Laurent batted .615 in three games last week (8-13), belting three doubles, two home runs and knocking in eight runs in LU's threegame series at UNC Asheville. He doubled in each game and homered in two contests, went 3-4 with two RBI in game one, and added a 4-5, 5 RBI performance in Liberty's 20-3 win Saturday in the first game of a doubleheader. Laurent's eight hits pushed his career total to 264, breaking the school's all-time career record in the process. Laurent totaled four runs scored, 17 total bases and a 1.307 slugging percentage last week as well.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Wilson won his 11th game of the season after defeating High Point Saturday night, 3-1, in front of a nationally-televised audience on ESPNU. He went eight innings, allowing just four hits, one earned run while fanning a career-high 16 batters. Wilson's first eight outs came via the strikeout and he whiffed at least two hitters in seven of his eight innings on the mound. In addition, he held Mark Shorey, the Big South's leading hitter, to 0-3 at the plate and two strikeouts. Wilson's line: 1-0, 1.12 ERA, 8 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 3 BB, 16 SO, .143 opponent average.
