Collins averaged 23.5 points, .680 percent from the floor (17-of-25), .611 from three-point range (11-of-18) and 3.0 rebounds and 2.0 steals in two games last week for the Panthers. He tied his career-best with six three-pointers en route to 20 points in Birmingham-Southern's win over Liberty, then scored a career-high 27 points at Coastal Carolina on 10-of-15 shooting, including 5-of-10 from long-range. Collins, who entered the week averaging 12.4 points, is averaging 21.2 points, .569 from the field (37-of-65) and .535 from the arc (23-of-43) in his last five games.

WINTHROP, BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN AND COASTAL CAROLINA CLINCH HOME SEEDS

Winthrop, Birmingham-Southern and Coastal Carolina have all clinched home seeds in the 2006 Advance Auto Parts Big South Conference Men's Basketball Championship and will host a first round game on Tuesday, Feb. 28. Winthrop will host a first round game for the fourth-straight year, while the Panthers will host for the second consecutive year. Coastal will host for the first time since the 2004 Tournament. As of Sunday, Feb. 19, three teams (Radford, High Point and UNC Asheville) are in the hunt for the last remaining home seed.

REGULAR-SEASON CHAMPIONSHIP RACE DOWN TO THREE TEAMS ENTERING FINAL WEEK

Winthrop (11-2), Birmingham-Southern (11-3) and Coastal Carolina (9-4) are the final three teams still in contention for the Big South's regular-season title entering the final week of the season. Both Winthrop and Coastal have three games remaining, while Birmingham plays twice this week to conclude the regular-season -- including a home game against the Eagles on Saturday, Feb. 25. Coastal is 3-1 against both WU and BSC. The regular-season champion will host the semifinals of the Advance Auto Parts Tournament on Thursday, March 2.

BIG SOUTH "CHOICE HOTELS RIVALRY SERIES" TV PACKAGE CONCLUDES FEB. 20

The Big South's "Choice Hotels Rivalry Series" television package concludes Monday, Feb. 20 with UNC Asheville at High Point at 9:00pm ET on FSN South. Both teams are still alive for the final remaining home seed in the upcoming Advance Auto Parts Tournament. "Voice of the Big South" **MATT HOGUE** and **CLIFF ELLIS** will call all the action. In addition, the game will be video streamed on the Big South's premium website, The Big South EDGE presented by Aéropostale, for \$4.95, and will be available nationally by digital cable subscribers on Fox College Sports (FCS) Atlantic for those who have access to FCS through their cable company (to find out about availability of FCS in a particular market, call 1-877-2-GETFCS).

HOLCOMB-FAYE WILL FINISH AS BIG SOUTH'S NO. 3 ALL-TIME SCORER

Radford senior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**, who entered the season 42nd on the League's scoring list with 1,187 points, has moved into 3rd all-time with 1,777 points, where he will remain. Here is a look at the Big South's all-time top five leading scorers:

COAST IS CLEAR

Coastal Carolina has won nine of its last 10 games -- including the last seven-in-a-row -- with the lone defeat being by one point in overtime to Radford, Jan. 21. The Chanticleers are 15-9 and are guaranteed of their first winning season since 1993-94. In addition, Coastal's 15 overall wins are the most since winning 15 in '93-94, while its nine Conference victories are the most since winning 10 in '93-94 as well. The Chanticleers' seven-game winning streak is their longest since winning 11 in 1992-93.

RADICAL

Radford's 15 wins this season are its most since winning 15 in 2001-02, and the Highlanders will finish with a winning record for the first time in **BYRON SAMUELS'** four years as head coach. The Highs have won eight League games for the first time since netting nine victories in 2001-02.

NO FRESHMAN 15

Four Big South squads (Winthrop, Birmingham-Southern, Coastal Carolina and Radford) have won 15 games this season, just the fourth time in the last 11 seasons that the Conference has had at least four squads win 15 games. The previous years are 2003-04, 1996-97 and 1995-96. High Point needs two more wins to join the group, which would mark the first time five members had at least 15 wins since six accomplished the feat in 1993-94.

BIG SOUTH'S ENJOYS BRACKETBUSTERS WEEKEND

The Big South went 2-1 over the weekend in its three games created from the original pool of 100 *BracketBusters* presented by eBay teams. Winthrop knocked off MAC West Division leader Northern Illinois in double-overtime, 98-97, while UNC Asheville held off the OVC's Eastern Kentucky Colonials, 83-77. High Point lost a late lead and eventually its game to MAAC member Loyola (Md.), 77-71. As part of the participation agreement, the teams will meet again next year, with Winthrop traveling to Northern Illinois and UNC Asheville and High Point hosting their respective opponents in 2006-07. The wins helped push the Big South Conference four spots in the national RPI to 19th.

LEASURE SUIT

Coastal Carolina sharpshooter **JACK LEASURE** enters the final week with a chance to break the Big South's single-season record for three-pointers made and three-pointers per game. He has nailed 106, tied for fourth-most in a season, and is averaging 4.42 per game -- tied for the most. Coastal will play at least four more games in 2005-06 -- three regular-season tilts this week and a first round Conference Tournament game. Here is where Leasure stacks up in the Conference annals:

JACK BE NIMBLE, JACK BE QUICK

In his last four games, **JACK LEASURE** is 26-of-50 (=520) from three-point range. He has hit a three-pointer in his last 10 appearances and in all but one game this season. In fact, he has nailed a three-pointer in 51 of his 53 career games and owns 18 career games with at least five three-point field goals made in a game, including 11 this year. Of those 11 games, he has made at least seven treys in six of those contests.

DUANE REBOUL CAPTURES 400TH CAREER WIN

Birmingham-Southern head coach **DUANE REBOUL** recorded his 400th career win Feb. 11 when the BSC Panthers defeated the HPU Panthers at home, 73-69. It was Reboul's second attempt at 400, as Birmingham-Southern fell in his first try at Radford, Feb. 6. Reboul is now 401-122 in his 17+ years as the Panthers' head coach, and is 30-16 all-time in Big South games. He has also led BSC to a 103-70 (=595) record since 2000-01, Birmingham-Southern's first year at the Division I level.

WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE NEARING 600 POINTS

Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** has scored 590 points this season, and he stands 22 points away from cracking the Big South's single-season top five. Charleston Southern's **ERIC BURKS** scored 612 points in 1994-95. If Holcomb-Faye can maintain his 22.7 scoring average in RU's next three games, he will have at least 658 points, which would be third on the League's single-season scoring list.

AND THEN THERE WAS ONE...

Birmingham-Southern is the lone remaining Big South team to remain unbeaten at home this season at 11-0. The Panthers, which have won 21 consecutive non-conference home games, have won 15-straight games at Bill Battle Coliseum entering this week, which is currently tied for six-longest in the nation.

WINTHROP'S TIME IS 10:15

For the seventh-straight season, the Winthrop Eagles have won 10 Big South contests, extending their League record. In addition, WU has recorded at least 15 wins for the eighth consecutive year, all under **GREGG MARSHALL**'s watch.

FIVE BENJAMINS

Flames scorer **LARRY BLAIR** and Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** are the first Big South players since 2002-03 to score 500 points in a season. Holcomb-Faye has scored 590 points, while Blair has 569. Coastal's **TORREY BUTLER** (521) and UNC Asheville's **ANDRE SMITH** (509) were the last duo to reach the mark. VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** needs 15 points to reach the 500-point plateau this season.

BLAIR CONTINUES TO RING LIBERTY'S BELL

Liberty junior **LARRY BLAIR**'s streak of six-straight 20 point games ended Feb. 11 when he mustered just 12 points in a loss to Charleston Southern. In that span, he averaged 25.8 points and netted his fourth 30-point game in the process. Blair is 30 points away from becoming the 16th player in Big South history with 1,500 career points.

HOME RUN

In his 10 home games for Radford this season, **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** is averaging 27.4 points in helping the Hights to an 8-2 record. He has recorded four of his five 30-point games in the Dedmon Center, and is shooting .453 from the field (81-of-179), .396 from long-range (36-of-91) and .854 from the free throw line (76-of-89). Radford hosts its regular-season home finale Saturday against Coastal Carolina and is in the running for a first round home game in the Advance Auto Parts Men's Basketball Championship.

SECOND IN COMMAND

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 160 victories. He surpassed former Coastal Carolina coach **RUSS BERGMAN** (149-112) Jan. 11 against UNC Asheville. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 88-23 (=.793) all-time in League match-ups.

STEADY EDDIE

UNC Asheville mentor **EDDIE BIEDENBACH** became just the third coach in League history to win 80 Big South games when he reached the mark Feb. 11 with a win over VMI. Biedenbach is 80-58 in the Conference regular-season, a .588 winning percentage.

MOORE IN STORE DOWN BY THE SHORE

Charleston Southern's **CHRIS MOORE** has enjoyed his Big South Conference season, as he is averaging a team-high 18.1 points against League foes after 14 games, good for fourth-place in that category in the League. Moore has led the Bucs in scoring in all but three Conference games, and owns eight 20-point affairs. His Big South averages are substantially above his regular-season numbers, including points (18.1 vs. 12.6), field goal percentage (.462 vs. .432) and three-point percentage (.494 vs. .437).

BLOCK PARTY

High Point's **ISSA KONARE**'s string of 19-straight games with a blocked shot ended last Wednesday vs. VMI. In that span, he swatted away 51 shots (2.68 per game) and recorded eight games with three-or-more. However, Konare has swatted away at least one shot in 22 of 24 appearances this season and owns 16 games of two-or-more, including six with at least four. Konare is looking to become the first High Point player to lead the Big South in blocked shots.

EAGLE EMPIRE

Winthrop is averaging more than 3,200 fans for its home Big South games, and has seen new season attendance highs each of the past six home Conference dates. Winthrop first attracted 3,000 fans this season Jan. 19 against Liberty (3,067), and upped the number to 3,180 Jan. 24 against Coastal Carolina. The Eagles drew 3,570 fans Jan. 28 for its game against Charleston Southern, and attracted 4,930 Feb. 11 against Radford, the third-largest crowd in school history.

GOING SOLO

Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (26 games) is the lone Big South player to reach double figures in scoring in every game this season. Dating back to last season, Holcomb-Faye has scored in double digits in his last 34 appearances.

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Despite its loss at Coastal Carolina Saturday, Birmingham-Southern is still in position to claim at least a share of its second Big South regular-season championship in three years if the Panthers win their final two games (at Charleston Southern Monday and vs. Winthrop Saturday) ... The Panthers will attempt to complete its first perfect season at home since the 1998-99 squad went 18-0 ... **JAMES COLLINS** became the 18th player in school history to score 1,000 career points. He sits at 1,001 entering the week.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Junior **DONNELL COVINGTON** averaged 11.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 7.5 assists in two games last week ... The Bucs have tied last season's regular-season win total of 11 with two games to play ... CSU finished with 13 wins last year, winning two in the Conference Tournament ... The Buccaneers are hitting 74 percent from the free throw line over their last seven games, a marked improvement over their 66 percent shooting effort for the season ...
