BIRMINGHAM-SOUTHERN

The Panthers went 1-1 this week as they wrapped up regular season play on the road against Ole Miss ... After dropping the first game by a score of 2-0, BSC went on to win the second game by the same score for BSC Softball's first-ever win over an SEC opponent in program history ... Senior **NIKKI ROMBOUGH** leads the Panthers heading into postseason play, batting .457 and slugging .819 with 39 RBI ... In the circle, senior **KRISTINA VILLAVICENCIO** leads with a 16-9 record, a 1.58 ERA, and 121 strikeouts.

CHARLESTON SOUTHERN

The Lady Bucs continued to pitch well, and, in the final game of the regular season, found some offense as well ... The Lady Bucs scored just 10 runs in the 10 conference games before this week ... CSU scored five runs in two games against Winthrop, including four runs to win the final home game of the 2006 season ... Junior AMANDA NOBLE pitched a complete game, giving up just three runs in game one, while Sophomore JILL SHONDEL also went the distance, giving up just one earned run in game two ... Offensively, Junior ASHLEY CONWAY quietly strung together a six-game hitting streak, including a hit in each of the two games this week.

COASTAL CAROLINA

Coastal won its 33rd game of the season with a win over Liberty on Saturday, May 6 ... The 33 wins are the ninth best ever in a single season by Coastal ... Junior **DANYELLE GERDTS** and Sophomore **ALLISON CANTRELL** both played in their first games in over a month against Liberty in a return from injury ... **MEAGEN JOHNSON** with her two home runs against Liberty has now hit a school record 17 home runs this season ... Johnson's 19 career home runs are good for sixth all-time at Coastal ... The Lady Chants added to its team record home run total with two more blasts against Liberty, CCU has now hit 50 home runs this season ... Coastal has now won nine of its last 10 games and 32 of its last 40 ... Johnson now has 14 multi-hit and multi-RBI games this season ... Hostetler is hitting .433 in conference play this season ... Doyle is 5-1 with 0.64 ERA against Big South competition this season.

LIBERTY

The Lady Flames swept 24th-ranked Virginia Tech on Thursday in Blacksburg, Va., marking the second and third times in the history of the program that Liberty has defeated a nationally-ranked program ... With Liberty's pair of victories over the Hokies, the Lady Flames upped their win total on the year to 38 games, marking the second most wins in a season in the history of the program ... Liberty now stands just three wins short of the 1999 squad that won a school record 41 games ... **ASHLEY WILLIAMS** had four RBI in Liberty's 6-5 first game victory over 24th-ranked Virginia Tech, in cluding a three-run homer and a game-winning RBI single in the seventh ... The four RBI gives her 54 on the season, which ranks tied for second in school history, leaving the sophomore just six short of Meredith Hollyfield's record 60 RBI in 2000 ... For the second time this season, the Liberty-Winthrop game has been postponed due to weather as the two were scheduled to play on Monday. The Eagles and the Lady Flames will attempt to play the final Big South doubleheader of the year now on Tuesday at Liberty Softball Field at 3 p.m.

RADFORD

Radford finished the regular season with its first ever undefeated home record (14-0) and the third most conference wins (9) in school history ... Also, the Highlanders extended their school record home winning streak to 16 games ... The Highlanders will host the 2006 Big South Softball Tournament on Thursday, May 11-13.

TEXAS A&M-CORPUS CHRISTI

The Islanders will find out who they will play in the 2006 Big South Softball Tournament when the seeds are announced on Tuesday, May 9.

WINTHROP

The Eagles will take on Coastal Carolina on Monday, May 8 at home and will finish out their regularseason against the Lady Flames on the road on May 9.
