Turner averaged 14.5 points per game over the Christmas break, leading her Chanticleers to a 2-0 record. She poured in 17 points against the College of Charleston and corralled eight boards as the Lady Chants downed the Cougars, 58-51 on Dec. 20. On Dec. 31, she rang in the New Year with 12 points on 5-of-10 (50 percent) from the floor, while pulling down five boards in Coastal Carolina's 68-54 win over UNC Greensboro. In the two-game span, she shot 48 percent from the floor, 1.000 percent from the free throw line, and posted one steal and one block.

Ralls led the Panthers to a 3-0 record during the holidays, averaging 12.0 points per game. She shot 58 percent from the floor, connecting on 11-of-19 attempts in the three-game span. At the charity stripe, she knocked down 14-of-17 (.824), while grabbing 12 rebounds, eight steals and dishing out 10 assists. Her biggest game of the break came against Presbyterian, where she posted a career-high 15 points and six rebounds, including four of HPU's eight overtime points, leading the Panthers to the 65-60 win.

SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** is averaging a League-leading 18.9 points per game, a mark that is 19th in the country. She has also posted a League-high seven double-doubles on the year. In the post, it has been all Frazee as she leads the League with 9.9 boards per contest to rank No. 19 in Division I.

YOUNG GUNS

The Big South scoring trend this season has seen the "non-seniors" step up and become playmakers. Of the top 10 scoring leaders so far this season, eight of them still have one-or-more years of eligibility left after this season. The League breakdown is as follows: 5 juniors, 2 freshman, 2 seniors and 1 sophomore compiling the top 10.

ROSS'N IT UP

REBA ROSS of Birmingham-Southern has been locked in all season. The sophomore is currently shooting 55 percent from the floor, connecting on 38-of-69 shots to lead the Big South.

DOWNTOWN

The Big South currently has four teams ranked in the top 50 nationally in three point field goal percentage. Liberty comes in at No. 20, Winthrop is 32nd, Birmingham-Southern is 40th, while High Point rounds out the list at No. 47.

HOME IS WHERE THE W IS

Big South schools are on fire in their home arenas posting a 23-8 record in their home gym. High Point is a perfect 7-0 in their home barn, while Coastal Carolina and Liberty are each 3-0 at home.

PRINCESS OF THIEVES

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been putting on "Robin Hood" like games thus far into the season. With 28 steals this season, Walker is averaging 3.11 steals per game and is ranked 15th in Division I.

FANN'N THE FLAMES

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has been on fire of late, shooting 51 percent from three point land. The freshman is currently ninth in the nation in three point field-goal percentage.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. After a 22 point outing against North Dakota State on Dec. 28, Hood currently has 1,095 points, while O'Dell sits at 1,072 points.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,072 points and 541 rebounds.

NO FEAR OF REJECTION

Charleston Southern's **SHAUNTE SMALL** bounced back on top of the blocked shot category over the Christmas vacation. She currently has 19 rejections this season, averaging 2.11 blocks per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 67 this season, averaging 6.70 per game, currently ranked No. 4 in the country.

EARNING THIER KEEP

Coastal Carolina has the 75th best Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) in the country, according to the latest rankings by CollegeRPI.com Jan. 1. The Chanticleers, Liberty, who is ranked 68th, and UNC Asheville, who is 100th, are the only Big South schools in the top 100 in the rankings. Coastal also has the 81st toughest schedule in the country, which includes a game against North Carolina, number three in the RPI.

MID-MAJOR MAGIC

The Big South is currently 41-36 against non-conference competition thus far into the season. The Big South currently owns a 10-3 advantage over the SoCon and is dominating the Atlantic Sun with an 8-2 record. The Big South is currently 15th in the national RPI as well.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

The Big South kept to its winning ways over the Christmas vacation. The League posted a 12-7 mark over the breaking, including three more wins over SoCon opponents, and two more wins over Atlantic Sun schools ... Every Big South school posted at least one win over the break.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

After the holidays, BSC returned home and lost to McNeese State, 68-62 ... In that game, the Panthers failed to hit a three-pointer in the first half for the first time this season ... The Panthers return to the hardwood on Jan. 2 on the road at Mississippi State. Tip-off is set for 8:00pm ET.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

After trailing for much of the first half, the Lady Bucs took the lead just :41 seconds into the second period, and never gave it back ... Led by **KEENA WICKER'S** 25-point, 10-rebound performance, the Lady Bucs scored 40 points in the paint ... Three Lady Bucs recorded a double double, including Wicker, **PAM TOLBERT** (17 points, 11 rebounds) and **ERICA MCCOY** (15 points, 10 rebounds) ... The Lady Bucs will return to action on Jan. 2 at home against Albany.

COASTAL CAROLINA

The Lady Chants 5-2 start is the best by a Coastal team since the 1999-00 season. That team started with a 6-2 record before finishing with a 20-10 mark. The best start by a CCU squad was in the 1982-83 season. That team started 9-2 and ended the season with a 21-9 record ... The Lady Chants bench scored 19 points and helped in a 16-0 run to end the first half in a 68-54 win over UNC Greensboro Dec. 31. CCU has four players with two fouls in the first half, but the Chants held the Spartans scoreless for the last 6:01 ... Coastal ends its contests against the Southern Conference with a 3-0 record after the 68-54 win over UNC Greensboro Dec. 31. Coastal also had wins over Furman (71-67) Dec. 3 and College of Charleston (58-51) Dec. 20. In the last three seasons, Coastal is 6-3 against Southern Conference opponents ... Coastal hosts three opponents this week, starting with a game against Savannah State Jan. 2 at 7 p.m. Coastal is in the midst of a five-game homestand before Big South play starts.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers are on a five game win streak going into tonight's contest against William & Mary ... High Point is undefeated at home this season with a 7-0 mark ... Senior **KATIE O'DELL** was honored before the Western Carolina game for reaching her career 1000th point (reached against Longwood) and 500th career rebound (against SFA) ... The Panthers they are on the road this week. On Jan. 2 they will face William & Mary in Williamsburg before traveling to Blacksburg for a contest with Virginia Tech on Jan. 4.

LIBERTY

Liberty completed in its second, and final, regular season tournament over Christmas Break as they finished second in the State Farm Classic tournament hosted by the University of Florida ... For the third time this season, Liberty outrebound its opponent by 20 or more boards as they pulled down 22 more rebounds (49-27) then Rhode Island during the Lady Flames' 67-57 victory ... **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ** picked up her first career double-double as she collected 14 points and 12 rebounds against Rhode Island, while **MEGAN FRAZEE** recorded her league-best seventh double-double on the year with 17 points and 13 rebounds versus the Rams.

RADFORD

KELLI DARDEN moved into 10th on RU's career blocks charts. She needs two more to tie for ninth ... **SARAH STEPHENS** has been RU's go-to player on the road this season. She is averaging 14 points and six rebounds, while shooting 57 percent from the field in five games. In the last three road tilts, she has led the Highs in scoring, including a season high 18 at Western Carolina ... Radford is back in action on Jan. 2 at Virginia Commonwealth.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville finished second in the Lady Grizz Holiday Classic in Missoula, Mont. The Bulldogs defeated North Dakota State before falling to Montana in the championship game ... **KRISTAL HOOD** celebrated her 21st birthday with a season-high 22 points against North Dakota State ... She and **BRITTANY HENDLEY** each earned all-tournament team honors ... **HENDLY** also had a season-high 15 points against NDSU ... **AMANDA ELDER** recorded her first double-double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds against Montana.

WINTHROP

Defensively the Lady Eagles have stepped up. In four of the last five games, Winthrop has held its opponents to at least 15 points below its season average. In the four games of holding its opponents below its average, the opponents have shot an average of 26% from the field ... The Lady Eagles nearly pulled off their first victory over an Atlantic Coast Conference member since going to NCAA Division I. Clemson's put-back as time expired gave the Lady Tigers a 52-51 victory. Winthrop only shot 9-for-24 from the foul line in the contest ... The Lady Eagles played three straight road games over the break and were 1-2, with a near upset of Clemson and its first road win at IPFW. They will now play three straight home games beginning on Wednesday with Wofford.
