Crumpler had four RBI and a home run in VMI's game one win over CSU, recorded two hits and two runs in game two and tallied three hits in the finale. He scored two runs in all but the last game, and finished the week with an .867 slugging percentage, .632 on-base average, seven runs scored, five runs batted in, two doubles, two walks and two hit-bynitches.

Barham tossed his first career complete game over the weekend a two-hitter to defeat Charleston Southern in the Keydets' Big South opener. He surrendered only a third-inning single and a fifth-inning double, while the only run he permitted was unearned. After the third-inning single, Barham retired 18 of the next 19 batters before issuing a ninth-inning walk. His six strikeouts increased his team-leading total to 44 in 39.1 innings of work.
