Sellars led High Point to a 2-0 record on the week, averaging 21.5 points per game. She got her week going against Elon on Dec. 6, pouring in 12 points on 6-of-11 from the floor (55 percent), while ripping down seven boards. Four days later against Longwood, Sellars posted a career-high 31 points on 12-of-18 from the floor (67 percent) and 7-of-10 (70 percent) from three-point land. For the week, she shot 62 percent from the floor, 64 percent from behind the arc, posted 10 rebounds, nine assists and three steals.

Fann averaged 19.5 points per game as the Eagles went 1-1. Against Charlotte on Dec. 5, Fann posted her first career double-double with 15 points and 10 boards. She was 6-of-9 from the floor (66 percent) and 2-of-4 (50 percent) from behind the arc as the Eagles lost to the 49ers, 59-57. On Dec. 11 against Norfolk State, Fann tossed up a career-high 24 points on 8-of-16 from the floor (50 percent) and 8-of-13 from three point land (62 percent). During the two game span, Fann shot 56 percent from the floor, 58 percent from behind the arc, posted 19 boards, five assists, four steals and two blocks.

SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** has led Liberty in scoring in each of the Flames' last six games, averaging a League-Leading 20.8 points per game. She has also posted a League-high four double-doubles on the year. Frazee is also the League leader with a .727 three point field goal percent (8-of-11). She has also posted four consecutive games with at least 20-or-more points this season.

NOT A SELLAR DWELLER

High Point's **CANDYCE SELLARS** posted a Big South season-high 31 points as the Panthers downed Longwood, 76-68, to earn Choice Hotels Player of the Week honors.

DOUBLE TROUBLE

High Point's duo of **KATIE O'DELL** and **CANDYCE SELLARS** have been causing teams double trouble this season. The teammates are the only two players in the League to each have 20 points in the same game, a mark that they have posted twice this season.

ROLL'N

UNC Asheville has cruised out to a 5-1 record on the season. The Bulldogs only loss thus far has been to No. 8 North Carolina in Chapel Hill. The Bulldogs are coming off back-to-back wins over SoCon foes Western Carolina and Furman.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

Coastal Carolina and Charleston Southern were both idle last week, taking a break for exams. Both teams will resume play this week.

FANN'N THE FLAMES

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has been on fire of late. The freshman guard shot 56 percent from the floor last week, including 58 percent from behind the arc. Against Norfolk State on Dec. 11, Fann smoked the Spartans, going 8-of-16 from the floor and connected on a school-record 8-of-13 from three-point land. Fann has picked up two Freshman of the Week honors on the season.

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players to reach 1,000 points in their careers. Hood currently has 1,035 points this season while O'Dell sits at 1,018 points.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with over 1,000 career points and over 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,018 points and 519 rebounds.

NO FEAR OF REJECTION

Radford's **KELLI DARDEN** is currently the Big South leader in rejections with 2.17 blocks per game, totaling 13 blocks this season.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 51 this season, averaging 7.29 per game, a mark that has her currently ranked No. 5 in the country.

MID-MAJOR MAGIC

The Big South is currently 25-25 against non-conference competition thus far into the season. The Big South currently owns the SoCon with a 7-2 mark and is dominating the Atlantic Sun with a 6-2 advantage. The Big South is currently 17th in the national RPI as well.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

After defeating Millsaps in its one game this week, BSC is now riding a two-game winning streak ... Sunday's game against the Lady Majors was the Panthers' first true home game since the season opener against Samford, Nov. 21 ... Junior **PAM THORNBORROW** is leading the team with 13.4 points, 3.0 assists, and 2.4 steals a game, while sophomore **REBA ROSS** leads with 8.3 rebounds a contest.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs took a week off to focus on final exams, but will be back in action this week as they host Southern Wesleyan on Thursday night.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal continues its two-week break before travelling to Chapel Hill, N.C., to face nationally-ranked North Carolina ... The Tar Heels have started the season at 9-0, which includes a 77-54 win over Connecticut in Hartford, CT ... Coastal currently is 13th in the country in steals, according to the first stats released by the NCAA ... The Lady Chants are averaging 12.8 steals per game ... Coastal had 28 second-chance points in a 71-67 win over Furman Dec. 3.

HIGH POINT

High Point defeated Elon and Longwood this past week. The series with Elon is HPU's longest running with last week's game having been the 67th meeting ... In the Longwood game, senior **KATIE O'DELL** scored her 1,000th career point ... She currently has 1,018 points ... Juniors **CANDYCE SELLARS** and **KATIE RALLS** also gave career high performances with Sellars scoring 31 points and Ralls dishing out eight assists ... The Panthers have the next week off for exams.

LIBERTY

After six contests, the Lady Flames have an identical record as a year ago at 3-3 ... The Virginia Tech game marked the third ACC opponent for Liberty as they took on North Carolina and North Carolina State ... Saturday's game marked the last regular season meeting between the Lady Flames and the ACC ... **MEGAN FRAZEE** has led the Lady Flames in scoring in all six games on the year ... So far the freshman is averaging 20 points, 10 rebounds and three assists on the year.

RADFORD

Radford ended a trend of falling behind by nine or more points in the first half against Western Carolina. RU trailed by only five early in the first half. Prior to that, the Highlanders had trailed by at least nine points in the first half in their first five games ... **KELLI DARDEN** has blocked at least two shots in half of her 34 career games ... With six blocks at Western Carolina, she tied for 10th on RU's career charts with 66 ... **JOHNETTE WALKER** has blocked one shot in each of RU's first six games ... They have combined for 19 of RU's 24 blocks.

UNC ASHEVILLE

With back-to-back wins over Southern Conference opponents, the Bulldogs are now 8-1 against the Southern Conference over the past three seasons ... Asheville's 66-62 victory over Furman was the Bulldogs first win over the Paladins since the 1984-85 season which was also the last time UNC Asheville started the season 5-1 ... **ASHTON BARTON** led the way with a career-high 20 points ... She scored 17 points in the victory over Western Carolina last week, moving her into the team lead in scoring at 13 points a game ... **STACY SHEPARD** had nine rebounds against Furman giving her a season average of 10.7 rebounds per game and **BRITTANY HENDLEY** is 11-for-22 from three-point range this season ... The Bulldog starters have counted for 77 percent of Asheville's scoring in the first six games ... Asheville is 3-0 at home for the second-straight season ... The Bulldogs have two games at home this week, on Wednesday against Chattanooga and Saturday against Sewanee.

WINTHROP

Winthrop has really picked up its offense over the past four games ... After averaging just 45.7 points in its first three games, the Lady Eagles have since averaged 65.0 points ... **TIFFANY RODD** was the only player scoring for Winthrop in the first three games as she averaged 17.0 points. Since then, three Lady Eagles have averaged in double-figures with freshman **ASHLEY FANN** leading the way at 16.8 ppg ... **IVA MILEVOJ** has picked up her scoring as well and is averaging 11 points to go along with 7.29 assists a game ... Freshman **SHELLY HANKINS** is also averaging double-figures at 10.0 ppg ... **FRANCESCA DAVENPORT**, also a freshman, is averaging 9.8 ppg in the last four games off the bench ... As the offense has improved, so has the defense. Winthrop is allowing 11 fewer points per game since the team picked up the offense ... Winthrop is also outrebounding its opponent during this stretch, 40.5-36.2.
