Carrara batted .533 in Winthrop's three-game sweep of Liberty, which had the Big South's top pitching staff entering the weekend. The lead-off hitter scored Winthrop's first run each game, including homers in the last two games leading off the Eagle first inning. In the Eagles' comeback win in game two, Carrara led off the ninth inning with a single and scored one of Winthrop's four unanswered runs in the late-inning rally. In game three, he hit a oneout single in the eighth to score the tying run, and after stealing second, scored the winning run in the come-from-behind win.

David Sappelt • Freshman OF • Coastal Carolina Saxapahaw, N.C.

Sappelt enjoyed a breakout week in helping the Chanticleers to a 3-2 record in five games with a .556 batting average. The freshman had three hits, including a home run and the game-winning single in the 10th, in Coastal's 5-4 win over Savannah State. He then had his second home run in as many games in the series opener against Charleston Southern. Sappelt wrapped up the week with four hits in the series finale against the Bucs to finish with a .545 clip (6-11) against CSU.

NEW BALANCE PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Alex Wilson • Freshman Winthrop • RHP Hurricane, W.Va.

Wilson remained perfect on the season, improving to 6-0 on the year following a three-hit, 14strikeout performance in the series opener against the Flames. He pitched 7.2 innings, did not allow a run and walked just two batters. His 14 strikeouts are a career-high his first career double-digit total which broke his previous high of nine -- as well as the most by an Eagle pitcher this season. Wilson also allowed his fewest hits in an outing and did not allow a run scored for the first time in his collegiate career.
