Chris Oliver • Junior

Kernersville, N.C.

Oliver averaged 21.0 points and 8.5 rebounds in two wins last week for the Highlanders. Against High Point, which was ahead of RU in the standings, Oliver scored 25 points and grabbed nine rebounds, while contributing three assists, two blocks and five steals against the Panthers. At Coastal Carolina on Saturday, Oliver tallied 17 points, eight rebounds, three assists, two blocks and two steals in RU's overtime win over the Chanticleers. For the week, Oliver shot .571 percent from the field (16-of-28), .818 from the free throw line (9-of-11), and averaged 3.0 assists, 2.0 blocks and 3.5 steals.

### NEW BALANCE FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Michael Ellis  
Forward • UNC Asheville  
Statesville, N.C.

Ellis enjoyed two break-out games for the Bulldogs, averaging 23.0 points and 6.0 rebounds in his first two career starts. He dropped in a career-high 28 points at Coastal Carolina, shooting 11-of-15 ( =.733) from the floor, while adding six rebounds and four assists. It was the most points scored by an Asheville freshman in more than 20 years. In UNCA's win over VMI Saturday, Ellis scored 18 points - 16 in the second-half, while going 8-of-8 from the line and notching four steals. For the week, Ellis, who entered the game averaging 4.6 points, went 16-of-24 from the field ( =.667), 14-of-17 from the charity stripe ( =.824), in addition to 3.0 assists and 2.0 steals.

**BIG SOUTH "GAME OF THE WEEK" TV PACKAGE TIPS OFF SATURDAY**

The Big South's annual "Game of the Week" television package tips-off this Saturday, Jan. 28 with Charleston Southern at Winthrop. Tip-off is set for 12:00pm ET on FSN South. The game can also be seen nationally by digital cable subscribers on Fox College Sports (FCS) Atlantic for those who have access to FCS through their cable company (to find out about availability of FCS in a particular market, call 1-877-2-GETFCS). The game on FCS Atlantic is a change from previous reports of FCS Central airing the game. CSU-WU will also be video streamed on the Big South's premium website, The Big South EDGE presented by Aéropostale, for \$4.95. "Voice of the Big South" **MATT HOGUE** and former Auburn coach **CLIFF ELLIS** will call Saturday's action.

**FOUR SCORE AND 20 POINTS AGO**

The Big South Conference is one of just two Conferences nationwide to have four 20-point scorers, through games of Sunday, Jan. 22. The Mid-Continent Conference is currently the other League, while three others (Big Ten, Colonial and MAAC) have three 20-point scorers. The Big South also has an additional player averaging better than 19 points a game. Interestingly enough, the Big South has not had a 20-point scorer since the 1998-99 season.

**WINTHROP JUMPS OUT TO 6-0 IN LEAGUE PLAY**

At 6-0 in the Big South, Winthrop has recorded its best Conference season start since opening the 1998-99 season 8-0 against League competition. The last Big South squad to open the Conference season 6-0 was Radford in 1999-00. Only seven teams in League history have opened 7-0, with the 1998-99 Eagles being the last to do so.

**WINTHROP'S CONFERENCE STREAK**

Winthrop has won 21-straight regular-season Conference games and 24 consecutive against League foes (including tournament games). The streak is currently the longest Conference winning streak in the nation. In the six games this season, the Eagles are winning by an average of 20.3 points, but played their closest game of the year Saturday at High Point, winning by three. Winthrop's six Big South wins have been by margins of 41, 25, 15, 18, 20 and 3.

**HOLCOMB-FAYE CRACKS LEAGUE'S ALL-TIME TOP 10 SCORERS**

Radford senior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**, who became the 15th player in Big South history to score 1,500 career points when he reached the milestone Jan. 7 at Liberty, ranks 10th all-time with 1,580, moving into the 10th spot last week. He is 25 points away from the ninth position, which is currently occupied by **HENRY WILSON** (Campbell) with 1,604 points. Holcomb-Faye, who entered the season 42nd on the League's scoring list with 1,187 points, is the second Radford player in the top 10, joining Big South Hall of Famer **DOUG DAY**, who is second with 2,027 points.

**THE BIG SOUTH 500**

UNC Asheville senior forward **CHAD MOHN** became the 34th player in Big South history to record 500 career rebounds when he reached the milestone Jan. 14 at Charleston Southern. He grabbed three boards in five minutes before suffering an ankle injury. Mohn, whose total stands at 501, has missed the last two games. Meanwhile, Radford junior **CHRIS OLIVER** has 489 career boards, and needs 25 more rebounds to establish his season career-high, which is 196, set last year.

**BLAZING ARIZONA**

In his last four games, High Point forward **ARIZONA REID** has posted four double-doubles, averaging 21.5 points and 12.0 rebounds, while shooting .576 from the field (34-of-59). He has moved into a tie for the most 10-rebounding games this season with eight, as well as most double-doubles this year (eight). Reid also became the second Big South player this year to post 10 games with 20-or-more points.

**P-ZAZZ**

Birmingham-Southern duo **DWAYNE PAUL** and **SREDRICK POWE** have quietly helped Birmingham-Southern to a 5-1 League record and 12-5 overall mark. Paul, in his first season with the program, is tied for the team scoring lead with 12.6 points and averages 5.6 rebounds. In League games, he is scoring 13.5 points and grabbing 6.8 caroms, while shooting .532 from the field. Powe, who missed all of last season with an injury, is posting 10.0 points and 6.0 rebounds a game, while shooting .677 from the floor. His rebounding average jumps to 7.8 in Conference games.

**AND THEN THERE WERE TWO...**

Two Big South squads have yet to lose in their home barn this season -- Birmingham-Southern and Winthrop. The Eagles have won 23-straight home contests, which is the fourth-longest in the nation. In addition, Birmingham-Southern, which has won 21 consecutive non-conference home games, has won 11-straight games at Bill Battle Coliseum entering this week.

**DEFENSIVE MINDED**

The Winthrop Eagles are allowing a Big South-low 58.8 points per game, which is ahead of their recording-setting average of 59.4 last year. In addition, Winthrop has held seven opponents to 50 points-or-less, equalling last season's total in 33 games. Plus, the Eagle Defense has limited 10 opponents to less than 40 percent field goal shooting this year (four of which were under 30 percent). Through six Conference games, Winthrop is allowing 57.0 points, .353 percent on field goals and has won by an average margin of 20.3 points.

**I'M IN THE MOOD FOR SOME DOUBLE MINT GUM**

Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** (17 games) and VMI's **REGGIE WILLIAMS** (17) are the lone Big South players to reach double figures in scoring every game this season. Dating back to last season, Holcomb-Faye has scored in double digits in his last 25 appearances, while Williams has reached the mark in his last 23 contests.

**BIG SOUTH AMONG 18 CONFERENCES IN EBAY BRACKETBUSTERS**

The Big South Conference is among 18 conferences eligible to participate in the 2006 eBay BracketBusters, the League's first-ever involvement in ESPN's four-year-old event. Winthrop, High Point and UNC Asheville will represent the Big South the weekend of Feb. 17-19. Winthrop will host a game, while the Panthers and Bulldogs will play on the road. Opponents, game dates and TV appearances will be announced **next Monday, Jan. 30**.

**LESS IS MOORE**

Charleston Southern's **CHRIS MOORE** has enjoyed his first Big South Conference season, as he is averaging a team-high 17.5 points against League foes after six games. Moore has led the Bucs in scoring in all but one Conference game, and owns three 20-point affairs. His Big South averages are substantially above his regular-season numbers, including points (17.5 vs. 9.9), field goal percentage (.455 vs. .410) and three-point percentage (.500 vs. .406).

**M&M**

VMI junior **MATT MURRER** has vaulted to the top of the Big South in field goal percentage, hitting .679 percent (91-134) on the season, qualifying for second among the national leaders and challenging the League record of .664. In his last 10 games, Murrer is shooting .709 percent (56-of-79), scoring 15.4 points with 8.4 rebounds. He has shot better than 63 percent in 11 games this season, including seven-straight games from Dec. 29 - Jan. 18.

**BLAIR APPROACHING TOP 30 ALL-TIME BIG SOUTH SCORERS**

Liberty's **LARRY BLAIR**, who became the 60th member of the Big South's 1,000-point club when he reached the milestone vs. Buffalo Dec. 6, currently ranks 31st all-time with 1,268. If he scores his season average of 21.6 in his next game, Blair will jump to the 30th position. Meanwhile, the following players are approaching the Big South's 1,000-point club.

**BLAIR PLAYS WITH FLAIR**

Liberty junior **LARRY BLAIR** is averaging a career-high 21.6 points per game, and is looking to become the first Flames player since the 1989-90 season to average 20 points a game. He leads the Big South with three 30-point games this season and owns five 30-point nights in his career. In addition, Blair has eight 20-point affairs this year, and averages 28.5 points when he reaches the plateau.

**MAKING HIS POINT**

Highlanders senior guard **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** leads the Big South with 393 points scored and 23.1 per game. If he is able to continue to pace the League, he would become just the second player in Big South history to lead the League in scoring twice. Holcomb-Faye was the leading scorer in 2003-04 at 17.5 per game. Coastal Carolina's **KEKE HICKS** was the Conference's top scorer in 1993-94 and 1994-95.

**20/20 VISION**

Radford guard and Big South leading scorer **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** leads the Conference with 11 20-point games already this season, surpassing the League's high from last year (nine). In those 11 20-point efforts, Holcomb-Faye is averaging 26.6 points.

**MID-MAJOR POLL UPDATE**

The Winthrop Eagles are ranked eighth in the latest *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll, released Monday, Jan. 23. Winthrop, which was ninth last week, has been ranked as high as fourth on two occasions, its highest spot ever in the poll. In other rankings through results of Sunday, Jan. 23, Winthrop was 40th in the *Sagarin Ratings* and 54th in the national RPI. Meanwhile, Birmingham-Southern received five votes in this week's Mid-Major poll. High Point and Radford have also received votes this season.

**BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN'S FOUR CORNERS OFFENSE**

Birmingham-Southern is the only Big South squad to have four players averaging double figures in scoring. **THOMAS VIGLIANCO** and **DWAYNE PAUL** lead with 12.6 per game each, followed by **JAMES COLLINS** (11.5) and **SREDRICK POWE** (10.0). In addition, the Panthers are also the lone League member to have three players hauling in 5.0 rebounds per game. Powe is tops with 6.0 boards per night, followed by Viglianco (5.9) and Paul (5.6).

**SECOND IN COMMAND**

Winthrop head coach **GREGG MARSHALL** is in sole possession of second-place on the Big South's overall win chart with 154 victories. He surpassed former Coastal Carolina coach **RUSS BERGMAN** (149-112) Jan. 11 against UNC Asheville. Former Radford mentor **ROB BRADLEY** is the Big South's all-time winningest coach with 193 victories, as well as in Conference Games with 109. Marshall is 83-21 (= .798) all-time in League match-ups.

**POINTING STRAIGHT UP**

High Point leads the Big South in scoring offense in overall games (78.4) and Conference match-ups (80.5). The Panthers also lead the Conference in field goal percentage with a .469 success rate. The last Big South team to lead the League in both overall scoring offense and field goal percentage in the same season was Birmingham-Southern in 2003-04.

**RADICAL**

Radford is leading the Big South in free throw percentage at .727 percent. It is currently the highest for a Big South member since UNC Asheville converted .765 percent in 2002-03. The last time Radford led the Conference in free throw percentage was in 1996-97 (.711).

**BLOCK PARTY**

High Point's **ISSA KONARE** has recorded 30 of his League-leading 40 blocked shots in his last nine outings, an average of 3.33 per game. In fact, Konare has swatted away at least one shot in 13-straight games and in 15 of 16 appearances this season. He also owns 12 games of two-or-more. Konare is looking to become the first High Point player to lead the Big South in blocked shots.

**TIME TO START A NEW STREAK**

Coastal Carolina sophomore **JACK LEASURE** saw his 34-game consecutive three-pointers streak end Jan. 14 with an 0-4 day behind the arc at Birmingham-Southern. During the streak, he hit 126-of-291 treys (= .433) and averaged 3.71 per game. Still, he has nailed a three-pointer in 44 of his 46 career games and owns 14 career five three-point field goal outings, including seven this year. Meanwhile, Leasure leads the Big South in three-point field goals with 70, and is challenging **DOUG DAY**'s single-season record of 117 set in 1991-92.

**COACHES BOX**

Birmingham-Southern head coach **DUANE REBOUL** needs five wins for 400 in his career, while Liberty leader **RANDY DUNTON** needs six more victories for 100 in his coaching career.

#### **A RARE LEAGUE DOUBLE-DOUBLE**

Radford currently boasts the Big South's top scorer (**WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE**, 23.1) and rebounder (**CHRIS OLIVER**, 10.1). If the two are able to run the table in their respective category, it would be just the fifth time in League history that one school produced the Big South's leading scorer and rebounder in the same season. Winthrop (1985-96), Charleston Southern (1987-88, 1989-90) and High Point (2002-03) are the four schools that have previously accomplished the feat.

#### **"I'LL TAKE SCORING FOR 100 PLEASE, ALEX"**

High Point defeated VMI Jan. 12, 100-90, for the first 100-point game in a regular-season Big South match-up since February 18, 2002, when Winthrop defeated Coastal Carolina 100-74. It was High Point's first 100-point night in a Big South game, and just the 20th 100-point affair in a League game in Big South history.

#### **WHAT'S MY LINE?**

Radford senior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** tied and set League free throw records Jan. 14 against Winthrop with his 16-of-16 performance from the charity stripe. His 100.0 success rate tied the League mark for overall percentage, falling two short of **GABE MARTIN**'s all-time best of 18-of-18 for Liberty against Florida Atlantic on Dec. 20, 2002. However, Holcomb-Faye captured the Big South Games record, besting the previous high of 12-of-12, set by **BRANDT WILLIAMS** of UNC Asheville vs. Campbell on Feb. 28, 1989.
