He went 4-for-5 scoring three times and driving in three runs in the middle game of the Winthrop series. He scored in four of the five games and drove in runs in three games last week.

He then had a no-decision against Birmingham-Southern, but went eight-plus innings, allowing only five hits and four runs, while striking out a career high 10 Panthers. That strikeout total also is a season high for a Coastal pitcher. Coastal won the game 7-6 in the bottom of the ninth. On the year, Fleet is 3-1 with a 3.70 earned-run average and leads the team with 39 strikeouts.
