Vernon had at least one hit in all five games this week posting a .417 (10-for-24) batting average. He drove in five runs and scored seven times on the week. He had an on base percentage of .440 and a slugging percentage of .708 getting 17 total bases in 10 hits. He had a RBI double in the win at Tennessee and made a great catch robbing a threerun home run to keep the Bulldogs in the lead. He tripled and homered going 8-for-14 against Winthrop. He went 4-for-5 scoring three times and driving in three runs in the middle game of the Winthrop series. He scored in four of the five games and drove in runs in three games last week.

# **NEW BALANCE** PITCHER OF THE WEEK

#### Austin Fleet • Freshman Coastal Carolina • RHP Edmund, Okla.

Fleet went 1-0 and recorded a career high in strikeouts in two games this week. The freshman went five innings, allowing only three hits and a run while striking out six Camels in an 11-1 win. He then had a no-decision against Birmingham-Southern, but went eight-plus innings, allowing only five hits and four runs, while striking out a career high 10 Panthers. That strikeout total also is a season high for a Coastal pitcher. Coastal won the game 7-6 in the bottom of the ninth. On the year, Fleet is 3-1 with a 3.70 earned-run average and leads the team with 39 strikeouts.
