Arizona Reid • Sophomore
Forward • High Point

Reid earns his second weekly honor in as many weeks after averaging 28.0 points, 11.0 rebounds and .719 from the floor (23-of-32) in two games last week. At #10 Kentucky, Reid posted a double-double with 29 points, 16 rebounds - both career-highs - as well as 12-of-19 from the field (.632). He also posted one blocked shot and three steals against the Wildcats. The Panthers led Kentucky midway through the first half and trailed by just four points at the break. Saturday against Ferrum, Reid added 27 points on 11-of-13 shooting (.846) to lead High Point to a win. Reid also finished the week with 2.5 steals per game and an .889 free throw percentage.

MID-MAJOR POLL UPDATE

The Winthrop Eagles maintained their sixth standing in the new *Collegeinsider.com* Mid-Major Top 25 poll. The ranking is Winthrop's highest ever. The 5-2 Radford Highlanders received votes in this week's poll as well. Meanwhile, Winthrop received four votes in last week's *Associated Press* Top 25 poll, tied for the 44th spot when continuing the rankings. Last season, Winthrop received top 25 votes in the final two regular-season AP polls.

THAT'S A FACT, JACK

Coastal Carolina sharp-shooter **JACK LEASURE** has already nailed five three-pointers in a game twice this season. He tallied five in the season opener at Jacksonville State and added seven last week against Coker. Leasure now has nine career five three-point field goal games. He has also extended his three-point field goal streak to 25 straight contests. In fact, Leasure has recorded a three-point bucket in 32 of his 33 career games and has hit 80-of-195 (= .410) three-point attempts in the 25-game stretch, averaging 3.20 per game.

2-LEGIT TO WHIT

Radford's **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** now has 1,355 points in his career, good for 26th all-time in League history. He entered the season 42nd with 1,187 points. Holcomb-Faye is 30 points from displacing **MARK HAILEY** (Winthrop, 1989-93) for the 25th spot. Meanwhile, Holcomb-Faye is 145 points away from becoming the 15th player to score 1,500 points in Big South annals.

WINTHROP FIRST BIG SOUTH TEAM TO OPEN 4-0 SINCE 1999-00

The Winthrop Eagles opened the 2005-06 season with a 4-0 record before falling this past Saturday in the final seconds to Alabama. The 4-0 start is the first by a Big South member since both Winthrop and Liberty each opened the 1999-00 campaign 4-0.

MAKING HIS POINT

Highlanders senior guard **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** leads the Big South with 168 points scored and 24.0 per game. If he is able to continue at his current pace, Holcomb-Faye would be the first player to average 20 points in a season since **KEVIN MARTIN** averaged 21.9 points in 1998-99. Holcomb-Faye is currently averaging 0.6 points under the Big South's single-season scoring rate. Campbell's **CLARENCE GRIER** averaged a record 24.6 points in 1986-87.

RAISING ARIZONA

High Point sophomore **ARIZONA REID** has had an impressive start to the 2005-06 season. An All-Freshman Team selection a year ago, the 6-5 forward has posted five 20-points games in six appearances already and three double-digit rebound performances. Reid, who is second in the League in scoring at 23.3 points, leads the Big South in rebounding at 10.2 per game. The last player to average more than 10 rebounds a contest was Winthrop's **GREG LEWIS** in 2001-02 (10.1).

REID TO ACHIEVE

In his last 15 regular-season games (including the final nine of 2004-05), High Point's **ARIZONA REID** is averaging 14.7 points, 8.1 rebounds, .570 from the floor (94-of-165) and .789 from the foul line (.789). In that span he has had five double-doubles as well.

THE DEFENSE NEVER RESTS

Winthrop has led the Big South in scoring defense a record seven-straight seasons and 10 times overall, and looks to continue that trend in 2005-06. The Eagles D, which set the League scoring defense mark last year at 59.4 points allowed, is currently holding opponents to that same figure through five games this basketball season.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

In its win over in-state rival Alabama State, Birmingham-Southern increased its home non-conference win streak to 20 games and won its third-straight over the Hornets ... The Panthers shot a season-low 26.9 percent in their loss at Miami, snapping a three-game winning streak ... Junior guard **ED HORTON** scored a season-best 14 points vs. the Hurricanes ... Senior center **SREDRICK POWE** is averaging 8.3 rebounds over his last three games ... Birmingham-Southern hosts Centenary Tuesday in a home-and-home series that concludes Dec. 17.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Bucs' 4-1 start was just the second such start in the last 22 seasons ... Two losses have come to Clemson and St. John's ... The win over The Citadel was the fourth-straight in the series, and third-straight time winning at The Citadel ... CSU captured the unofficial "city championship" with wins over city rivals College of Charleston and The Citadel ... The Buccaneers are off until Dec. 17 due to exams, and return to action at Robert Morris ... Five of the next seven games are on the road.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal will take the week off for finals and be back in action Sunday at home against Jacksonville ... The Chanticleers will play four of their next five games at home, with the lone road tilt up the interstate at UNC Wilmington ... CCU won its home opener last week over Coker and is now 23-9 in home openers, including 15-6 since moving to Division I ... Coastal is now 13-3 in non-conference play at Kimbel Arena since the 2003-04 season.

HIGH POINT

High Point leads the Big South in scoring offense at 80.7 points per game ... HPU's 103 points vs. Ferrum marked the second time this season the Panthers reached triple digits in a game ... The Panthers led nationally-ranked Kentucky midway through the first half and trailed by just four points at the break ... The Ferrum game marked the final home appearance for HPU in 2005, as the Panthers will close out December with four consecutive road games ... High Point visits Elon on Wednesday before taking 10 days off from competition for exams.

LIBERTY

The Flames will host Buffalo on Tuesday, marking the team's final home game of the calendar year and the team's last home contest until Jan. 3 ... Liberty will play five games away from Lynchburg over the Christmas Break, including road trips to Lipscomb and McNeese State, as well as the San Juan Shootout ... **LARRY BLAIR** enters Tuesday's game needing just three points to become the 19th player in school history with 1,000 points.

RADFORD

Radford at 5-2 has equaled its best start since the 1995-96 season ... Senior **WHIT HOLCOMB-FAYE** is quickly ascending on the career scoring ladder at RU.
