Darden posted back-to-back 20-point games, averaging 21.5 points per game to lead the Highlanders to a 2-0 record on the week, including a win over High Point. In the Highs' game against the High Point Panthers, Darden put in 23 points on 8-of-10 from the floor (80 percent) and 7-of-11 from the line (64 percent). She also registered four rebounds, four blocks and one steal in the win. Three days later against Birmingham-Southern, she tossed up 20 points, shooting 50 percent from the field (8-of-16) and 100 percent from the charity stripe (4of-4). She grabbed 12 rebounds, turned away six shots and dished out one assist as the Highlanders downed the BSC Panthers, 60-56 in overtime.

Ashley Fann Forward • Winthrop Hazel Green, Ala.

Fann led the Eagles with 15.5 points per game as Winthrop was 1-1 on the week. She was 8-of-25 from the floor while connecting on 14-of-19 from the free throw line. She also had 15 boards, five steals and three assists on the week.

BURN'N IT DOWN

On Saturday Liberty captured its ninth-straight Big South Women's Basketball Regular-Season Championship, claiming the No.1 seed in the Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament.

TOO CLOSE TO CALL

The standings in the Big South Conference are tight. Liberty, High Point and Charleston Southern are the only teams who aren't tied in the League. Liberty is on top at 11-1, HPU is currently No. 2 at 8-4, UNC Asheville, Coastal Carolina and Radford are tied at 6-6, while Birmingham-Southern and Winthrop are deadlocked at 5-7. Charleston Southern is 1-11 in the Conference.

THE FARMER IN THE O'DELL

High Point's **KATIE O'DELL** is the Big South's leading scorer at 15.0 points per contest. She has also taken control of the top spot in Conference Only games with 13.6 points per game.

NO. 1

Liberty head Coach CAREY GREEN built on his all-time winningest coach record during the week adding two more wins to push his all-time record to 161 wins. His Lady Flames netted their ninth-straight Big South Regular-Season Championship and secured the home floor for the Advance Auto Parts Big South Women's Basketball Tournament.

POST'N UF

Liberty has been big in the post this season. The Lady Flames rank No. 2 in the country in Rebound Margin. Lead by **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ**, Liberty is ripping down 12.3 more rebounds than the opposition.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. She currently is ranked No. 29 in the nation with 2.8 steals per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's IVA MILEVOJ has a commanding lead in assists with 160 this season, averaging 6.8 per game, and is currently ranked No. 8 in the country. She needs 21 more assists this season to move into the single season top five in the League.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the lastest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. O'Dell is 22nd all-time with 1,268 points, while Hood ranks 25th with 1,249points.

BIG TIMERS

KATIE O'DELL of High Point and **KRISTAL HOOD** of UNC Asheville are the only two active players in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. O'Dell's totals are 1,268 points and 653 rebounds, ranking 22nd in the League's all-time rebounding records. Hood has 1,249 points and 513 rebounds, ranking 42nd all-time in the Big South's rebounding records.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

The Big South Conference's new magazine TV show, "Big South On The Edge", continued Thursday, Feb. 23 across the Big South Television Network with the fifth of eight scheduled shows. UNC Asheville was last week's featured member institution. Radford will be featured on this week's show.

MILESTONE

High Point's **TOOEY LOY** (42 wins) moved into the all-time Top 10 winningest Big South coaches midway through the season. He joins Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** (2nd-87) and Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LEFORCE** (7th-55) as one of three active head coaches in the all-time Top 10.

2 PULL DOWN ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT HONORS

LESLIE COOK of High Point and **IVA MILEVOJ** from Winthrop earned *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District honors for the 2006 season season. Cook picked up a nod to the first team, while Milevoj earned a spot on the second team in the University Division.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

BSC dropped both games last week by four points, including its second overtime game of the season against Radford on Saturday ... Senior STACEY ANTHONY leads the Panthers with 10.6 points a game, while senior LAWANDA YOUNG leads the team in conference play with 11.4 points a contest ... Young set a new career high against Coastal on Wednesday with 23 points.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs broke two trends as the season started to wind down ... Their first road win of the season was even bigger as it marked their first conference victory of the season as well ... With seven rebounds on Saturday, ERICA MCCOY became the eighth player in school history to grab 500 rebounds while scoring 800 points for her career ... She scored a season high 19 points in the victory over Asheville.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina held High Point, who led the Conference in scoring, to 51 points on 35.1 percent shooting in its 62-51 win Feb. 25 ... Coastal allowed only four three-pointers by the Panthers and just one double-figure scorer (11 by KATIE O'DELL) ... Coastal is second in the conference in three-point field goal percentage defense ... Coastal had 44 rebounds in its 62-51 win over High Point Feb. 25 ... Four players had five or more rebounds, led by senior KIM TURNER's 14 boards, which was a season high by a Coastal player ... Of CCU's 44 rebounds, 16 were offensive ... Coastal Carolina had nine different players score in its 63-59 win over Birmingham-Southern Feb. 22 ... Eight of those players had points in the first half, and senior DEMARIA YOUNG had two big points in the second half on a jumper with 1:25 left ... Senior KIM TURNER led the Lady Chants with 16 points, while junior CALISHA YATES added 15 ... Senior AMBER ROSE added a game-high five assists ... Turner and Yates had double-doubles in the same game for the second time this season in a 63-59 win over Birmingham-Southern Feb. 22 ... Turner had 16 points and 12 rebounds, while Yates went for 15 points and 10 rebounds ... The duo had double-doubles in its 73-61 win over Radford Feb. 13 ... Yates had her fourth double-double of the season against the Panthers.

HIGH POINT

High Point goes into this week's games looking to snap a three game losing streak ... The Panthers host Charleston Southern on Wed. and will play at Winthrop on Friday ... Senior KATIE O'DELL recorded back-toback double-doubles this week, picking up her fourth and fifth of the year.

After losing five out of their first six road games, the Lady Flames won their last seven road games to finish 8-5 on the season on the opponent's home floor ... With its 67-60 victory over UNC Asheville, Liberty won its 20th game of the season, marking the ninth time in the last 10 seasons that the Lady Flames have won 20 or more games ... Not only did Liberty win its 20th game of the season, but with Coastal Carolina's win over High Point, the Lady Flames clinched their ninth-straight Big South regular season title (1998-2006); the second longest streak in the nation (UC Santa Barbara, 10).

RADFORD

Kelli Darden reached the 100-block plateau with four against High Point on Wednesday and finished the week with 106 blocks ... She has also led RU in scoring the last three games, averaging 19 points, eight rebounds and four blocks per game ... She is shooting 61 percent from the field and 71 percent from the line over that stretch ... RU's wins over High Point and BSC were rare in the fact they it trailed at halftime ... It was just the second and third time this season in 14 games RU won when trailing at the half.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville dropped a pair of close games losing both games by a total of 10 points \dots 10 of the Bulldogs' 12 Big South games have been decided by seven points or less with seven games decided by three points or less ... ASHTON BARTON tied her career high in points this week with a 20 point effort against Liberty. The Bulldogs now hit the road for their final two regular season games at Radford and at Birmingham-Southern.

WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles started off the 2005-06 season as one of the top shooting three-point teams in Big South, but over the previous seven games Winthrop was a combined 25-for-122 (21 percent) from behind the arc ... Winthrop opened up hitting two of its first 18 threes at Charleston Southern, but with just under 10 minutes to go in the game the threes started to finally fall for the Lady Eagles ... Winthrop hit 5-of-9 down the stretch to help earn its fourth road victory of the year and to keep its hopes alive for the possibility of hosting a first round game ... Tiffany Rodd is still struggling from three as she's hit just six of her last 35 three-point attempts (17 percent) ... Winthrop ended a six-game losing streak with its win at Charleston Southern. The Lady Eagles lost all six games by an average of 4.0 ppg ... Freshman ASHLEY FANN is the team's leading scorer this season and for just over half the season she used the three to her advantage to score double-figures ... She is only 3-for-22 in her last seven games ... Since she's gone cold from deep, Fann has focused on the inside game and is averaging 12.4 points a game during that stretch with just the 3 three-point baskets made ... She's getting the line more (36 times in the last 7 games-78 percent) ... She's also averaging 6.0 rebounds and 1.6 steals in that stretch and is quickly becoming a complete scoring threat ... This season as a freshman she's led the team in scoring 10 times and has scored 20 points or more three times ... Freshman LISA KOOP has also had a solid freshman campaign ... She's averaged 7.3 points, 4.9 rebounds and 1.5 blocks a game ... In the Big South her numbers are up slightly at 7.5 points, 5.2 rebounds and 1.7 blocks. She's averaging 24.5 minutes a game on the year.
