SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** is averaging a League-leading 19.2 points per game, and is 37th in the country. She has also posted a League-high nine double-doubles on the year. In the post, it has been all Frazee as she leads the League and is 25th nationally with 9.9 boards per contest.

LEAGUE PLAY, UNDER WAY

The Big South opened up League play this past weekend. High Point and Winthrop picked up wins on the road, while Radford and Liberty notched wins at home. It will be a full schedule of Big South hoops during the week as UNC Asheville travels to Winthrop on Jan. 18 with every team in action on Jan. 21.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

On Jan. 14 the Big South Conference began filming for the upcoming Women's Basketball magazine TV show, "Big South on the Edge." More information will be announced once it is finalized.

SIGNS OF IMPROVEMENT

Winthrop's Big South win on Saturday is already one better than last year. With a bevy of new faces in Rock Hill, S.C., the Eagles are starting to get things back on track. This season Winthrop is 7-7, 1-0 in the Big South and has won its last four games. **ASHLEY FANN** leads the Eagles in scoring with 12.4 points per game.

HIGH POINTS

The Panthers pulled out the 73-70 win over UNC Asheville on Saturday. **LESLIE COOK** tossed up a season-high 17 points, while teammate **CANDYCE SELLARS** drained a last second trey to steal the win from the Bulldogs.

GUN'N FOR THAT NO. 1 SPOT

Liberty head coach Carey Green is one win away from moving into second place for the most wins in Big South games, he currently has 79. Also, he is eight wins shy of becoming the Big South's all-time winningest coach.

IT'S OK TO HAVE MISDEMEANORS ON THE HARDWOOD

At Coastal Carolina, defense has been the name of the game. The Chants are currently No. 6 in the country in steals per game, as **C.J. WARE** has posted 26 take-aways on the season.

WORKING HARD IN THE PAINT

The Flames are tough in the paint, as they lead the League in both offensive and defensive rebounds. The effort in the paint has them outrebounding the opposition by 10.3 to rank 13th in Division I.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. With 42 steals this season, Walker is averaging 3.0 steals per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 85 this season, averaging 6.79 per game, currently ranked No. 8 in the country.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. Hood is 34th all-time with 1,140 points while O'Dell ranks 35th with 1,107.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,107 points and 562 rebounds. Her current rebound total has her ranked 37th in the League annuals.

YOUNG GUNS

The Big South scoring trend this season has seen the "non-seniors" step up and become playmakers. Of the top 10 scoring leaders so far this season, eight of them still have one-or-more years of eligibility left after this year.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

After the Big South dominated the non-conference schedule, League play began last Saturday ... High Point and Asheville played a barn burner, with the Panthers stealing a 73-70 win on a **CANDYCE SELLARS** last second three ... Winthrop traveled to Birmingham-Southern and picked up the 69-59 win on the road ... In Radford, Va., the Highlanders snapped Coastal Carolina's six-game winning streak with a 66-46 win over the Chanticleers ... Liberty and Charleston Southern capped the games on Saturday with the Flames notching a 78-41 win.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

Birmingham-Southern dropped its lone game last week, losing its Conference opener at home to Winthrop, 69-59, Saturday. It marked the first time that Winthrop has beaten the Panthers in Bill Battle Coliseum, and is only the Lady Eagles' second win over BSC in program history ... Seven of the Panthers' eight losses so far this season have been by 10 points or less ... Freshman **ASHLEY THORNTON** was one of the Panthers' two leading scorers against the Lady Eagles, recording a career-high 11 points, while sophomore **MORGAN TALBOT** also posted a career high with 10 points ... Junior **PAM THORNBORROW** still leads the Panthers with 11.5 points a game, while sophomore **REBA ROSS** leads with 7.2 rebounds a contest.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

In the Conference opening loss, the Lady Bucs had just one person in double figures with **RACHEL POTTS** scoring 10 ... It was the first time this season that Potts has led the team in scoring ... **SHAUNTE SMALL** and **ERICA MCCOY** each dropped in nine points ... Small also had six rebounds and two blocks ... With the loss, the Lady Bucs start the Conference season 0-1 for the fourth straight year.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Junior **ALISHA DILL** comes into the Liberty game needing only 19 points to reach 500 in her career. Dill has the most career points on the team and had a career high 21 points against Furman Dec. 3 ... Senior **DEMARIA YOUNG** had 11 first-half points against Radford Jan. 14, going 5-of-6 from the floor. Young ended the game with 14 points, two off a career high, and was 2-of-3 from three-point range ... After being down 27-26 at half-time against Radford, Coastal shot just 22.6 percent in the second half in a 66-46 loss. The Lady Chants went 7-of-31 from the field and 1-of-5 from three-point range. For the game, Coastal shot 30 percent from the floor.

HIGH POINT

High Point opened Big South Conference play with a 73-70 win over UNC Asheville ... Junior **CANDYCE SELLARS** hit a last second three pointer to seal the win for the Panthers ... This week High Point will face Birmingham-Southern on Monday and Radford on Saturday.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames will host Coastal Carolina on Monday and Winthrop on Saturday, bringing to a close the team's longest homestand of the season at five-straight games ... The Lady Flames opened up Big South action this past weekend against Charleston Southern, posting a 78-41 victory over the Buccaneers, which marked the team's sixth-straight Conference-opening victory. The last time that Liberty dropped a Conference opener came in a 77-72 loss to Elon on January 13, 2000 ... The Lady Flames saw the continued emergence of junior **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ** this week as the forward averaged a double-double on the week (12.0 points and 10.5 rebounds per contest). Piotrkiewicz tied a season high with 14 points against Loyola, while adding her third double-double of the year with 10 points and 12 rebounds against Charleston Southern on Saturday ... Head coach **CAREY GREEN** continues to shake up his starting lineup as Liberty recorded its eighth different starting lineup when they faced Charleston Southern on Saturday ... **ALEX BREAM** was the newest addition to the starting lineup as Green gave Bream the start, allowing the walk-on to honor her father who recently passed away ... **RACHEL HAMMOND** came off the bench to record a career game against Charleston Southern as the rookie netted 13 points on a perfect night from the field (4-of-4), including 2-of-2 from three-point range, while going 3-of-4 from the free throw line. She also added a season-high three steals and two assists in her first-ever Big South game.

RADFORD

Over the last seven games, **SARAH STEPHENS** has been on a roll, scoring in double figures every game, including a pair of 20-point performances vs. IPFW and Southern Virginia. Over that stretch, she's averaged 17 ppg, while shooting 49.5 percent from the field and 74 percent from the line ... For the year, she has 10 double-digit scoring games, a new career high, and led RU is scoring seven times ... She also reached the 500-point plateau vs. Coastal ... The Highlanders have forced 24+ turnovers in the last three games, including season highs of 28 vs. IPFW and Southern Virginia ... They have forced 20+ miscues in 10 of their first 14 games.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville lost both games this week by a total of nine points. It is the first time this season the Bulldogs have lost back-to-back games ... **AMANDA ELDER** recorded her second double-double of the season with 18 points and a career-best 11 rebounds at Longwood ... Against High Point, she scored a career-high 20 points going 10-of-11 from the free throw line ... **KRISTAL HOOD** also had a good week posting 20 points and seven rebounds at Longwood and a double-double of 15 points and a career-high 12 rebounds against High Point. Elder and Hood combined for 52 percent of the Bulldogs offense in the two games.

WINTHROP

Winthrop's victory over Birmingham-Southern marked the first time Winthrop has ever opened up Big South play with a victory on the road ... It also marked the first time Winthrop has won at Birmingham-Southern in five attempts ... Heading into Saturdays Conference opener, the Lady Eagles had been shooting 58 percent from the free throw line in away games. Birmingham-Southern tried to take advantage of that, but the young Lady Eagle squad was up to the task, connecting on 25-of-34 (74 percent).
