Liberty's **MEGAN FRAZEE** has not been playing like most freshmen during their first three games. This season the guard/forward as posted a league-leading three double doubles during her first three games this season, including 15 points and 15 boards against No. 7 North Carolina.

**KRISTAL'S HOOD**

UNC Asheville's **KRISTAL HOOD** picked up Player of the Week honors as she led the Bulldogs to a 3-0 record to begin the 2005-06 campaign. She currently leads UNCA with 16.0 ppg. and six assists, while shooting 48 percent from the floor, 86 percent at the line and is currently 3-of-3 from three-point land. During UNCA's game against Gardner-Webb on Nov. 22, she recorded her 1,000 career point as a bulldog.

**LET'S GET IT STARTED**

UNC Asheville opened up the season going 3-0 for the first time since the 1987-88 season. Coastal Carolina is also unbeaten this season, opening up with a 2-0 record for the first time since the 2002-03 season when they started out 3-0.

**30-SECOND TIMEOUT**

Birmingham-Southern Coach **BRAD HODGE** picked up his first career win as the Panthers' head coach with a 74-66 win over Florida Atlantic. Birmingham-Southern's **REBA ROSS** also recorded a double-double in the win ... Liberty has kept to its winning ways, starting the season with a 2-1 mark thus far ... Charleston Southern picked up a win against in-state rival Wofford at home on Nov. 21 ... Coastal Carolina's jumped out to a good start, posting 16 points and 11 rebounds vs. Southern Virginia on Nov. 25 ... Radford's **SHAVON EARP** is leading the Highlanders with 13.7 points per game ... **KATIE O'DELL** of High Point has led the Panthers in scoring in each of their last three games, including a 23 point performance against Gardner-Webb.

**LOCKDOWN**

In two games, Coastal Carolina is holding opponents to just 43.5 points per game, holding Campbell and Southern Virginia to just 42 and 45 points, respectively, while posting a +16 rebounding margin in the two-game span.

UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** became the latest member of the Big South 1,000 point club, when she reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. She is the only active Big South player to reach 1,000 points in her career. O'Dell is close behind with 958 career points

**I'LL TAKE THAT**

**KATIE O'DELL** is averaging 4.0 steals per game, leading to the Panthers to a League-best 42 steals in three games (14.33 per game).

**LIGHTS OUT**

Coastal Carolina's **JASMINE TYLER** is shooting the lights out in every gym that she has played in thus far, lighting the nets up for .579 percent, connecting on 11-19 shots.

**A HELPING HAND**

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 21 this season, averaging 7.0 per game.

**MONEY**

The Big South currently has four players shooting 1.000 from the free-throw line this season. Liberty's **MORIAH FRAZEE** is 7-for-7 from the line while High Point's **KATIE RALLS** is 12-for-12, followed **KATIE O'DELL** and **JENNIFER LONG**, who are 6-for-6 for the Panthers.

## NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

## BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers got their first win of the season this past weekend, defeating Florida Atlantic in the annual Birmingham Sheraton Hotels Thanksgiving Classic, hosted by Samford ... Junior **PAM THORNBORROW** was named to the All-Tournament Team after averaging 13.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 4.0 assists, and 2.0 steals per game in the Classic ... Sophomore **REBA ROSS** also had a big game against Florida Atlantic on Saturday, posting her second career double-double with a career-high-tying 12 points and a career-high 12 rebounds ... First-year head coach **BRAD HODGE** also picked up his first-ever win at the NCAA Division I level on Saturday.

## CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

It was a rocky start for the Lady Bucs as they began the season with a tough schedule ... CSU opened the season with a pair of Southern Conference opponents ... After falling to College of Charleston, the Lady Bucs rebounded to beat Wofford, led by **KEENA WICKER'S** 15 points and eight rebounds ... Having played in all four games this season, Wicker leads CSU with 44 points, averaging 11.0 per game ... Wicker has also grabbed a team-leading 24 rebounds, followed closely by **SHAUNTE SMALL**, who has 21.

## COASTAL CAROLINA

The Chanticleers return to action on Nov. 29 at UNC Wilmington.

## HIGH POINT

High Point started the season with a win at home against Mars Hill College ... The Panthers have won each of their home openers for the past five seasons ... This week, High Point will host UNC Greensboro at home before traveling to Colorado Springs, Colo., to participate in a tournament at the Air Force Academy ... In addition to HPU and host team Air Force, Stephen F. Austin and Bucknell will be participating as well.

## LIBERTY

The Lady Flames began the 2005-06 season as the 13th winningest program in the NCAA over the past five seasons as they have posted a .758 winning percentage ... So far this season Liberty is 2-1 ... The Lady Flames (**MEGAN, MOLLY** and **MORIAH FRAZEE**) are one of just two schools in women's basketball to have triplets playing together ... The only other school is Farleigh Dickinson (Heather, Lauren and Ashley Coombs) ... Liberty is tied with eight other teams in the NCAA with 10 underclassmen ... The Lady Flames' roster is compiled of six freshmen, four sophomore and four juniors, making them the seventh youngest team in the nation.

## RADFORD

Radford opened the season 1-2 ... They went 1-1 on their trip to California ... Against UC Davis, **SHAVON EARP** had a career high 19 points and four assists, while **CORRIE FERTITTA** hit a career high four three-pointers.

## UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville begins the season 3-0 for the first time since the 1987-88 season ... The Bulldogs won their opening game of the season for the first time in 14 years with a 65-47 victory over Jacksonville ... **KRISTAL HOOD** became the 11th player in Asheville history to go over the 1,000 point mark in her career with a 17 point effort at Gardner-Webb last Tuesday ... She has been in double figures in all three games for the Bulldogs ... **STACY SHEPARD** tied her career high with 14 rebounds in each of the first two games this season and **AMANDA ELDER** matched her career high with 10 boards at Gardner-Webb. Hood, Shepard, and **ASHTON BARTON** were each named to the All-Tournament team as they led Asheville to a 2-0 mark in the Carolina First Classic to begin the season ... The Bulldogs play their first nine games in the State of North Carolina and will travel to UNC Chapel Hill and Western Carolina this week.

## WINTHROP

The Lady Eagles are off to an 0-3 start. The team has been competitive in the opening period as they have only been trailing at halftime by an average of five points ... Winthrop has been struggling from the field in the second half of its games by allowing 41.7 points a game in the second half, compared to just 28.3 points per game in the first half ... **IVA MILEVOJ** has been thrown into having to run the point guard position for nearly every minute of the season so far for Winthrop and has done a solid job ... Milevoj has 21 assists (7.0 per game) and nine turnovers (six of which came in the loss to Appalachian State)
