O'Dell averaged 19.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game to lead High Point to a 2-0 record on the week, including a win over traditional Big South power Liberty. Against the Lady Flames on Jan. 25, O'Dell poured in 17 points, while shooting 44 percent (4-of-9) from three-point land along with six boards and one assist in the win. Three days later at Coastal Carolina, she shot 67 percent from the floor, connecting on 10-of-15 shots, while adding a free throw to finish with 21 points. She also posted nine boards and three assists as the Panthers defeated the Chanticleers, 69-60.

DUDE, YOU'RE GETTING AN O'DELL

Preseason Big South Player of the Year **KATIE O'DELL** came out swinging in her first five Conference games, averaging 14.0 points per game. Four of her last five games have seen her in double-digits, including 21 points against Coastal Carolina and 17 points against traditional Big South Power Liberty.

SEP-HPU-RATION

High Point has established itself as the team to beat this season. The Panthers are currently 5-0, with one more League game in store for the first round of the Conference season. Liberty and Winthrop are currently second with identical 4-1 records, but the Flames hold the tie breaker with the Eagles with a 56-44 win on Jan. 21.

FIVE OF A KIND

Coastal has had the same starting five for all 15 games this season. The quintet of senior **AMBER ROSE**, sophomore **C.J. WARE**, junior **CALISHA YATES**, senior **KIM TURNER** and junior **ALISHA DILL** are averaging 45.4 points and 21.0 rebounds a contest. Coastal is the only Big South school that has used the same starting five throughout the season.

DANGEROUS

Winthrop has turned itself into one of the most dangerous teams in the Big South, jumping out to a 4-1 start on the Conference season. The freshman duo of **ASHLEY FANN** (12.8 ppg) and **TIFFANY RODD** (11.5 ppg) are averaging 24.3 points per game. Fann is shooting 42 percent from the arc, while Rodd is 21st in the country 2.8 treys per game.

MILESTONE

High Point's **TOOEY LOY** moved into the all-time Top 10 winningest Big South coaches midway through the season. He joins Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** (2nd-83) and Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LEFORCE** (7th-50) as one of three active head coaches in the all-time Top 10.

HALF LADY, HALF AMAZING

Birmingham-Southern's **REBA ROSS** has found her mark this season. The junior is leading the League with a 55 percent stroke from the floor, connecting on 57-of-104 shots.

GUN'N FOR THAT NO. 1 SPOT

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** moved into second place for the most wins in Big South Games as he currently has 83 in seven years at the helm. Also, he is four wins away from becoming the Big South's all-time winningest coach (154). The current all-time winningest coach is **LUBY LICHONCZAK** who racked up 158 wins in 11 years at Radford.

GRAND THEFT AUTO

At Coastal Carolina, defense has been the name of the game. The Chants are currently No. 4 in the country in steals per game, averaging 13.1 take aways per game.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. She currently is ranked No. 22 in the nation with 3.1 steals per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 124 this season, averaging 6.8 per game, and is currently ranked No. 6 in the country. She needs 57 more assists this season to move into the single season top five.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. Hood is 27th all-time with 1,185 points, while O'Dell ranks 28th with 1,175.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,175 points and 593 rebounds. Her current rebound total has her ranked 34th in the League annuals. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** is close to reaching the 500 career rebounds mark with 451 career boards.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

The Big South Conference's new magazine-style television show, "Big South On The Edge," premiered Thursday, January 26 across the Big South Television Network. The show featured Birmingham-Southern's women's basketball program as well as various institutional topics. Winthrop is the next school to be featured, and will begin airing on Thursday, Feb. 2. "Voice of the Big South" **MATT HOGUE** serves as host, with Charlotte-based Fresh Roast TV producing.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern dropped its second-straight game this past Saturday, losing to Liberty at home, 51-40 ... It was the 10th meeting between the Panthers and the Lady Flames, and the 10th time that Liberty has beaten the Panthers ... Sophomore **REBA ROSS** led BSC with 12 points against Liberty, while seniors **STACEY ANTHONY** and **LAWANDA YOUNG** led the Panthers with 14 points apiece against Coastal Carolina last Monday.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

After a mid-week pounding of Agnes Scott, the Lady Bucs couldn't translate any momentum into getting their first Conference victory ... Instead, they found themselves on the wrong end of a 29-point deficit against Winthrop ... It was the tale of two games for freshman point guard **PAM TOLBERT** who led the Lady Bucs with 18 points against Agnes Scott, then scored just three points against Winthrop ... **SHAUNTE SMALL** continued to be solid for CSU, scoring 13 points against Winthrop, CSU's only scorer in double figures ... She also had six rebounds and two blocks ... She has currently scored double figures in five-straight games and every Conference game with exception of Liberty ... Small is averaging just over eight points per game for the season.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior **ALISHA DILL** and senior **KIM TURNER** both broke the 500-point mark for their careers in the 70-57 win over Birmingham-Southern Jan. 23 ... Dill had 12 points in the win and now has 523 career points ... Turner went for eight points against the Panthers and now has 512 career points ... Senior **AMBER ROSE** is close to getting to 500, as she has 459 career points ... Senior **AMBER ROSE** kept her double-digit scoring streak alive against High Point Jan. 28 ... Rose scored 13 points against the Panthers and has scored in double digits in the last 11 games ... The last time she was held below 10 points was a nine-point performance against second-ranked North Carolina ... Coastal steps out-of-conference Wednesday, Feb. 1, against Savannah State. Game time is at 3 p.m. Coastal then travels to North Charleston, S.C., to face in-state rival Charleston Southern on Feb. 4 at 2 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point is off to its best Conference start since joining the Big South with a 5-0 record going into tonight's game against Charleston Southern ... Last week the Panthers defeated perennial Conference power Liberty for the second time in as many meetings ... Senior **KATIE O'DELL** is within five rebounds of moving into the Top-10 all-time rebound leaders for HPU ... This week HPU wraps up the first half of the Conference schedule against Charleston Southern and Winthrop.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames lost just their second game against a Conference opponent since the 2002-03 season as they fell to High Point, 55-64 ... Since 2002-03, Liberty is 54-2 (with both losses coming in the last two seasons to the Panthers) ... Liberty's and the Big South's leading scorer, **MEGAN FRAZEE**, missed her third straight game after tweaking her knee against Coastal Carolina (1/16) ... Six of the Lady Flames' 14 players are shooting 40 percent or better from behind the arc: **EGLE SMIGELSKAITE** (1.000, 1-1), **MEGAN FRAZEE** (52.8, 19-36), **MICHELLE PARKER** (50.0, 5-10), **MOLLY FRAZEE** (50.0, 7-14), **MORIAH FRAZEE** (44.0, 4-10) and **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ** (40.0, 4-10).

RADFORD

SARAH STEPHENS and **SHAVON EARP** are averaging more points on the road than they are at home this season ... In eight games, Stephens is posting 16.0 points and Earp is recording 15.8 points per game ... Stephens has led RU in scoring in five of its last seven road tilts, including a career and game high 23 at IPFW on Jan. 7 ... Earp registered a career-high 26 at UNC Asheville on Saturday ... Radford has had some misfortunes at the line in the last six games ... The Highlanders are shooting just 59.1 percent (68-115) ... In its last two games, RU is at 52.8 percent (19-36), losing those games by a total of eight points ... The Highlanders have also struggled from the charity stripe in late game situations ... In the final two minutes of games this season, RU is shooting 54.3 percent (25-46) from the charity stripe.

UNC ASHEVILLE

The Bulldogs have won three straight after defeating Charleston Southern and Radford last week ... It has not been easy for the Bulldogs as four of their five Big South games have been decided by three points ... Sophomore center **STACY SHEPARD** had a big week averaging 17.5 points and 8.5 rebounds off the bench ... She tied a season-high with 19 points at Charleston Southern and just missed a double-double with 16 points and nine rebounds against Radford ... Freshman **ANA BAKER** had a break out week ... After averaging 1.3 points per game for the season, Baker posted season-highs in both games this week with seven points at CSU and 11 points against Radford ... She went 6-for-8 from the floor and 3-for-3 from three-point range and recorded a season best five steals against the Highlanders ... The Bulldogs hit a season-high 10 three-pointers at CSU, just one off the school record of 11 set during the 2000-01 season ... The Bulldogs have the week off before hosting Birmingham-Southern on Saturday.

WINTHROP

Since starting 0-4, the Lady Eagles have won 10 of 14 games and are off to their best start in school history at 4-1 in the Big South ... One of the main reasons for this young team's success is its defense ... This past week the defense held both of its opponents under their scoring averages and have done so in 13 of its last 14 games ... Freshman **TIFFANY RODD** is off to a good start in Conference play ... The forward/guard finally got back in sink returning from injury and so far in the Big South is averaging 12.4 ppg while shooting 46 % from the field and 52 % from three in 28 minutes a game ... She's led the team in scoring in three of its five conference games. She has also hit at least three 3-point baskets in the first half in three of the five games ... Freshman center **LISA KOOP** had a solid week offensively as she averaged 9.0 ppg and 9.0 rpg ... She pulled down a career-best 12 rebounds at Radford ... The Lady Eagles 29-point victory over Charleston Southern on Wednesday was its largest margin of victory ever in the Big South ... Winthrop's previous best was 27 vs. Charleston Southern (89-62) in 1996 and vs. UMBC (60-33) in 1997.
