Brandon Hynick • Junior • 1B Birmingham-Southern • North Royalton, Ohio

Hynick hit .421 (8-19) in five games against nationally-ranked opponents last week, helping the Panthers win two-of-three at No. 24 Winthrop and taking sole possession of first-place in the Big South standings. He opened the week with a 3-6 performance at No. 1 Mississippi State, posting a home run and 3 RBI in the two-game series. His homer gave BSC a 3-0 lead over MSU in game one before the Panthers fell, 5-4. Hynick went 3-5 with two home runs and four RBI in Friday's 10-6 win at Winthrop, and twice helped increase leads during the ballgame. In Sunday's rubber game against the Eagles, Hynick had two hits, including an RBI single that proved to be an insurance run that gave Birmingham-Southern a 3-1 lead and the eventual 3-2 victory. On the week, Hynick recorded three multi-hit games, four runs scored, three home runs, eight RBI, an .895 slugging percentage, .500 on-base average, two walks and one hit-by-pitch.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Martin went 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in two road starts last week. At No. 1 Mississippi State, he pitched a scheduled four-inning outing, yielding just two runs (one earned) on two hits with eight strikeouts in the no-decision. Sunday at No. 24 Winthrop, Martin tossed a complete game with nine strikeouts, two runs and four hits, giving BSC the series win over WU. Following a home run and a double in the fourth, Martin retired nine straight before allowing a seventh-inning home run. He then retired the next eight hitters to close out the game.
