Ross averaged 11.0 points per game to lead the Panthers to a 2-0 record on the week and helped Birmingham-Southern jump up two spots to fifth in the standings with wins over Radford and UNC Asheville. She got the week started on Jan. 30 with 10 points on 5-of-6 from the field (83 percent) while ripping down seven boards and dishing out two assists in the Panthers' win over Radford. On Feb. 4, Ross shot 56 percent on 5-of-9 from the floor while adding 2-of-3 at the line (67 percent) to finish with 12 points against UNCA. She also chipped in eight boards and one assist in the overtime win against the Bulldogs.

Lightfoot averaged 10 points per contest to help the Flames go 2-0 on the week. Against Longwood on Feb. 1, she put in a career-high 12 points, on 4-of-5 from the field (80 percent), while shooting a perfect 2-of-2 from three point land and the charity stripe. She also added three rebounds and one assist in the win. Three days later against Radford, she tossed up eight points on 3-of-6 from the floor (50 percent), 1-of-2 from the arc (50 percent) and 1-of-2 from the line (50 percent). She also notched four boards and two assists as the Flames downed the Highlanders, 58-50.

DUDE, YOU'RE GETTING AN O'DELL

Preseason Big South Player of the Year **KATIE O'DELL** came out swinging in the first round of HPU's Conference games, averaging 14.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game. Six of her last seven games have seen her in double-digits, including 21 points against Coastal Carolina and 17 points against traditional Big South Power Liberty.

SEP-HPU-RATION

High Point has established itself as the team to beat this season. The Panthers are currently 7-0, with the first round of the Conference games behind them. Liberty is second with a 5-1 record, while Winthrop rounds out the top three with a 4-2 mark.

(HIGH)LANDER

Radford's **SARAH STEPHENS** finished the first half of the Conference season with great numbers. Through the first seven games, she has scored in double figures five times, posted three 20-point games and is averaging 8.6 boards per outing. In League games, she is shooting 42 percent from the field, 50 percent from the arc and 73 percent from the charity stripe.

LIGHTS OUT

Birmingham-Southern's **REBA ROSS** has been shooting the lights out of every gym she has played in this season. She currently leads the Big South with a 57 percent stroke from the field. Ross also picked up Big South Player of the Week honors this week as she helped the Panthers post two key League wins and jump up two spots to fifth in the League.

FIVE OF A KIND

Coastal has had the same starting five for all 18 games this season. The quintet of senior **AMBER ROSE**, sophomore **C.J. WARE**, junior **CALISHA YATES**, senior **KIM TURNER** and junior **ALISHA DILL** are averaging 45.4 points and 21.0 rebounds a contest. Coastal is the only Big South school that has used the same starting five throughout the season.

MILESTONE

High Point's **TOOEY LOY** moved into the all-time Top 10 winningest Big South coaches midway through the season. He joins Liberty's **CAREY GREEN** (2nd-83) and Coastal Carolina's **ALAN LEFORCE** (7th-50) as one of three active head coaches in the all-time Top 10.

GUN'N FOR THAT NO. 1 SPOT

Liberty head coach **CAREY GREEN** moved into second place for the most wins in Big South Games as he currently has 83 in seven years at the helm. Also, he is three wins away from becoming the Big South's all-time winningest coach (155). The current all-time winningest coach is **LUBY LICHONCZAK** who racked up 158 wins in 11 years at Radford.

GRAND THEFT AUTO

At Coastal Carolina, defense has been the name of the game. The Chants are currently No. 10 in the country in steals per game, averaging 12.4 take aways per game.

I'LL TAKE THAT

Radford's **JOHNETTE WALKER** has been robbing the opposition thus far into the season. She currently is ranked No. 19 in the nation with 3.1 steals per game.

HERE, YOU SHOOT IT!

Winthrop's **IVA MILEVOJ** has a commanding lead in assists with 126 this season, averaging 6.63 per game, and is currently ranked No. 6 in the country. She needs 55 more assists this season to move into the single season top five.

1K AND COUNTING

KATIE O'DELL became the latest member of the Big South 1,000-point club when she reached the milestone against Longwood on Dec. 12. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** reached the milestone against Gardner-Webb Nov. 22. Hood and O'Dell are the only active Big South players with 1,000 career points. O'Dell is 27th all-time with 1,203 points, while Hood ranks 28th with 1,190 points.

O'DELL NO SHE DIDN'T

KATIE O'DELL is the only active player in the Big South with 1,000 career points and 500 career rebounds. Her totals are 1,203 points and 609 rebounds. Her current rebound total has her ranked 31st in the League annuals. UNCA's **KRISTAL HOOD** is close to reaching the 500 career rebounds mark with 454 career boards.

BIG SOUTH ON THE EDGE

The Big South Conference's new magazine TV show, "Big South On The Edge", continued last Thursday, Feb. 2 across the Big South Television Network with the second of the eight scheduled shows. Winthrop University was the featured member institution. High Point is the next school to be featured and will air on Thursday, Feb. 9.

NOTING THE BIG SOUTH TEAMS

BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 2-0 last week to move to fifth place in the Conference standings, defeating Radford at home and UNC Asheville on the road in their first overtime game of the season ... Senior **STACEY ANTHONY** made program history against UNCA, getting two steals to take over the top spot on BSC's career steals list with 129.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

Despite two home games, the Lady Bucs were still unable to pick up their first Conference victory ... CSU was within eight midway through the second half but went cold from the field, scoring just 15 points in the last 13 minutes of the game against High Point on Jan. 30 ... Senior **ERICA MCCOY** was the lone CSU player to score in double figures (15) against High Point, while the Lady Bucs put four in double figures against Coastal, but still came up short ... **SHAUNTE SMALL** broke her streak of consecutive games scoring in double figures at five, not getting there in either contest this week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal Carolina won its third road game of the season, 76-69, against Charleston Southern Feb. 1 ... Coastal is now 3-4 on the road and has surpassed last year's two wins on the road ... Senior **AMBER ROSE** leads the team with 10.3 points per game on the road ... Rose tied her career high with 20 points in a 76-69 win over Charleston Southern Feb. 4 ... Seventeen of those points came in the first half, when the senior was 7-of-10 from the floor and 3-of-6 from three-point range ... Rose also scored 20 points against Morris Jan. 12, when she had 15 first-half points ... Junior **CALISHA YATES** had 13 points and 11 rebounds in the 76-69 win over Charleston Southern, marking the second time she has had a double-double this season ... The junior had 16 points and 11 rebounds in an 88-45 win over Southern Virginia Nov. 25 ... In the win over the Lady Bucs, Yates was 2-of-5 from three-point range and had three steals ... Coastal Carolina held Savannah State to 24.6 percent shooting from the field in a 46-42 win over the Tigers Feb. 1 ... It was a season low for an opponent, which was 28.8 percent, also by Savannah State Jan. 2. SSU also shot just 1-of-10 from three-point range ... Coastal ends its three-game road trip at Winthrop Tuesday at 7 p.m. in Rock Hill ... The Lady Chants then host Liberty Saturday at 2 p.m.

HIGH POINT

High Point is the only undefeated team in the Big South, having swept the first half of the Conference schedule ... The Panthers have a week break before getting started on the second half of the League schedule when they host UNCA, Sat. Feb. 11 ... This past week senior forward **KATIE O'DELL** combined for 16 rebounds to move her into ninth place on HPU's all-time leading rebounders list ... Her 28 points moved her into the number 10 spot on the all-time leading scorers list.

LIBERTY

After a four-game road swing, Liberty returns home to face UNC Asheville ... The Lady Flames lead the all-time series record, 31-6, and have not lost to the Bulldogs at home since February 12, 1990 ... The Lady Flames are a perfect 10-0 this season when wearing their white (home) uniforms, going 8-0 at home and 2-0 at neutral sites (Southern Miss and Rhode Island) ... With its win over Radford on Saturday afternoon, Liberty won its 13th-straight game against the Highlanders and pulled to within one victory of evening the series at 21 apiece.

RADFORD

SARAH STEPHENS continues to have a stellar season, netting her fifth 20-point game against Liberty and is averaging a career high 14 ppg this season ... During RU's five-game losing streak, RU has struggled from the field, offensively and defensively ... In those five games, RU is shooting 31 percent including three games under 30 percent and averaging 57 ppg, compared to 40 percent and 68 ppg in the first 15 ... Defensively, they have allowed 66 ppg and opponents to shoot 42 percent, compared to 38 percent and 63 ppg.

UNC ASHEVILLE

UNC Asheville lost its only game last week in overtime 66-61 to Birmingham-Southern ... The Bulldogs had their worst shooting night of the season from the free throw line ... Asheville has been the best free throw shooting team in the Conference this season but in the last two games are just 24-of-46 (52.1 percent) from the charity stripe ... **BRITTANY HENDLEY** hit a season high five three-pointers against BSC to match her season-high of 15 points in the game ... The Bulldogs will travel to Liberty and High Point this week.

WINTHROP

The defense for Winthrop continued to be its strong point this past weekend as it held High Point to just 57 points, 10 points below its scoring average ... The Lady Eagles had two starters in foul trouble nearly the entire game and never could get going offensively, but the defense kept them in the game ... It was the 14th opponent in 15 games in which Winthrop has held the opposition under its scoring average ... The 57 points for High Point was its second lowest total on the season ... Freshman **ASHLEY HAUGTVEDT** did a solid job in filling in for **LISA KOOP** (who was in foul trouble vs. High Point) as she scored nine points in 21 minutes off the bench.
