Thornton posted two break-out games on the week, doubling her season scoring average with her 12.0 points per game. Against High Point on Jan. 16, she poured in 17 points on 6-of-9 from the floor (67 percent) and 5-of-8 from the line (62 percent). She also came up with four rebounds, while handing out one assist and picking up one steal in the match-up. Five days later against Charleston Southern, she tossed up seven points on 3-of-3 from the field and 1-of-1 from the free throw line, while notching one rebound and one assist. For the week, she shot 75 percent from the floor, 67 percent from the line while, posting five rebounds, two assists and one steal.

SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** is averaging a League-leading 18.5 points per game, and is 39th in the country. She has also posted a League-high nine double-doubles on the year. In the post, it has been all Frazee as she leads the League with 9.8 boards per contest ... Frazee has seen limited playing time over the last two games after she tweaked her knee on Jan. 16 against Coastal Carolina.

SEPERATION

High Point and Liberty highlight the Big South's women's basketball schedule this week ... Both teams are 3-0 in the League and are tied for the No.1 spot ... Last season, High Point defeated the Flames on the road to snap Liberty's 57-game winning streak over Big South opponents.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

The Big South Conference has developed a new magazine-style television show titled "Big South On The Edge," which will feature the League's women's basketball programs as well as various institutional topics during an eight-week run, beginning Thursday, Jan. 26. "Voice of the Big South" **MATT HOGUE** will serve as host, with Charlotte-based Fresh Roast TV producing.

FIVE OF A KIND

Coastal has had the same starting five for all 14 games this season. The quintet of senior **AMBER ROSE**, sophomore **C.J. WARE**, junior **CALISHA YATES**, senior **KIM TURNER** and junior **ALISHA DILL** are averaging 44.5 points and 20.7 rebounds a contest. Coastal is the only Big South school that has used the same starting five throughout the season.

TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Coastal Carolina, High Point and Radford are the only teams in the Big South with three players averaging double-digit outputs in scoring.

GUN'N FOR THAT NO. 1 SPOT

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** moved into second place for the most wins in Big South Games as he currently has 81 in seven years at the helm. Also, he is six wins away from becoming the Big South's all-time winningest coach. The current all-time winningest coach is **LUBY LICHONCZAK** who racked up 158 wins in 11 years at Radford.

GRAND THEFT AUTO, VICE CITY

At Coastal Carolina, defense has been the name of the game. The Chants are currently No. 5 in the country in steals per game, as **C.J. WARE** has posted 27 take-aways on the season.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. She currently is ranked No. 18 in the nation with 3.06 steals per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 107 this season, averaging 6.6 per game, and is currently ranked No. 6 in the country.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. Hood is 30th all-time with 1,166 points while O'Dell ranks 34th with 1,137.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,137 points and 578 rebounds. Her current rebound total has her ranked 35th in the League annuals. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** is close to reaching the 500 career rebounds mark with 442 career boards.

YOUNG GUNS

The Big South scoring trend this season has seen the "non-seniors" step up and become playmakers. Of the top 10 scoring leaders so far this season, eight of them still have one-or-more years of eligibility left after this year.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

Three games into the Big South season, High Point and Liberty are the only teams with 3-0 records ... However, that will change as the Panthers and the Flames meet on the hardwood Wednesday night ... Radford and Winthrop have identical 2-1 records ... UNCA and Birmingham-Southern each have 1-2 records, while Charleston Southern and Coastal Carolina are each looking for their first win ... The standings will continue to fill out as six of the eight Big South schools are in action on Monday, with a full slate of games on Saturday.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went on the road this past Saturday and got their first Conference win at Charleston Southern, 61-58 ... Sophomore forward **REBA ROSS** tied her career high with 14 points and hit two key free throws with 17 seconds left to help Birmingham-Southern to the win ... Senior guard **LAWANDA YOUNG** was also impressive with 13 first-half points, while senior guard **STACEY ANTHONY** recorded 11 points in the game. Prior to the win at CSU, BSC lost at home to High Point on Monday ... Freshman forward **ASHLEY THORNTON** led the Panthers in that game with a career-high 17 points. Birmingham-Southern has now won or lost 11 of its 15 games by 10 points or less.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

AMBER JAMES returned to the line-up for the Lady Bucs and immediately made her presence known ... James scored 17 points with six rebounds in the loss to Radford, and then scored 10 and grabbed five rebounds against Birmingham-Southern ... **SHAUNTE SMALL** also had a strong week with 30 points, 14 rebounds and four blocks.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior **ALISHA DILL** and senior **KIM TURNER** come into the Birmingham-Southern game needing only eight points to reach 500 in their careers ... Senior **AMBER ROSE** also looks to get to the 500 mark this season, as she has 428 career points ... Coastal Carolina opened the 2005-06 with seven straight home wins ... That streak was broken in the 68-65 loss to UNC Asheville Jan. 21. Ironically, the last time the Lady Chants lost at home was also to Asheville 52-48 Feb. 26, 2005 ... Coastal Carolina forced UNC Asheville into 26 turnovers in a 68-65 loss ... Coastal leads the Conference in turnover margin (+7.4) while forcing its opponents into 21 turnovers a game ... Coastal hosts Birmingham-Southern and High Point this week ... Coastal plays Birmingham-Southern Monday at 7 p.m. and High Point Saturday at 2 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point is 8-0 at home this season ... The Panthers are off to a 3-0 start in Conference play and will host pre-season favorite Liberty on Wednesday. Both teams are currently undefeated in Conference play.

LIBERTY

With a 56-44 win over Winthrop, it marked the sixth-straight year that Liberty has started Conference play 3-0 ... The last time a **CAREY GREEN** team did not win its first three Conference games came during his first season (1999-2000) as head coach of Liberty when they won two out of their first three ... In the absence of Liberty's, and the Big South's, leading scorer **MEGAN FRAZEE**, **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ** stepped up and had a career night as the junior from Calais, France, tallied 15 points and 16 rebounds against Winthrop to give her her fourth double-double on the year ... Liberty looks to avenge its 62-53 loss (the Lady Flames' only Conference loss on the season) last year that snapped its 57-game winning streak against Big South opponents when they face-off with the Panthers of High Point on Wednesday night at the Millis Center.

RADFORD

KELLI DARDEN blocked seven shots this week, including five at High Point ... She moved into sole possession of seventh on RU's career charts with 81, needing six to tie for sixth ... **CORRIE FERTITTA** is continuing to get it done on the glass, averaging 9.6 rebounds per game in the last five contests.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville split a pair of road games last week falling by three points at Winthrop before defeating Coastal Carolina by the same margin ... Free throw shooting keyed the win at Coastal as the Bulldogs went 29-of-36 from the line, marking the first time since Dec. 16, 2004 the Dogs have gone to line more than 25 times in a game ... **KRISTAL HOOD** was 14-of-16 from the foul line, moving her free throw percentage up to 81.6 percent for the season ... UNC Asheville overcame a 12-point second half deficit to beat Coastal, marking the fourth time this season the Bulldogs have overcome double-figure second half deficits this season ... Asheville made similar comebacks against Western Carolina, Furman, and North Dakota State.

WINTHROP

For the 11th time in 12 games, the Winthrop defense held its opponents below its scoring average ... Defense has been a big part of why the Lady Eagles have been able to turn around their season after an 0-4 start ... **TIFFANY RODD** has found her stroke in Conference play as she's averaging 14.3 points a game and is shooting 52 percent from three and 86 percent from the foul line.
