**Corrie Fertitta • Sophomore

Fertitta averaged 16.5 points and 8.5 rebounds per game to lead her Highlanders to a 2-0 record on the week. She got things going on Jan. 4 with 16 points against Lees-McRae, shooting 54 percent from the floor on 7-of-13 shots. She also added two free throws and six boards on the night. Three days later at IPFW, she posted a double-double with 17 points and 11 rebounds, while shooting 46 percent from the floor and 1.000 from the charity stripe to lead the Highs to an overtime victory. In the win, she blocked a shot, grabbed the rebound and took it the length of the floor and nailed a 19-footer as time expired in overtime to pick up the 79-77 win. For the week, she shot 50 percent from the floor, .750 percent from the free throw line while notching 17 rebounds, five blocks, four assists and two steals.

SCORING FRAZEE

Liberty freshman **MEGAN FRAZEE** is averaging a League-leading 18.5 points per game, and is 3rd in the country. She has also posted a League-high eight double-doubles on the year. In the post, it has been all Frazee as she leads the League with 10.0 boards per contest.

SEPERATING THE CONTENDERS FROM THE PRETENDERS

The Big South women's basketball Conference season is set to get underway on Jan. 14 with a full slate of games. Winthrop travels to Birmingham-Southern, Charleston Southern will be at Liberty, Radford will play host to Coastal Carolina and High Point will travel to UNC Asheville.

YOUNG GUNS

The Big South scoring trend this season has seen the "non-seniors" step up and become playmakers. Of the top 10 scoring leaders so far this season, eight of them still have one-or-more years of eligibility left after this year. The League breakdown is as follows: 5 juniors, 2 freshman, 2 seniors and 1 sophomore compiling the top 10.

MID-MAJOR MAGIC

With the non-conference season coming to a close, the Big South is 13 games over .500 with a 53-40 record (.569). The Big South scored wins over 12 different leagues and is 11-3 against the SoCon, as well as 8-2 vs. the A-Sun. The League also posted a perfect 12-0 record against Non-Division I schools.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

Beginning on Jan. 14 the Big South will begin filming for the upcoming Women's Basketball magazine TV show, "Big South on the Edge". More information will be announced once it is finalized

HOME IS WHERE THE W IS

Big South schools are on fire in their home arenas, posting a 35-9 record in their home gym. High Point is a perfect 7-0 in their home barn, while Coastal Carolina is 6-0 and Liberty is 4-0 at home.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. With 34 steals this season, Walker is averaging 2.83 steals per game and is ranked 29th in Division I.

FANN'N THE FLAMES

Winthrop's **ASHLEY FANN** has been on target of late, shooting 48 percent from three point land. The freshman is currently sixth in the nation in three point field-goal percentage.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 81 this season, averaging 6.75 per game, currently ranked No. 8 in the country.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. Hood and O'Dell each have 1,105 points.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,105 points and 558 rebounds.

30-SECOND TIMEOUT

Birmingham-Southern split last week with a loss to Mississippi State, but rebounded to down Savannah State ... Coastal picked up three wins last week over Savannah State, Coker and Converse ... High Point dropped William & Mary on Jan. 2, but lost two days later to then No. 25 Virginia Tech ... Liberty won its only game of the week with a win over American ... Radford went 2-0 on the week, knocking off Lees-McRae and Indiana Purdue Fort Wayne ... UNC Asheville downed Montreat on Jan. 5 ... Winthrop picked up some good wins last week with wins over Wofford and Longwood.

FREE BASKETBALL

The Big South is currently 4-1 in overtime games this season. The latest win came on Jan. 7 as Radford downed IPFW, 79-77, on the strength of a **CORRIE FERTITTA** blocked shot, rebound and 19-foot jumper as time expired. For her efforts on the week, Fertitta was named the Big South women's basketball Player of the Week.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers split last week on the road, losing a tough match at Mississippi State, Monday, and holding off a tenacious Savannah State team for their first true road win of the season, Saturday ... Birmingham-Southern had its worst shooting game of the season against MSU, hitting a season-low 27.1 percent from the field ... Senior **LAWANDA YOUNG** was the Panthers' leading scorer in both games, averaging 10.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 5.0 assists, and 3.0 steals per game.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

After a thrilling victory over Albany, clinched by two **ERICA MCCOY** free throws with :02 on the clock, the Lady Bucs were unable to carry the momentum and dropped the second game of the week to Longwood ... **KEENA WICKER** continued to be strong for CSU as she scored 21 points with 10 rebounds against Albany, and followed that up with 16 points and 11 rebounds against Longwood ... **PAM TOLBERT** also continued to be strong for CSU, as she combined for 27 points, 14 rebounds and nine assists in the two games. She also recorded two blocks and five steals in the two contests ... CSU will open up League play on the road for the second-straight year.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal is now 6-0 in Kimbel Arena after defeating Converse 80-50 Jan. 7 ... Coastal also has a five-game winning streak, its longest since 1999-2000 ... In the three games last week, the Lady Chants averaged 48.7 rebounds a game, compared to 36.3 for its opponents ... They also shot 47.4 percent from the floor, compared to 30.3 for the opponents ... Coastal has had the same starting five for all 10 games this season. The quintet of senior **AMBER ROSE**, sophomore **C.J. WARE**, junior **CALISHA YATES**, senior **KIM TURNER** and junior **ALISHA DILL** are averaging 47.4 points and 21.3 rebounds a contest ... The Lady Chants set a season high with 23 assists in the 80-50 win over Converse Jan. 7. This performance came after CCU had 22 assists in a 92-44 win over Coker Jan. 3 ... The Lady Chants 8-2 start is the best by a Coastal team since the 1982-83 season. That team started 9-2 and ended the season with a 21-9 record. Coastal beat the start of the 1999-2000 team when it defeated Coker Jan. 3 ... Coastal starts its Big South schedule Saturday, Jan. 14 with a 3 p.m. tip against Radford in Radford, Va.

HIGH POINT

The Panthers defeated William & Mary this past week in Williamsburg, but fell to #25 Virginia Tech on the road. High Point has a 10-day break before kicking off Conference play on Jan. 14 at UNC Asheville.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames outrebounded the Eagles of American by a season-high 31 boards (61-30) in their 66-42 victory on Tuesday night in Liberty's only game on the week ... For the second-straight game, **MEGAN FRAZEE** and **KAROLINA PIOTRKIEWICZ** recorded double-doubles as Frazee had 15 and 11, while Piotrkiewicz collected 12 and 11 ... Liberty has won all seven of its games by double digits, with an average victory of 17.4 ... However, in their four losses (all by double digits) the Lady Flames have been beaten by an average of 24.5 points.

RADFORD

In RU's victory over IPFW there were several firsts ... It was Radford's first road overtime win since Jan. 22, 2000 at Charleston Southern ... Its first win this season when trailing at halftime ... Its first game since Nov. 28, 2001 two Highlanders score 20+ points ... **SARAH STEPHENS** (23) and **SHAVON EARP** (20) scored career highs in points ... **CORRIE FERTITTA** recorded the first RU double double this season (17 pts/11 rbs) ... Against IPFW, Radford forced a season high 28 turnovers, the eighth time this year it has forced 20+ mistakes.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville defeated Montreat College 73-40 in its only action last week ... **KATIE BALDWIN** led the way posting career highs with 18 points and nine rebounds ... **AMANDA ELDER** just missed her second straight double-double with 17 points and nine rebounds ... **LESLIE YOUNG** made her first start of the season and grabbed a career-best 11 rebounds ... **BRITTANY HENDLEY** and **KRISTAL HOOD** were each in double-figures with 11 and 10 points in the game ... The Bulldogs played without two starters, **ASHTON BARTON** and **STACY SHEPARD** did not play against Montreat but are expected back this week ... Asheville has one more non-conference game at Longwood before opening up Big South play at home against High Point.

WINTHROP

The Winthrop defense has stepped up the last eight games as they are allowing just 54.2 ppg over the eight game stretch in which the team has posted a 5-3 record ... The defense has held six of its last seven opponents under its season scoring average ... It held Longwood to just six points under its average, but the other five opponents were held to at least 18 points under their season averages ... During this stretch, opponents are shooting just 31 percent from the field and 29 percent from three ... Winthrop senior **ASHLEY CAREY** came off the bench to tie her career-best 18 points and lead Winthrop to its first back-to-back wins since the 2002-03 season. Carey was 7-for-13 from the field, including 4-for-7 from three and also grabbed three rebounds in 24 minutes. Carey also came off the bench to score seven points in just 11 minutes to help Winthrop defeat Wofford on Wednesday ... This season Carey is averaging 5.0 points, 1.6 rebounds and is shooting 34 percent from three (after missing her first 11 three-point attempts to start the season) off the bench ... Since her first 11 misses she's shooting 48 percent from behind the arc and 45 percent from the field.
