his career. He is second all-time with 86 PATs, and has made his last 32 attempts. VMI kicker **BARRETT WAY** is looking to become the third kicker to surpass 100 points, currently at 93 in his young career. The remaining kickers in the Big South -- **NICK ELLIS** (CSU) and **ZACRY KOLEGUE** (LU) -- have scored 91 and 76 points, respectively.

PETER PIPER

VMI punter **ADAM PETERS** became the Big South's all-time leader in punts in Week 10 at Richmond. He owns a career record 161 punts, surpassing Gardner-Webb's **GRAHAM WHITLOCK** (152). Peters is 175 yards away from breaking Whitlock's career yardage record of 6,476. Liberty's **NOAH CROUCH** is behind Whitlock with 150 career punts.

COASTAL RIDING SEVEN-GAME WIN STREAK

The Chanticleers have won seven-straight ballgames, the second-longest in-season winning streak in League history and third-longest ever. Coastal and Gardner-Webb share the longest in-season win streak at eight games, while the Chanticleers' 10-game win streak from 2004-05 is the longest overall.

STREAKING

Coastal Carolina has scored a point in all 32 games in its history, currently the longest scoring streak in the Big South.
