Lentz batted .500 (10-20) with three multi-hit games, two doubles, a home run, two RBI and six runs scored to lead Winthrop to a 3-2 record, including a series victory on the road at Coastal Carolina and a 5-0 defeat of #19 Wake Forest. Slugging .750, he led the club in total bases (15) and had a .565 on-base percentage. Lentz hit a solo home run against Coastal in game one and finished with a .545 batting average against the Chanticleers. He recorded three hits against Wake Forest and CCU (game two) and struck out just once in his 20 official at-bats. Lentz is currently on a 14-game hitting streak, batting .569 (21-59) which includes five doubles, three home runs, and eight RBI and ten multi-hit games.
