Klint Reed • Sophomore OF • VMI • Chesterfield, Va.

Reed batted .400 (10-25) in six games to open the 2006 season, helping lead the Keydets to a series win over Auburn and a 3-3 overall mark. Reed reached base safely in each game, recorded three multihit games and scored seven runs with four runs batted in, three doubles, one home run and three walks. Against the Tigers, he batted .583, including the game-winning home run in the Keydets' 8-5 game two win, which was VMI's first win over an SEC team since 1922.

Mike Konstanty • Sophomore 1B • Winthrop Oneonta, N.Y.

Konstanty, a reserve first baseman last year, hit .316 in Winthrop's first five games, with three homers, nine runs batted in, one double and an .813 slugging percentage, helping the Eagles to a series win over nationally-ranked Miami. He also reached base safely in all five games, homered in three contests and posted three multi-RBI efforts. Against the Hurricanes, Konstanty batted .455 with two home runs and six RBI, and added a round-tripper at Alabama.

Wilson, a true freshman, won his first two career starts against Miami and Alabama. In Winthrop's 4-3 win over the Hurricanes, Wilson tossed 8.2 innings, allowing just six hits, three runs (two earned), while striking out six batters.
