Billak hit .500 (9-18) in four games last week, with six runs, one double, three home runs and 10 RBI. Against No. 25 Troy, he went 2-5 with two runs, an RBI-double and a stolen base, helping the Panthers to a 15-8 win. His run-scoring double was a key part of a four-run third inning that cut a 5-0 Troy lead to 5-4. He later singled and scored during BSC's seven-run seventh that helped the Panthers take the lead for good. At Liberty, Billak batted .538 (7-13) in the 2-games-to-1 series win, helping Birmingham-Southern reclaim first-place in the Big South standings. In game one, he went 4-5 with three homers, four runs and seven RBI. His three round-trippers tied a school record while his seven RBI tied for secondmost in a single game in school history. On the week, Billak slugged 1.056, posted a .500 on-base percentage and stole two bases.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

David Horne • Senior Birmingham-Southern • RHP Alpharetta, Ga.

Horne went the distance in Birmingham-Southern's 4-1 win at Liberty Saturday afternoon, giving the Panthers the series-clinching win and first-place in the League standings. After allowing an unearned run and one hit in the first inning, Horne scattered five hits over the final eight frames. He retired seven-straight hitters between the fourth and sixth innings, and after a single in the seventh, retired nine consecutive batters to close out the game for his fifth-straight win. Horne's line for the week: 9 IP, 6 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB (1 IBB), 4 SO, .194 batting average.
