Jacob Dempsey • Senior • LF Winthrop • Chesapeake, Va.

Dempsey hit .588 (10-17) in four games last week with four doubles, two home runs and 13 RBI to lead the nationally-ranked Winthrop Eagles to a 4-0 week, including a three-game sweep over Charleston Southern to reclaim first-place in the Big South standings. He turned in three multi-hit games, including a season-best 4-5, six RBI performance in Friday's 23-6 win at CSU. He hit a three-run homer and notched two doubles in that game, and his six runs batted in were the most driven by an Eagle batter this season. Dempsey drove in five runs in Sunday's come-from-behind win, including a grand slam to give Winthrop the lead for good. He added three hits (two doubles) and two RBI in a mid-week tilt against The Citadel, and finished the week with nine runs scored, three walks, a stolen base and a 1.176 slugging percentage.

Gagg helped the Chanticleers take an important Big South series from VMI in Lexington, Va., with a complete game, three-hit shutout of the Keydets on Monday afternoon, winning 2-0.
