Megan Frazee • Freshman Forward • Liberty Xenia, Ohio

Frazee averaged 26.5 points per game last week and was named MVP of the North Carolina State Tournament. while leading Liberty to a 1-1 record on the week. Against Southern Mississippi on Dec. 3, she posted 24 points and eight boards, shooting 50 percent from the floor. She also connected on 5-of-6 from the line (83 percent) and 1-of-1 from three point land. The next day against N.C. State, she netted 29 points and ripped down seven rebounds. From the floor, she shot 70 percent, while going 3-for-4 from behind the arc (75 percent) and 10-for-13 (76 percent) at the charity stripe. For the week, she posted a .500 field goal percent, .800 percent from three point land and 78 percent from the line. She also recorded out six assists, three steals and one block over the two-game span.

NEW BALANCE CO-FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Moriah Frazee Forward • Liberty Xenia, Ohio

Frazee averaged nine points over two games for the week. She posted a .417 field goal percent, .700 percent from the line and connected on 1-of-1 from beyond the arc. In the post, Moriah turned away four shots and averaged six boards per game. She also handed out five assists and posted one steal.

Fann averaged 14 points in two games last week. She netted 55 percent (11-of-20) of her shots from the floor and connected on 50 percent (5-of-10) of her tries from behind the arc. She also recorded six steals, seven boards, one block and one assist during the two-game stretch.

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** has led Liberty in scoring in each of the Flames' last five games, averaging a League-Leading 21.0 points per game. She has also posted a League-high three double-doubles on the year. Frazee is also the League-leader with a .727 three-point field goal percentage (8-of-11).

MV-FRAZEE

MEGAN FRAZEE picked up MVP honors during the N.C. State Tournament last weekend in Raleigh, N.C. The Flames knocked off Southern Mississippi on Saturday, before falling to N.C. State in the championship game. Her sister **MORIAH** was named to the All-Tournament team.

HERE'S THE DILL

Coastal Carolina's **ALISHA DILL** posted 21 points against Furman on Dec., scoring 12 points in the last five minutes of the game, to lead the Lady Chants to the 71-67 win over the Paladins. Dill also was a perfect 6-for-6 from the line for Coastal Carolina. She is currently second on the squad averaging 11.5 points per contest.

ROLL'N

UNC Asheville has cruised out to a 4-1 record on the season. The Bulldogs only loss thus far has been to No. 8 North Carolina in Chapel Hill. UNCA is coming off an overtime win against region-rival Western Carolina on Dec. 3.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

Birmingham-Southern traveled to Kansas to play in the relocated University of New Orleans Classic ... The Panthers' game against Kansas marked the first time they have played a Big 12 team ... Charleston Southern is idle this week as its players prepare for final exams ... Radford will travel to Cullowhee, on Dec. 9 to take on defending SoCon Champ Western Carolina ... Winthrop will take to the court on Dec. 5 at Charlotte.

FREE BASKETBALL

Thus far the Big South is a perfect 2-0 in overtime games this season, recording both wins over SoCon foes. High Point downed UNC Greensboro 65-63 in OT on Nov. 29, while UNCA knocked off WCU on Dec. 3.

UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** became the latest member of the Big South 1,000 point club, when she reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. She is the only active Big South player to reach 1,000 points in her career. **KATIE O'DELL** is close behind with 982 career points. She saw limited action last week due to an injury.

MILESTONE

KATIE O'DELL of High Point reached 500 rebounds last week. She currently has 504 boards in her career and is the only active player in the Big South with more than 500.

COUNTER BLOCKWISE

Charleston Southern's **SHAUNTE SMALL** is the only Big South player with double-digit blocks this season. She has currently turned back 10 shots and is averaging 1.67 swats per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's IVA MILEVOJ has a commanding lead in assists with 34 this season, averaging 6.80 per game.

EVEN ALAN

As a team the Chanticleers are leading the League in scoring offense, averaging 66.8 points per game, while holding opponents to a Conference-low 57.2 points per game.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-2 last week, dropping a close game to Troy on the road by three points, and losing to Kansas, which has been receiving votes in the weekly Top 25 poll, in Allen Fieldhouse ... BSC's win came against New Orleans on Sunday to cap off what was originally scheduled as the UNO Lady Privateer Classic but was moved to Lawrence, Kan., due to Hurricane Katrina ... So far, three of BSC's four losses have been by five points or less ... The meeting with Kansas was the first time the BSC women have played a Big 12 program.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs struggled in their only game this week as they traveled to North Carolina to take on the 6-0 Tarheels ... CSU shot just 25 percent for the game ... **KEENA WICKER** once again led the way with 12 points, while **RACHEL POTTS** dropped in seven ... So far in the season, Wicker is leading CSU averaging just over 12 points per game ... The Lady Bucs will have time to rest as they face final exams for the next week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior CALISHA YATES has started her Coastal career with some strong performances. The Chattanooga State C.C. transfer went for 15 points and nine rebounds in the 71-67 win over Furman. She has been in double figures in scoring all four games this season and leads the team with 14.0 points and 6.8 rebounds a game ... For a team that doesn't start a player over 6'0", Coastal sure gets its share of rebounds. The Lady Chants outrebounded Furman 36-31 Dec. 3 in a 71-67 victory and CALISHA YATES and KIM TURNER had nine and eight rebounds, respectively. Coastal also ended the game with 23 offensive caroms. For the season, CCU has a +5.0 rebounding margin, compared to a -4.8 margin last season ... Coastal will now take a break for finals and not return to the hardwood until Saturday, Dec. 17. Coastal will face nationally-ranked North Carolina at 2 p.m. in Charmichael Auditorium in Chapel Hill, N.C. CCU will play only two games from Dec. 4-30.

HIGH POINT

Earlier in the week High Point defeated local rival UNC Greensboro in an overtime classic ... The Panthers traveled to Colorado Springs, Colo. this past weekend to participate in the Air Force Classic ... Junior Candyce Sellars was named to the All-Tournament team for her play during the tournament ... This week High Point will face Elon for the 67th time in team history.

LIBERTY

Earning the MVP trophy of the N.C. State Tournament, **MEGAN FRAZEE** became Liberty's third-straight recipient of an MVP trophy in the Lady Flames' last three tournaments as **KATIE FEENSTRA** brought home the trophy at the 2003 Lafayette Holiday Tournament and the Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament ... The N.C. State Tournament marked Liberty's first loss in their last three regular season tournaments as they defeated Loyola (Md.) and Cornell to win the 2003 Lafayette Holiday Tournament and then defeated Tennessee State and No. 17 Kansas State to win the Commerce Bank Wildcat Tournament last season.

RADFORD

JOHNETTE WALKER is the first true freshman to start a point guard since KIM HAIRSTON did in 1995. Prior to that it was 10 years earlier with STEPHANIE HOWARD in 1985 ... Radford went to its third starting lineup in four games ... The two lineup changes after losses resulted in victories over UC Davis and Lafayette ... Defensively, RU has been solid, forcing 22 turnovers per game (19 or more in each game) and recording 10 steals per contest.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville split a pair of games against defending conference champions this week ... The Bulldogs fell to ACC Champ North Carolina and overcame a 13-point second half deficit to defeat Southern Conference champ Western Carolina ... STACY SHEPARD recorded 19 points and a career-high 15 rebounds against WCU. She has had double figure rebounds in three of five games this season. She averaged a double-double this week ... KRISTAL HOOD moved into 10th place on UNCA's scoring list with 14 points at WCU ... ASHTON BARTON matched her career-high with 17 points at Western ... The Bulldogs have beaten their mountain rival three-straight times for the first time in the series and are off to their best start since the 1984-85 season.

WINTHROP

Freshman FRANCHESCA DAVENPORT has been the team's sixth man as she's averaged 13.0 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 2.5 spg off the bench in the last two games ... Freshman SHELLY HANKINS is averaging 12.0 ppg, 3.0 apg, 5.0 rpg, and 2.0 spg in her last two games ... She's also coming off a career-high 14 points vs. Livingstone College ... Already doing without their point guard, the Lady Eagles lost two more players this past week to injuries. TIFFANY RODD, the team's leading scorer, and KRISTINE WEBB will both be out 4-6 weeks.
