Ashton Barton • Sophomore

Barton led the Bulldogs to a 1-1 record on the week, posting back-to-back 16 point games. Against SoCon leader Chattanooga on Dec. 14, Barton shot 70 percent from the floor, connecting on 7-of-10 attempts. She also hit 2-of-4 from behind the arc (50 percent), and added two rebounds as UNCA fell to the Mocs. Three days later against Sewanee, Barton stayed hot as she nailed 7-of-11 shots from the floor (64 percent) and 2-of-3 from the charity stripe (67 percent). She also added a season-high seven rebounds as the Bulldogs downed Sewanee, 79-35. For the week, Barton averaged 16.0 points per game, shot 67 from the floor (14-of-21), collected nine rebounds, one steal and dished out two assists.

BIG SOUTH REPORT TO TAKE ONE WEEK HIATUS

Due to the upcoming Christmas holiday break, the Big South Conference will not produce a weekly report next Monday, Dec. 26. The report will resume on Monday, Jan. 2.

SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** has led Liberty in scoring in each of the Flames' last seven games, averaging a League-leading 21.4 points per game, a mark that is 19th in the country. She has also posted a League-high five double-doubles on the year. Frazee is the League leader with a .667 three point field goal percent (10-of-15). She has posted five consecutive games with at least 20-or-more points this season ... In the post, it has been all Frazee as she leads the League with 10.4 boards per contest.

PUNK'N EM

UNC Asheville's **ASHTON BARTON** has been on fire this season lighting teams up for team-leading 13.8 points per game, well above last season's average of 4.6 points per game. The sophomore guard has led her team in scoring in each of UNCA's last three games and currently ranks fifth in the Big South.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 51 this season, averaging 7.29 per game, a mark that has her currently ranked No. 5 in the country.

PRINCESS OF THIEVES

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been putting on "Robin Hood" like games thus far into the season. With 21 steals this season, Walker is averaging 3.5 steals per game and is ranked 17th in Division I.

FANN'N THE FLAMES

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has been on fire of late. The freshman is currently ninth in the nation in three point field-goal percentage, shooting 53 percent.

BORROW'N OPPONENTS

PAM THORNBORROW of Birmingham-Southern has stepped up this season as one of the Panthers' top players. She has netted three 20 point games, as she tied a season-high 22 points vs. Alcorn State last week. Of the Panthers' nine games this season, Thornborrow as led BSC in scoring four times.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. Hood currently has 1,054, while O'Dell sits at 1,018 points.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with over 1,000 career points and over 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,018 points and 519 rebounds.

NO FEAR OF REJECTION

Radford's **KELLI DARDEN** is currently the Big South leader in rejections with 2.17 blocks per game, totaling 13 blocks this season.

NOT A SELLAR DWELLER

High Point's **CANDYCE SELLARS** posted a Big South season-high 31 points as the Panthers downed Longwood on Dec. 10.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

High Point's duo of **KATIE O'DELL** and **CANDYCE SELLARS** have been causing teams double trouble this season. The teammates are the only two players in the League to each have 20 points in the same game, a mark that they have posted twice this season.

MID-MAJOR MAGIC

The Big South is currently 29-28 against non-conference competition thus far into the season. The Big South currently owns a 7-3 advantage over the SoCon and is dominating the Atlantic Sun with a 6-2 record. The Big South is currently 14 in the national RPI.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

It was a light week around the Big South as three of the League's teams took a break from playing for exams ... High Point, Winthrop and Radford were idle last week and will resume play on Dec. 19 ... UNC Asheville split a pair of games last week ... Birmingham-Southern also split a pair of games last week as well ... Coastal Carolina fell to No. 6 North Carolina, Charleston Southern dropped Southern Wesleyan and Liberty downed Southern Methodist to round out last week's games for the Big South.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers traveled to Corpus Christi, Texas, this past weekend for the Flint Hills Resources Islanders Classic, hosted by Texas A&M-Corpus Christi ... Birmingham-Southern took on the host Islanders in the first game and lost, 68-58, after the Islanders mounted a late-game comeback ... The Panthers then defeated Alcorn State in the consolation game, 75-73, courtesy of a buzzer-beating layup from sophomore **REBA ROSS** ... In the ASU game, senior **LAWANDA YOUNG** got her name in the record books once again as she dished out 10 assists, breaking BSC's single-game record ... Senior **STACEY ANTHONY**, who averaged 15 points a game, was named to the All-Tournament Team ... Freshman **ASHLEY THORNTON** also made her debut as a Panther against Corpus Christi after suffering a preseason knee injury.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs will take on James Madison on Dec. 20.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior **VANESSA LAUG** made her season debut in a 98-41 loss to #6 North Carolina Dec. 17. Laug has missed Coastal's first four games due to a knee injury and gives Coastal 12 players who will be available for game action. She grabbed three rebounds against the Tar Heels ... Coastal Carolina shot only 24.2 percent from the field in the loss ... Coastal went 6-of-19 from three-point range and were led by **KIM TURNER**'s 13 points ... North Carolina went 38-of-65 from the field for 58.5 percent and were just as good from behind the three-point line, going 10-of-19 for 52.6 percent ... Coastal will hit the hardwood against the College of Charleston on Dec. 20.

HIGH POINT

The High Point women's basketball team is coming out of the exam break with back-to-back games Monday and Tuesday ... On Monday night the Panthers will face Southern Conference rival Western Carolina ... It will be the 21st meeting between the two teams ... Tuesday night's contest will pit HPU against a strong Division II Presbyterian College ... It will be the first meeting between the Panthers and the Blue Hose.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames have won all three of their home games this season, outscoring the competition 72.7-55.3 (+17.4) and outrebounding them 51.0-33.3 (+17.7) ... The **FRAZEE** Triplets (**MEGAN**, **MORIAH** and **MOLLY**) are averaging 31.9 points, 16.5 rebounds, and shooting 63.6 percent (14-of-22) from behind the arc, while the Fairleigh Dickinson Triplets (Ashley, Heather and Lauren Coombs) are averaging 2.5 points, 1.4 rebounds and are 0-of-6 from three-point land ... At halftime of the Liberty-SMU game on Friday night, the Lady Flames inducted two of its best in the Liberty Women's Basketball Hall of Fame, honoring **KATIE FEENSTRA** and **KRISTAL THARP** ... Not only was Feenstra inducted into the Hall of Fame but the Lady Flames also retired her No. 44 jersey.

RADFORD

Radford will look to win back-to-back games for the first time this season ... The Highs have alternated a loss and a win in the first six games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

ASHTON BARTON continued her hot shooting scoring 16 points in both of UNC Asheville's games last week ... She is shooting 71 percent for the floor over the last four games and is averaging 17.3 points in those games ... Freshman **JESSICA MONROE** had a near perfect game in Saturday's win over Sewanee ... She was 4-for-5 from the floor, 1-for-1 from 3-point range, and 2-for-2 from the free throw line for a career-high 11 points ... She also grabbed a career-best eight rebounds in 16 minutes ... **WUDIALFORD** matched her season-high with nine points and set a new high with seven assists against Sewanee ... The Bulldogs 1-1 week puts them at 6-2, marking the best start over the first eight games since UNCA began playing a Division I schedule in 1986.

WINTHROP

Winthrop has really picked up its offense over the past four games ... After averaging just 45.7 points in its first three games, the Lady Eagles have since averaged 65.0 points ... **TIFFANY RODD** was the only player scoring for Winthrop in the first three games as she averaged 17.0 points. Since then, three Lady Eagles have averaged in double-figures with freshman **ASHLEY FANN** leading the way at 16.8 ppg ... **IVA MILEVOJ** has picked up her scoring as well and is averaging 11 points to go along with 7.29 assists a game ... Freshman **SHELLY HANKINS** is also averaging double-figures at 10.0 ppg ... **FRANCESCA DAVENPORT**, also a freshman, is averaging 9.8 ppg in the last four games off the bench ... As the offense has improved, so has the defense. Winthrop is allowing 11 fewer points per game since the team picked up the offense ... Winthrop is also outrebounding its opponent during this stretch, 40.5-36.2.
