Fields batted .714 (10-14) in four games last week, including a .900 clip (9-10) against No. 16 Winthrop, helping the Keydets to the series win over the Eagles. He collected multiple hits in each contest against Winthrop, as well as a walk in every game over the weekend, including an intentional walk in game two after going 5-5 to open the series. Fields had hits in his first seven at-bats against WU, going 3-3 in game one, 4-4 with three runs in game two and finishing 2-3 in the finale. He also had 5 R, 2 2B, 3 RBI and a .765 on-base percentage.

Schwartz hit .750 (9-12) to help HPU to a series victory over Liberty, securing the No. 4 seed in this week's Big South Baseball Championship. He recorded multi-hit games in every contest, including a 4-4 effort in game one and 3-4 performance in the finale. He also drove in four runs, scored three times, walked twice and posted a double and a home run for the Panthers. Schwartz also did not strikeout, slugged 1.083 and posted a .786 on-base average, while raising his season batting average 27 points to .310.

He worked 8.0 innings, allowing just one earned run on six hits while striking out 10. He also held the Flames -- the League's second-best hitting team -- to a .194 batting average and 1.12 ERA. Portice also recorded his 100th whiff of the season, becoming just the fourth pitcher in school history to reach the century mark in a season.

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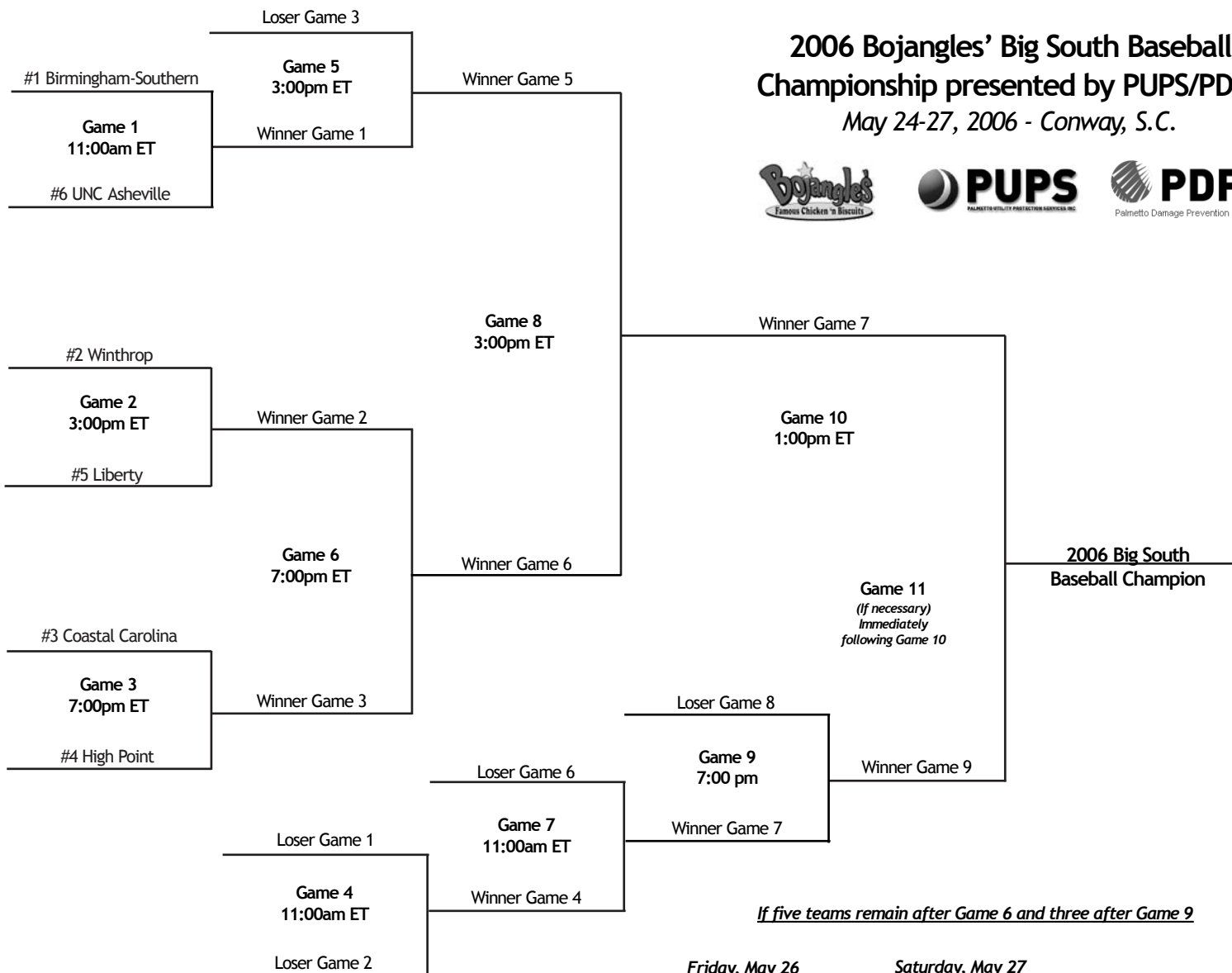

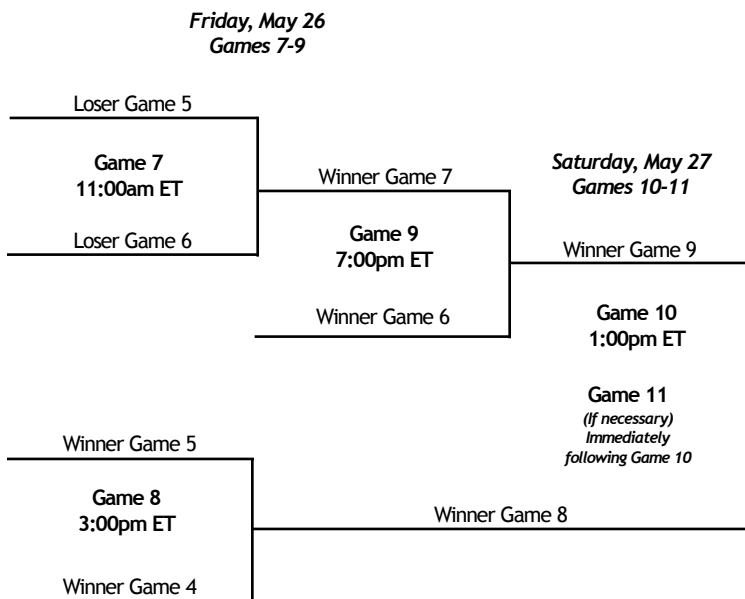

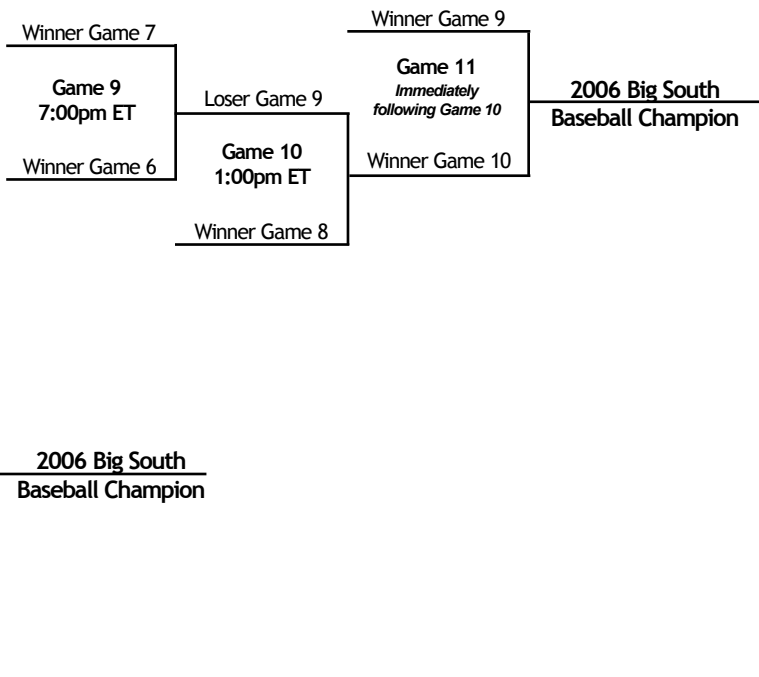
